**SECTION 1. Title.** This Ordinance shall be known as, "AN ORDINANCE RECOGNIZING THE OUTSTANDING TEACHER 1, TEACHER 2, TEACHER 3, AND MASTER TEACHERS IN ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MACARTHUR, LEYTE"

**SECTION 2. Coverage.** The granting of the awards will only be bestowed to two qualified teachers in Teacher 1, Teacher 2, Teacher 3, and Master Teacher category in Elementary and Secondary public school in the Municipality of MacArthur who displayed exemplary excellence in teaching field. Each category will have two awardees coming from the Public Elementary and Secondary Schools of MacArthur, Leyte.

**SECTION 3. Definition of Terms.** For the purpose of this ordinance the following term are hereby define:


- a. Recognition- is an acknowledgement, a prize or other mark of recognition given in honor of an achievement.
- b. Teacher - is one that teaches; especially the one whose occupation is to instruct.
- c. Master Teacher - is one who has mastered the basics of teaching, one who goes above and beyond to ensure a positive learning experience for each student, and one who shares his or her knowledge with the broader learning community.







d. Elementary Education – also called primary education. This is the first stage of education traditionally found in formal education, beginning at about age 5 to 7 and ending at about age 11 to 13.

e. Secondary Education – it is the stage of education following the elementary education. Students usually begins about age 11 to 13 and ending usually at age 15 to 18.

f. Public Schools– it is a school that runs on public funds, usually government– imposed taxes. It is free of charge to everyone and offers inclusive education.

g. Screening Committee– is a group of capable individuals that are tasked to examine and evaluate the nominees in order to choose the awardee of a specific category.

SECTION 4. Objectives. The objectives of this ordinance are as follows:

a. To recognize exemplary and outstanding public-school teachers on their valuable contributions in the advancement and promotion of functional and effective teaching.

b. To create an environment that allows growth, recognition, appreciation and quality; and

c. To give teachers a motivation to work harder.

SECTION 5. Incentives to Recognized Teacher. Awardees will be given a Plaque, a Certificate of Recognition, and Ten Thousand Pesos cash (Php10,000.00) incentive in recognition of their exemplary work in their fields. Applicants will also receive a certificate to recognize their participation in this ordinance











1. Any public school teachers may apply for the awards.
