#### **RESOLUTION NO. 180, S. 2022**

A RESOLUTION PASSED ENACTING AN ORDINANCE LIFTING ORDINANCE NO. 08, S. 2020 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO TEMPORARILY PROHIBIT THE BUYING, SELLING/SERVING, DRINKING OF BEER, LIQOUR OR ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF BARUGO, LEYTE, ADOPTING THE IATF-MEID GUIDELINES AS OF JUNE 4, 2022"

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, the Sangguniang Bayan of Barugo, Leyte enacted Ordinance No. 08, S. 2020, entitled "An Ordinance to Temporarily Prohibit the Buying, Selling/Serving, Drinking of Beer, Liquor or Alcoholic Beverages within the Territorial Jurisdiction of Barugo, Leyte;

WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Bayan of Barugo, Leyte is aware that the temporary liquor ban in the municipality has somehow affected the domestic liquor industry, especial the livelihood of tuba farmers, local buyers and sellers of tuba wines in the households and sari-sari stores, workers of liquor companies, sari-sari stores selling other liquor and alcoholic beverages. There is a need to assist local liquor industries and establishments selling and serving liquor and other alcoholic beverages to thrive in their respective businesses and contribute in refueling the local livelihood and economy;

WHEREAS, the Municipal Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Disease (MIATF-EID COVID-19) Council of Barugo, Leyte issued Resolution No. 1, s. 2022 recommending the lifting of the liquor ban as mandated by the aforesaid Ordinance No. 08, S. 2020;

WHEREAS, even with the lifting of the liquor ban within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality, the Sangguniang Bayan of Barugo, Leyte's Joint Committees on Health, Police Matters and Youth met on August 3, 2022 and saw the need to reinforce

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and continue to strictly enforce its minimum safety protocols to help contribute in containing the possible spread, local transmission and/or re-infection of the virus;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Barugo, Leyte is still placed under Alert Level 2 by the Leyte Provincial IATF and the MIATF-EID COVID-19 of Barugo, Leyte;

WHEREAS, the Inter-Agency Task Force for the Management of Emerging Infectious Disease (IATF-MEID) has issued the Guidelines on the Nationwide Implementation of Alert Level System for Covid-19 Response as of June 4, 2022. Section [5] thereof provides for the Guidelines for Areas under Alert Level 2. Protocol No. 1 thereof states that "1. Intrazonal and interzonal movements shall be allowed. However, reasonable restrictions may be imposed by the LGUs, which should not be stricter as those prescribed under higher alert levels and subject to the oversight monitoring, and evaluation of their respective RIATF";

WHEREAS, Section [5], Protocol No. 3 of the same IATF-MEID Guidelines provides that "3. The following establishments, or activities, shall be allowed to operate, or be undertaken at a maximum of 50% indoor venue capacity for fully vaccinated individuals and those below 18 years of age, even if unvaccinated, and 70% outdoor venue capacity. Provided that all on-site workers/employees of these establishments, or organizers of activities are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 and MPHS (minimum public health standards) shall be strictly maintained. Provided further, that there is no objection from the LGU where these activities may take place: xxx...b. Permitted venues for social events such as parties, wedding receptions, engagement parties, wedding anniversaries, debut and birthday parties, family reunions, and bridal or baby showers...xxx";

WHEREAS, Section [5], Protocol 3 (k) states that "Dine-in services of food preparation establishments, such as kiosks, commissaries, restaurants, and eateries, subject to DTI sector-specific protocols";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the same IATF-MEID Guidelines, particularly Part I, Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response, Section [1] General Guidelines No. 7 states that "7. LGUs are enjoined to enact the necessary ordinances to enforce protocols contained in these Guidelines and to penalize, in a fair and humane manner, violations of these protocols. Law enforcement agencies are likewise strongly enjoined to observe fair and humane treatment of violators";

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 07, Series of 2022, by the President of the Philippines, was passed thereby allowing the voluntary wearing of face masks in indoor and outdoor settings with exceptions thereon. The wearing of face mask is still highly encouraged for the elderly, individuals with comorbidities, immunocompromised individuals, pregnant women, unvaccinated individuals and symptomatic individuals;

#### **NOW THEREFORE:**

ON MOTION of Hon. Nikkos Rhet V. Astorga, jointly seconded by Hon. Jake Andrian C. Gerona and Hon. Eduardo C. #### ORDINANCE NO. 14, S. 2022

(Sponsored and Authored By: Hon. Nikkos Rhet V. Astorga)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honourable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Barugo, Leyte on its Regular Session assembled, to wit:

SECTION 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Lifting of the Temporary Liquor Ban and Adopting the IATF-MEID Guidelines on the Nationwide Implementation of Alert Level System for COVID-19 Response as of June 4, 2022".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. - It is the policy of the Local Government Unit of Barugo, Leyte to balance the local economy and protect its inhabitants from activities to their welfare, health and safety related to Corona Virus Disease-19 (COVID-19);

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. - The following word and phrases, whenever used in this Ordinance, shall be construed as defined in this Section:

- a. Liquor refers to beer, alcoholic beverages, whether distilled or fermented, including, but not limited to, gin, brandy, rhum, whiskey, or other locally fermented wines, such as coconut wine or tuba, lambanog, shoktong and the likes.
- b. Minimum Public Health Standards refer to the national, local, and sectorspecific guidelines on mitigation measures for its COVID-19 response across all settings by implementing non-pharmaceutical interventions (NPIs), consistent with the Department of Health (DOH) Administrative Order No. 2021-0043 or the Omnibus Guidelines on the Minimum Public Health Standards for the Safe Reopening of Institutions. This term shall also encompass specific NPIs of community mitigation strategies or public health measures that do not involve vaccines, medications, or other pharmaceutical interventions that individuals and communities can carry out in order to reduce transmission rates, contact rates, and the duration of infectiousness of individuals in the population.

SECTION 4. LIFTING OF THE LIQUOR BAN. - The Ordinance to temporarily prohibit the buying, selling/serving, drinking of beer, liquor or alcoholic beverages within the territorial jurisdiction of Barugo, Leyte is hereby LIFTED, provided that that the Guidelines on the Nationwide Implementation of Alert Level System for Covid-19 Response as of June 4, 2022 is hereby ADOPTED and the minimum public health standards are STRICTLY OBSERVED, pursuant to Executive Order No. 7, Series of 2022, by the President of the Philippines;

SECTION 5. RE-IMPOSITION OF THE TEMPORARY BAN. -- In the event that there is a spike in the number of Barugueños or Barugon-ons who tested positive for COVID-19, the Local Chief Executive and the MIATF-EID may ask and/or recommend

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the Sangguniang Bayan the immediate re-imposition of the ban on selling of liquor and other intoxicating and alcoholic beverages in the Municipality of Barugo, Leyte, and to provide appropriate penalties or to impose additional conditions thereon.

**SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ORDINANCE.** – The members of the local Philippine National Police, Barangay Officials and their respective Barangay Public Safety Officers (BPSO) or barangay tanod are hereby authorized to implement this Ordinance for the observance of the minimum public health standards.

SECTION 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If, for any reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

**SECTION 8. REPEALING CLAUSE.** - All Ordinances, Resolutions, Local Executive Orders and/or Administrative Orders, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE**. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval and shall remain in full force and effect during the period of Alert Level 1 and 2 imposed by the National Government and the Local Government Unit of Barugo, Leyte.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, to furnish copies of this Ordinance to the Local Chief Executive of Barugo, Leyte, the Chief of Police of the Barugo Municipal Police Station, Municipal Local Government Operation Officer (MLGOO) assigned in Barugo, Leyte, to all Punong Barangays of Barugo, Leyte, to all Sangguniang Kabataan Chairpersons of Barugo, Leyte, the Business Licensing and Permitting Officer of LGU-Barugo, Leyte, and to the Honourable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte for their information, review and approval.
