

ORDINANCE TO DEVELOP EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR BABATNGON RESIDENTS.

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution states that "The State shall promote a just and dynamic social order that will ensure the prosperity and independence of the nation and free the people from poverty through policies that provide adequate social services, promote full employment, a rising standard of living, and an improved quality of life for all."

WHEREAS, Section 391 (a) (1) of the Local Government Code provides that "(a) The Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall: (1) Enact ordinances as may be necessary to discharge the responsibilities conferred upon it by law or ordinance and to promote the general welfare of the inhabitants therein;"

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State to develop the municipality into a self-reliant and independent economic unit by generating employment for its constituents.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Babatngon, Leyte in session assembled:

SECTION 1. Title of the Ordinance. This ordinance shall be known as the "Employment Opportunity Ordinance of Municipality of Babatagon."

SECTION 2. Coverage. All employment opportunities to be engaged or contracted out by commercial establishments such as private ports and terminal, oil depot, filling/gas stations, warehouses, factories, restaurants, department stores, groceries, sari-sari stores, auto-repair shops; institutions like hospitals, schools, public and private offices; industrial and agricultural establishments (hereinafter collectively called as the "establishments") of any kind situated within the territorial jurisdictions of Babatngon, Leyte.

SECTION 3. Creation of Municipal Employment Task Force. As a vehicle for consolidation and unification of efforts in addressing the problem on unemployment, the municipal hereby creates the Municipal Employment Task Force which will lead and supervise in the implementation of the municipal employment program. The Task Force will be responsible in managing the human resource of the municipal and in facilitating skills development/training programs for the municipal workforce. It shall be composed of the following:

SECTION 4. Roles, Functions and Responsibilities of Municipal Employment Task Force. The following are the roles, functions, and responsibilities of the Municipal Employment Task Force:

- 1. Identify employment opportunities in the establishments situated in Babatagon and effectively endorse qualified resident applicants of the municipality for employment.
- Accept and assess applications for employment for the purpose of identifying and managing a work pool that will ultimately be endorsed to establishments in Babatngon that needs employees/workers.
- 3. Coordinate with Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), Local Government Units (LGUs), Non-Government Organizations (NGOs) or other government recognized training centers implementing skills development/training programs, for the endorsement of qualified and interested applicants residing in Babatngon for skills development/training.
- 4. Source support for the implementation of municipality employment program.
- 5. Lead the information, education, communication, and monitoring activities for the advancement of the program.

SECTION 5. Support from the LGU. To effectively implement the roles and responsibilities of the Municipal Employment Task Force, the following are the support and assistance to be provided by the Municipality:

- a) Use of the Municipal Building and vehicle for Municipal Employment Task Force; and
- b) Provide transportation allowance of Municipal Employment Task Force members in supervising its activities.

SECTION 6. Right of First Refusal. The provisions of the laws to the contrary notwithstanding, all kinds of establishments situated in Babatngon shall give priority to its residents the engagement of their services for employment.

SECTION 7. Condition for the Issuance of Municipal Clearance/Business Permit. As a condition for the issuance of municipal clearance/business permit, the applicant establishment must have served a notice of vacancy with the Municipal Employment Task Force and, whenever necessary, must show proof that a publication for employment vacancies at the establishment site with standard message like "JOB VACANCIES; APPLY INSIDE; MUST BE A RESIDENT OF BABATNGON, LEYTE" or such other messages of similar import has been made until such vacancy has been filled up.

SECTION 8. Penalty. Any establishment who violates the provision in Section 6 hereof, without giving the municipal residents the opportunity to exercise its right of first refusal shall be denied application for municipal clearance/business permit.

SECTION 9. Separability Clause. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstances is declared unconstitutional, the remainder of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected by such declaration.

SECTION 10. Repealing Clause. All existing ordinances and resolutions of this municipality found to be inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect after ten (10) days from the date of its approval and posting in three conspicuous places in the local government unit.
