MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 07 Series of 2022

AN ORDINANCE IMPOSING NEW RATES FOR THE USE OF THE WATERWORKS SYSTEM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATALOM, LEYTE.

Sponsor: Hon. Joseleo W. Dances

WHEREAS, Section 129 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that "each local government unit shall exercise its power to create its own sources of revenue and to levy taxes, fees and charges subject to the provisions herein, consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy. Such taxes, fees and charges shall accrue exclusively to the local government units";

WHEREAS, Section 132 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 states that "the power to impose a tax, fee or charge or to generate revenue under this Code shall be exercised by the Sanggunian of the local government unit concerned through an appropriate ordinance";

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase the current rates for the use of the waterworks system in the municipality to generate more income and to sustain the operation of the Matalom Municipal Waterworks System;

NOW WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises, the Sangguniang Bayan during its regular session assembled and on motion of Hon. Joseleo W. Dances, duly seconded by all members present, be it

ENACTED, AS IT IS HEREBY ENACTED to approve and adopt the Municipal Ordinance imposing new rates for the use of the waterworks system in the municipality.

SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Imposing New Rates for the Use of the Waterworks System of the Municipality of Matalom".

SECTION 2. SCOPE. This Ordinance shall cover the collection of charges fees of all services rendered by the MMWS in the Municipality of Matalom.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. Any interpretations to the contrary notwithstanding, the terms hereof shall mean:

- a. Water system a system of the entire water works components which provides water supply from the water source to the distribution, maintenance and the administration of the Matalom Municipal Waterworks System (MMWS) within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality;
- Water consumption a quantitative portion of water, utilized by the consumer/concessionaire, generated from the standardized water meter that is subject for the computation of the account for the water monthly due;
- c. Water rate the charges made for the use of water from the water supply;

- d. Consumer/concessionaire person, natural or juridical who has water service connection and/or concession from the water supply, either classified as residential, commercial, industrial or institutional;
- e. Residential connection service water connection intended for domestic or family use;
- f. Commercial/industrial connection service water connection intended for business or venture or for business that involves manufacturing of goods;
- g. Institutional/government connection service water connection intended for religious, educational, social or for similar purposes;
- h. Seniors citizens those residents of the Municipality of Matalom, who aged 60 years and up, as certified by the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development through the Office of the Senior Citizens Affairs;
- i. Persons with disability those residents of the Municipality of Matalom, who are physically or mentally impaired that has a substantial and long-term adverse effect on their ability to carry out normal day-to-day activities, as certified by the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development through the PWD Focal Person:

SECTION 4. IMPOSITION OF NEW RATES. The fees and charges herein shall be collected for the water service rendered by the Matalom Municipal Waterworks System (MMWS) of this municipality.

SECTION 5. In the incident where there is a leak, a maximum of 2 months bill with irregular high water consumption will be adjusted. This will be done upon the report of the concessionaire to the MMWS Office & upon the office verification thru inspection. The adjustment shall be computed based on the average of the latest 3 months bill with regular water consumption

SECTION 6. In case of water interruption with a duration of at least 1 week, the bill shall be based on the actual consumption. This shall be done upon the issuance of a letter from the MMWS signed by the MMWS head and Mayor, furnished copy to the MTO for reference.

SECTION 7. In case a person or company causes damage to the water system lines and reservoirs, they shall be held liable for the cost of the repair that would include the materials, labor and the cost of water waste.

SECTION 8. DISCOUNTS. There is hereby a five percent (5%) discount applied to the total water bill for every water meter registered in the name of Senior Citizens and PWD. Provided that, the monthly water consumption shall not exceed thirty (30) cu.m. per month. For the excess of the thirty (30) cu.m. per month, regular water rate shall automatically apply.

SECTION 9. ACCOUNT UPDATES. To continue in availing the discount, the senior citizen or person with disability shall bring a photocopy of his/her identification card (ID) and present himself/herself personally at the MMWS Office to fill out an Update Form, which shall be done on his/her birthdate. In case the SC/PWD is unable to present himself/herself in the MMWS Office, a representative may come who shall bring an authorization letter and a photocopy of identification card (ID) of the senior citizen/PWD. Strictly no renewal, no discount policy.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations, or part thereof, in conflict with, or inconsistent with any provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
