

RESOLUTION NO. 192, S. 2022

A RESOLUTION ENACTING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AN INFIRMARY IN THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF BARUGO, LEYTE, TO BE NAMED AS "BARUGO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY", AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2022, the Sangguniang Bayan thru Vice Mayor Josephine C. Tiu received a letter of even date from the Local Chief Executive of Barugo, Leyte, Hon. Aron C. Balais, M.D., FPCEM, requesting for a Resolution and Ordinance for the establishment of an Infirmary of the Local Government Unit of Barugo, Leyte, to be named as "Barugo Municipal Infirmary;

WHEREAS, the establishment and construction of a municipal infirmary with qualified/trained personnel as well as the provision of primary care facilities with 24-hours emergency and observational care, including diagnostics services, laboratory services and medicine dispensary under the PhilHealth e-Konsulta, are part of the improvement of the health services and local revenue measures of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Barugo, Leyte. For the past years, records from the RHU show that the average monthly referrals from the Municipality of Barugo, Leyte ranged from 80 to 100 patients, some of them lost their lives while in transit, while most of them are poor. To minimize, if not eliminate referring the patients to other health facilities, 15 minutes to 1 hour away from the municipality for hospital confinement, it became necessary and appropriate to establish an Infirmary in the municipality. This health facility will address the alienation that many of the locals experience while they bring their sick loved ones to a place knowing no one and bringing with themselves nothing;


WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7610) provides that, "Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom...xxx...and those which are essential to the

promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety...xxx...preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of R.A. 7160 provides that "Every LGU shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its services requirements and financial capability, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission";

NOW THEREFORE:

ON MOTION of Hon. Nikkos Rhet V. Astorga, jointly seconded by Hon. Eduardo C. Cazita and Hon. Clinio A. Balais, resolved as it is hereby resolved to pass this Resolution Enacting an Ordinance Establishing an Infirmary in the Local Government Unit of Barugo, Leyte, To Be Named as "Barugo Municipal Infirmary", and Appropriating Funds Therefor.

ORDINANCE NO. 16, S. 2022

(Sponsor: Hon. Nikkos Rhet V. Astorga)

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honourable Members of the Sangguniang Bayan of Barugo. Leyte on its Regular Session assembled, to wit:

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Establishing the Barugo Municipal Infirmary".

SECTION 2. ESTABLISHMENT OF THE BARUGO MUNICIPAL INFIRMARY. — There shall be established a government-owned Infirmary of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Barugo, Leyte, classified as Other Health Facility, particularly as a Category A: Primary Care Facility - Infirmary with in-patient beds for Infirmary/Dispensary and Birthing Home and without beds for medical out-patient clinics, OFW clinics and Dental Clinics, as well as Category B: Diagnostic/Therapeutic Facility with a laboratory and ionizing machines, pursuant to the Department of Health (DOH) Administrative Order No. 2012-0012, known as the "Rules and Regulations Governing the New Classification of Hospitals and Other Health Facilities in the Philippines and the DOH-Food and Drug Administration Guidelines on the License To Operate";

SECTION 3. INFIRMARY PERSONNEL. – The Barugo Municipal Infirmary shall have an adequate number of qualified, trained and competent staff, subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission and Republic Act No. 1080, to ensure efficient and effective delivery of quality of services:

Said various plantilla positions under the Infirmary of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Barugo, Leyte are created by virtue of the Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 184 and approved by the Local Chief Executive of Barugo, Leyte. The duties and functions of the newly created plantilla positions were determined by the Local Chief Executive, in coordination with the Municipal Health Officer, consistent with or in accordance with the general functions provided for by the Civil Service Commission.

SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS. – Funding shall be appropriated by the LGU of Barugo, Leyte, as follows:

Project/Activity Description 1. Construction of the Barugo Municipal	Municipal Fund
Infirmary	20% Development Fund under the Annual Investment Program for CY2023
Newly created plantilla positions listed in the preceding Section 3 hereof	Annual General Fund Budget for CY2023
3. Medical Equipment/Supplies, Dental Equipment/Supplies, Laboratory Equipment/Supplies, Office Equipment/Supplies, Utilities (Water, Electricity, Telephone, Internet and Cable) and other expenses required for the establishment of the municipal Infirmary	Annual General Fund Budget for CY2023

SECTION 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. - If, for any reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid by competent authority, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. REPEALING CLAUSE. - All Ordinances, Resolutions, Local Executive Orders and/or Administrative Orders, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with or contrary to any of the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval.

RESOLVED FURTHER, to furnish copies of this Ordinance to the Local Chief Executive of Barugo, Leyte, the Municipal Health Officer of Barugo, Leyte and to the Honourable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte for their information and approval.
