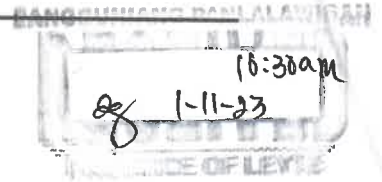

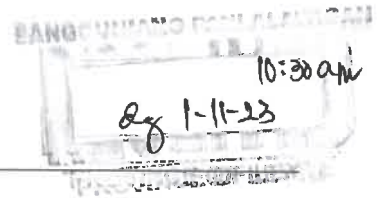

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 149
Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING THE CLEARING OF THE NATIONAL HIGHWAY, PROVINCIAL ROADS, SECONDARY ROADS, SIDEWALKS, ALLEYS, BRIDGES, PARKS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF SAN ISIDRO, LEYTE OF ALL ILLEGAL STRUCTURES, OBSTRUCTIONS AND ILLEGALLY PARKED VEHICLES AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued Memorandum Circular No. 2020-145 directing all LGUs for the continued implementation of road clearing operations;

WHEREAS, every local government unit is clothed with the powers, duties and functions to regulate traffic on all streets and bridges, prohibit the putting up of encroachments or obstacles thereon, and, when necessary in the interest of public welfare, authorize the removal of encroachments and illegal constructions in public places pursuant to Section 447, par. (5) sub par. (vi), Book III, Title II of the Local Government Code of 1991;

WHEREAS, "Juresprudence²⁹ teaches that for liability to arise under the Civil Code, Article 2189, ownership of roads, streets, bridges, public buildings and other public works, is not a controlling factor, it being sufficient that a province, city or municipality has control or supervision thereof;"

WHEREAS, it has been held by the supreme Court that the use of sidewalk "applies even to cases involving the use of lease of public places under permits or licenses issued by competent authority upon the theory that such holders could not take advantage of their unlawful permits and licenses and claim that the land in question is a part of a public street or a public place devoted to public use hence beyond the commerce of man";

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WHEREAS, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 dated July 29, 2019 enjoined all local officials to exercise their powers essential to reclaim public roads which are used for private ends and in the process, rid them of illegal structures and constructions;

BE IT ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan of San Isidro, Leyte in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE – This Ordinance shall be known as the “Road Clearing Ordinance of San Isidro, Leyte.”

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS – as used in this Ordinance the following terms shall mean:

- a. Roads – refer to the National Highway, Provincial Highway, Municipal Road, and Barangay Road.
- b. National Highway – all roads maintained by the national government with road right of way width of 20 meters.
- c. Provincial Highway - all roads maintained by the provincial government with road right of way width of 15 meters.
- d. Municipal Roads – all roads maintained by the municipal government with road right of way width of 10 meters.
- e. Barangay Roads – all roads maintained by the barangay government with road right of way width of 8 meters.
- f. Obstructions – any structure, permanent or otherwise movable erected along, standing on, abutting or in any manner impeding safe and convenient passage through any public road or sidewalk.
- g. Illegal structures – refers to electric and cable poles found inside the 20-meter right of way width of the national highway, 15-meters right of way width of a provincial road, 10-meters right of way width of a municipal road , and 08- meters right of way width of a barangay road . Also, permanent or makeshift stands encroaching into the same right of way width of the roads.
- h. Sidewalks – specific areas running parallel to both sides of a public road with a width and elevation as maybe deemed appropriate for safe and convenient pedestrian passage.
- i. Road Clearing – shall mean the removal of illegal or unauthorize road structures along the road right of way which encompasses the entire width of the road thoroughfare, (including travel way to motor vehicles and road shoulders) and sidewalk.
- j. Road Obstructions – are structures, materials or activities within the road-right-of -way that hampered the free and clear passage of motor

vehicles, pedestrians and/or pose danger or cause injury to motorists, pedestrian or occupants of nearby structures which include, but not limited to the following:

1. Vehicles parked in prohibited places as specified in Section 46 of Republic Act No.4136 of the Land Transportation and Traffic Code or in sidewalks, paths, or alleys not intended for vehicular parking pursuant to Section 52 of said Act;
2. Vehicular terminals except in areas designated by the competent authority of the Municipality of San Isidro;
3. Vending sites of any kind;
4. House encroachment that obstruct the road right-of-way, protruding gates, conduct of household activities, and tents, except those being temporarily used for funerals and other similar activities;
5. Store encroachments and indiscriminate signages and advertisements;
6. Obstructing barangay outposts, halls, markers, and directories;
7. Conduct of sports, sports facilities, and other related activities;
8. Drying of rice, corn or other crops;
9. Obstructing and/or hazardous trees;

SECTION 3. STATUTORY PROVISIONS

- a. Electric, telecommunication and cable poles within the right-of-way boundaries of roads which may pose imminent danger to life and property of road users are deemed illegal upon approval of this Ordinance and shall be subject to demolition or removal and subject to a fine by authorized personnel given 3 formal warnings from the Municipal Engineer's Office.
- b. Illegally parked vehicles shall be towed off to an impounding area and owners fined accordingly for the violation based on M.O. No. 123 s. 2020 (Local Transportation Traffic Code of San Isidro, Leyte .)
- c. Owners of stands or stall used for economic purposes encroaching into the right-of-way width of the roads shall be immediately be given a notice to vacate and clean the area upon approval of this Ordinance otherwise LGU authorized personnel shall take necessary action if clearing notice is ignored.
- d. Signage set up along the roads within the right-of-way width are obstructions and shall be taken away by LGU authorized personnel.

SECTION 4. ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

- A. Barangay officials, within their respective territorial jurisdiction, jointly assisted by personnel of the San Isidro Police Station, Department of Public Works and Highways, Municipal Engineering Office and MDRRM Office, shall clear the National Highway, Provincial Highways, and Municipal Roads within the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte of all illegal structures and obstructions, and shall carry out enforcement and implementation functions.

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- B. The Municipal Engineer's office in coordination with the PNP and the Liga ng mga Barangay will be the lead agency in formulating a unified comprehensive policies, programs and guidelines for the implementation of the Ordinance.
- C. The PNP and Barangay Officials shall monitor the implementation and enforcement of the ordinance: oversee and enforce strict implementation of all clearing operations. Jointly, said agencies shall coordinate with stakeholders and citizens concerned relative to the information and awareness campaign as well as posting of information materials to all places and areas covered by the ordinance.

SECTION 5. EXEMPTIONS – Tabo/displays during fiesta and other special occasions are exempted on the condition that necessary permits have obtained from the Mayor's Office. Provided that exempted activities shall only be for definite period.

SECTION 6. PENALTY PROVISIONS. – Violation of this Ordinance shall merit the following fines and penalties:

- A. For ambulant vendors/illegal structures/business:

First Offense:

- i. Fine of P300.00 for ambulant vendors and Notice to Vacate/Demolish Obstruction;
- ii. Fine of P500.00 for other business owners and Notice to Vacate/Demolish Obstruction:

Second Offense:

- i. Fine of P500.00 for ambulant vendors and Notice to Vacate/Demolish Obstruction;
- ii. Fine of P1,000.00 for other business owners and Notice to Vacate/Demolish Obstruction:

Third and Succeeding Offenses:

- i. Fine of P1,000.00 for ambulant vendors, Notice to Vacate/Demolish Obstruction and confiscating of goods:
- ii. Fine of P2,000.00 for other business owners and Issuance of Cease and Desist Order or Revocation of Business Permit:

- B. For illegally parked vehicles – shall be referred to Local Transportation Traffic Code of San Isidro, Leyte (M.O. No. 123 s. of 2020).

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- C. Failure to post a clearly marked and visible sign indicating on-going construction or repair work along a public road or sidewalk shall be fine P2,000.00.
- D. Failure to cover or provide adequate cover on any hole, ditch or excavation and diggings along a public road or sidewalk shall be fine P2,000.00.
- E. Failure to obtain the necessary permits from the appropriate agency required in undertaking repairs, construction works or in conducting any activity requiring the use of public road or sidewalk shall be fine P2,000.00
- F. Failure to put up or use of adequate protective roofing above sidewalks or public roads adjacent to any construction or repair shop shall be fine P2,000.00.
- G. Destroying, removing, or in any manner tampering with any sign or notice indicating an existing hazard to pedestrian safety shall be fine P2,000.00.
- H. Building or in any manner placing a connecting pipe or porting thereof on an elevated concrete or other material across or along a sidewalk shall be subject to demolition and a fine of P2,000.00.

SECTION 7. The use of provincial and municipal roads, streets and sidewalks on a temporary basis and for a definite period only shall refer to Municipal Ordinance No. 33-2013 ("An Ordinance regulating the Opening and Closing of Roads, Streets, Bridges and all Access of the Municipality of San Isidro, Leyte .")

Provided, further, that the use of bridges and the National Highway on a temporary basis shall be prohibited.

SECTION 8. The Municipal Government of San Isidro, Leyte reserves the right at its option to dispose all illegal structures, materials and goods that are confiscated at dumpsites or in any manner most convenient and safe.

SECTION 9. If any provision, section, or part of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, or parts which shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 10. All Ordinances, Executive Orders and other issuances inconsistent hereto are deemed repealed or modified accordingly:

SECTION 11. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after its posting in three (3) conspicuous places within the Municipality.





HELD AT THE THIRD FLOOR, SAN ISIDRO TOWN HALL, SAN ISIDRO, LEYTE ON NOVEMBER 15, 2022.

The Public Hearing was started at 2:10 o'clock in the afternoon presided over by the Honorable Cecilio C. Ecalla, Municipal Vice Mayor. The Honorable Rolando C. Piamonte led the prayer.

The Honorable Presiding Officer after recognizing the visitors attending the public hearing, gave the floor to the Honorable Rem Beryl Y. Veloso for his opening statement. He gave a little background of the road clearing program which was implemented under the Duterte administration, citing some provisions in local government code and DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 and 2020-145 which are directives for LGUs for the continued road clearing operations. With the new president Marcos Jr. there is no issuance on road clearing yet, however this initiative made by the author Hon. Carmichael L. Villarino is to ensure that the clearing operations should be governed or backed up by local ordinance, citing further how important the road clearing is.

The Honorable Rolando C. Piamonte also stated that once this road clearing ordinance be approved and implemented this town will be more orderly and peaceful.

Presentation of Municipal Ordinance No. 149, also known as "Road Clearing Ordinance of San Isidro, Leyte."

The author, Honorable Villarino on his preliminary statement explained the process in crafting an ordinance with the same manner in the barangay level. After the Secretary read the whole context of the ordinance, under the definition of terms he emphasized the different distances of roads classified as national, provincial, municipal and barangay roads/highways. And as the town has expanded there are buildings/houses constructed in the barangays with no road clearance or right of way, because mostly in the barangay they have not foreseen the growth of their community.

Mr. Mario Orejola, MLGOO expressed that he was happy of the initiative of the sanggunian in crafting this ordinance because this will benefit the community. That based on the data of the government billions of pesos will lose everyday due to traffic cause by obstruction of structures/illegally parked vehicles. He also expounded that this directive of road clearing was ordered by the former administration of Mr. Duterte for this reason. His office, (DILG) being given the supervisory power to implement road clearing is tasked to monitor and evaluate the local government for the imposition of said circular on road clearing. With this he is happy to note that there is a local initiative to continue and give fangs to the DILG MC NO. 2019-121. That in the signage of road clearing the basis should not be DILG memorandum circular but an ordinance.

Open Forum:

Honorable Punong Barangay Concepcion Pacampara of Brgy. Hda. Maria:

Maayong hapon sa tanan, akong pangutana giingon man nga ang PNP ug barangay mag conduct sa road clearing example sa obstruction, kinsa man ang mouna ang police or ang barangay? Pareha anang vehicle na sa bridge nga naka obstruct need ba pod mobuhat mi ug ordinance or mo follow lang mi aning ordinance sa lungsod or mao banay among basihan. Maikog pod ta mobadlong.

Hon. Carmichael Villarino, answered that in the obstruction of barangay road it is the barangay who will monitor. And in towing of vehicle there is a traffic ordinance that governs on it. The barangay can make their own ordinance or may adopt the local ordinance.

Mr. Diomedes Espina, District 2 Supervisor says, that if for example the encroachment happened before the enactment of the ordinance, since there is a penalty, will the existing structure be covered by the ordinance? Second question, the parking of vehicles in San Isidro National High School causes also obstruction to traffic, how do we solve it?

Mr. Noe Benitiz, with regards to illegally parked motorcycles in SINHS which causes obstruction, he suggested to tap the DAR to give the school a space for parking area. He was informed that the DAR has already permitted them but the area is muddy and requires embankment of gravel so that the motor vehicles can be parked there.

With regards to the query of Mr. Espina regarding the effect of the implementation of the ordinance to those existing structures who are encroaching the highway, the Honorable Rem Beryl Veloso answered, we can't impose an ordinance with retroactive effect. If the structure covers the national highway the implementing agency is the DPWH, for obstruction in the locality the LGU has the authority to remove it under this ordinance.

Discussion continues...

With regards to problem on illegal parking we must refer to Municipal Ordinance no. 123, the Honorable Villarino added. Mr. Benitez however countered that regarding the SINHS hence they are our constituents for the safety of the commuters and pedestrian it is good that the LGU will designate an appropriate area for parking.

The Punong Barangay of Capiñahan, Magdalena Cabalquinto said, hence they are the frontliners she requested the presence of the PNP in the morning at the SINHS premises while conducting traffic control because sometimes the students will not listen to them. At least it is different when the PNP is visible.

Mr. Arwin Ladlad, GPTA President informed the body that he got a chance to talk with the Mayor regarding the proposed parking area at the DAR ground for SINHS students. Mayor said that he will ask the office of the engineering to fill up the area with gravel. He also asked if the cable poles are included in this ordinance? It is in Section 2 subpar. 9 he was answered.

Discussion continues...having no other questions or clarifications asked the Honorable Presiding Officer call the members for their parting words.

The Honorable Hospicio B. Apacible said, that with regards to ordinance on permanent and temporary structure this road clearing ordinance will be followed. We seem to focus to students illegal parking because we consent their illegal act. We have national laws driving without license, minors are not allowed to drive – so, do not allow minor/students to drive. We have our tricycle that would also help our economy moving, he ended.

The Honorable Ailene L. Basilan added that our town should be orderly so that we can achieve peace. If we allow obstructions then there could be chaos so we need this ordinance to implement. With regards to driving minor it is in my propose ordinance for child protection. Thank you.

After that, Honorable Jerold T. Lumapak said that vehicular accident happens mostly by minors, they are prone to accident, so tell your minor children not to drive. That's all.

Last the Honorable Dante R. Rodaje, in his observation that in the sidewalk there are permanent and temporary structures, we have our


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engineering it is hoped that everybody will secure permit prior to their construction and it should start within the barangay. Do remind the owner regarding construction to follow the law implemented by the government, he ended.


Having no further statements given, the Honorable Presiding Officer declared the public hearing adjourned.




