Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 4, S. 2022-2025 of the SB of Villaba, Leyte, with the following comments/recommendation:

1. That ordinance No. 4 S. 2022-2025 mandates "compulsory Registration and Licensing of single Motorcycle for hire";
2. That in case the driver of the Motorcycle for Hire is the operator or owner thereof, Section 6 of the Ordinance requires the possession of "Permit to Drive", and the payment of "License Fee";
3. That Ordinance No. 4, S. 2022-2025 however, is NOT signed by the Local Chief Executive (LCE), nor "VETOED", which signature is mandated under Section 54 (a) of the Code if he approves the Ordinance, or VETO message if he disagree;
4. That pursuant to Section 54 (b) of the Code, the VETO Message shall be communicated within Ten (10) days from receipt of the Ordinance, otherwise, the same shall be deemed approved as if he had signed it;
5. That pursuant to the "CERTIFICATION" issued by the SB Secretary dated February 1, 2023 attached to the ordinance, subject ordinance No. 4, S/. 2022-2025 was submitted and received by the Office of the municipal mayor on September 22, 2022;
6. That in view of the foregoing, Ordinance No. 4, S. 2022-2025 of the SB of Villaba, Leyte, is recommended for declaration of validity pursuant to its power under Section 56 © of R.A 7160, the same being, to the opinion of the Provincial Legal Office (PLO), an exercise of the power authorized under Section 447 (3), (vi) of the Code, subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation (DOTr). Provided, That, the requirement of "Permit to Drive and the payment of "License Fee", does not violate any Rules Policy or Regulation of the Land Transportation Franchising and Regulatory Board.

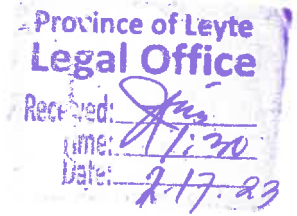

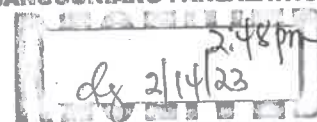


PREFATORY MESSAGE



At the time that the motorcycle was put on the market in the Philippines, many people in the cities working a kilometer or more away from their homeplace went for it, not because they could not afford to buy a car, but by preference. They appreciated and enjoyed the travel open air along the road, escaping traffic congestion and arriving much earlier at their work site. In plain language, the major purpose of their having a conveyance of this like is purely for ease and freedom of movement.


In the later years, several of the motorcycles were converted into passenger vehicles and, in this regard, the city governments concerned took advantage of the situation and contemplated a timely exercise of authority over the innovation by passing a measure to govern the business initiative of utilizing this means of transportation.

The above scenario also came to pass in this municipality. Some government employees assigned in the field activities, a number of businessmen in the locality, a few professionals and other persons captivated by the vogue at this certain period, made use of a motorcycle for personal service. It did not take long that other individuals wanted to own a motorcycle just for curiosity.

From then on, especially, from around the year 2010 to date, the motorcycles in Villaba, have been employed to the advantage of picking up passengers in the same way that it is done in the urban areas.

Unlike the conveyance business of using the motorcycles in those places, the drivers of these vehicles in this town are running their occupation of carrying passengers without a cent accruing in the local treasury because of the absence of a statute created to address this matter, hence the need for an enabling instrument.

RESOLUTION NO. 30 S, 2022-2025

A RESOLUTION ADOPTED TO ENACT ORDINANCE NO. 4, S. 2022-2025

WHEREAS, Section 447, (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 (R.A. 7160) gives authority to the Sangguniang Bayan, as the law – making body of the municipality, to enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code;

WHEREAS, Section 444, (b), (3), (IV) of the same Code mandates that as necessity for efficient, effective, economical functioning and governance, the municipal mayor shall issue permits or licenses and suspend or revoke the same for any violation of the conditions upon which said permits or licenses had been issued pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREAS, the single motorcycles are originally designed and deemed to be driven on the road, street or any public way only for personal or family use;

WHEREAS, it is a common knowledge that up until now said vehicles are utilized to carry goods and farm products besides passengers, from one place to another within the territorial jurisdiction of this municipality with pay;

WHEREAS, the fact that the power to regulate the operation of the tricycle which is a motorcycle per se with the sidecar as its contrivance for transporting passengers, has been devolved by the Local Government Code to the city and municipal governments, thus, by implication, the Sanggunian can also have a source of strong influence to manage the transit system of the single motorcycles,


WHEREFORE, on motion by the Hon. Rogelio J. Baay, Sangguniang Bayan Member, duly seconded en masse, Be it

RESOLVED, as the Sangguniang Bayan hereby resolved, that Ordinance No. 4, S. 2022-2025 be enacted, to wit:





Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan in regular session assembled that:

Section 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as a “Municipal Ordinance Instituting the Compulsory Registration and Licensing of Single Motorcycles Used as Passenger Vehicles in the Municipality of Villaba, Regulating Their Operation and Imposing Penalties for Every Violation Thereof”.

Section 2. Scope – Covered by this ordinance are the single motorcycles operated along the municipal roads, streets and other public ways within the territorial boundaries of LGU – Villaba and the required imposition of permits / licenses, fees and other related charges. This ordinance shall also take as reference and implementing guide the approved Municipal Ordinance No. 104, S. 2019 in terms of the operational provisions that pertain to these aforementioned passenger vehicles which are already incorporated therein, as well as the municipal Ordinance No. 118 S. 2020 relative to the route plan about the passage of tricycles, motorized pedicabs and other motor vehicles on the national road/highway.



Section 3. Definition of Terms. – The following terms, as used in this ordinance, shall be interpreted to mean as follows:

- a) **Compulsory Registration** – the required official recording of names, items and other data before any transaction or activity is being undergone
- b) **Institution** – an organization or foundation, especially one dedicated to public service. The term also refers to the building or buildings housing such an organization or foundation.
- c) **Issuance of Permit** – the act of granting a document as certificate, agreement, etc. allowing permission or license to do something
- d) **Public Way** – a street, road or thoroughfare in a town
- e) **PUV** – Public Utility Vehicle; a vehicle in the service of the public
- f) **Single Motorcycle** – a vehicle with two wheels similar to a bicycle but larger and heavier, propelled by an internal – combustion engine and which does not have a cab or sidecar attached to it
- g) **Territorial Boundaries** – the limits or borders that enclose or surround the land area of the local government unit of Villaba, Leyte
- h) **Transit System** – the process or act of conveying persons or goods from one place to another
- i) **Validity of Permit** – the inclusive dates that determine the effectivity period of the issued document, as certificate, permit or license.

Section 4. Distinction and Clarification. – Motorcycle - for – hire is distinct from passenger motorcycle on the following grounds, to wit:


a) Motorcycle – for – Hire

On one hand, the term “hire” as defined in the dictionary, means to pay for the use of something for a specified time. It is synonymous to the word “rent”. For this reason, the motorcycle – for – hire is available for use in exchange for payment. The payment for hiring the motorcycle would depend upon the agreement between the owner of the vehicle and the renter.

This motorcycle may be hired to transport goods or merchandise, farm products and other things for a pay but it has no definite point of travel.

b) Passenger Motorcycle

On the other hand, the word "passenger" signifies a person riding in, but not driving a car, bus, van, tricycle and other PUV's. Passenger motorcycle, therefore, is a vehicle for carrying passengers from one place to another. It has a specific and regular route and destination with suitable fare.

Nevertheless, whether motorcycle – for – hire or passenger motorcycle, both are subject to the provisions of this ordinance and the application herein of the term "single motorcycle" shall be referable to these.

Section 5. The Urgency of Registration. – Any person who owns a single motorcycle operated through the transportation facilities of LGU – Villaba shall legitimately be obligated to have his unit registered in the Office of the Municipal Mayor prior to engage in a course of action that involves the generation of income.

The requisite for registration are the following:

1. An official paper declaring legally valid the ownership of the single motorcycle to be registered.
2. The unit, during inspection, shall be in commission or in good working condition.
3. Applicant to drive a single motorcycle must be physically fit and possessed of knowledge, skill and experience in driving this kind of vehicle, with driver's license issued by LTO.

Section 6. Registration, Permit and Other Charges. – This ordinance sets down (puts in writing) hereunder the obligations of the single motorcycle operator and driver before performing their chosen livelihood, as:

A. Single Motorcycle Operator













If the operator/owner of the single motorcycle is, at the same time, the driver of his vehicle, he shall, equip himself with a permit to drive by paying the license fee of one hundred fifty pesos (₱150.00)

Section 7. Number and License Plate. – This plate shall have within itself the single motorcycle number and the sticker which points out precisely the year that the

license/permit was acquired and determines whether or not said license/permit is current or updated.

Section 8. Issuance of Permit. – After a thorough examination of the unit to be registered and payment of the registration fee, the applicant shall be issued a permit by the Office of the Municipal Mayor, which permit shall serve as the unit's proof of registration for the current year.

Section 9. Validity of Permit. – The permit to be issued under this ordinance shall be valid only for one (1) year from the date it was issued and must be renewed every year thereafter within twenty (20) days from the date of expiration in the succeeding year.

Section 10. Other Regulatory Provisions. – To make certain an orderly travel on the streets, roads and other public ways in the municipality of Villaba, especially one that is free from danger, risk, or threat of harm, every single motorcycle driver shall abide by the rules set in the approved Municipal Ordinance No.104, S. 2019, the amended traffic ordinance of the LGU. It shall be mandated by this upcoming single motorcycle regulation that such provisions as those that relate to this kind of conveyance which are embodied in the above – mentioned ordinance be strictly observed, namely:

A. One-Way Routes, Section 5, Article II (Under Traffic Control)

a) The direction from the corner of Cong. Alberto S. Veloso and Aurelio L. Veloso Streets going to the intersection of Aurelio L. Veloso and Zulueta Streets, turning left to the intersection of Zulueta and Andres Gervacio Streets, turning again left and moving onward to the intersection of Andres Gervacio and Cong. Albert S. Veloso Streets, keeping right to Rizal Street up to the corner of Bartolome Esmas Street, shall be a One – Way Route.













b) The portion from the intersection of Bartolome Esmas and Andres Gervacio Streets to the intersection of Andres Gervacio and Cong. Alberto S. Veloso Streets is also one-way for all motor vehicles and potpot, except heavy equipment enumerated in Section 10, Article III and buses, Provided, That there shall be no blowing of horns, or using any signaling device that produces a loud tone within the vicinity of the Roman Catholic Church.

Every driver shall drive along the One Way in the direction as shows by the arrow in the traffic sign.

B. Parking, Section 7, Article II (Under Traffic Control)

a. The parking area for all passenger vehicles shall be the terminal at the reclamation site at Poblacion del Sur.

b. Section 9, Article II (Under Prohibited Act)

This provision, as applied to the single motorcycle ordinance, strictly prohibits the parking of any motor vehicles, whether private or passenger/public utility, panel, delivery truck, bicycle, animal –drawn device, push cart and other forms of conveyances on the one-way or through streets in the municipality. Corollary to this rule, the one-way road in the business establishment sector from the intersection of Aurelio L. Veloso and Zulueta Streets up to the intersection of Andres Gervacio and Cong. Alberto S. Veloso Streets shall rigidly be a NO PARKING ZONE.

C. Loading and Unloading, Section 8, A, Article II (Under Traffic Control)

The passenger or public utility vehicles, including potpot, may load and/or unload on the right side of the one-way and non-one-way streets six (6) meters from the corner within a time limit not exceeding fifteen (15) minutes.

D. Speed Limit, Section 13, Article II (Under prohibited Act)

Motor vehicles, upon entering the town proper, are not allowed to speed up to more than twenty (20) kilometers per hour. This speed shall be maintained all along except on the National Road from Crossing, Suba to Villaba Vocational High School wherein the speed limit is thirty (30) kilometers per hour in order to prevent accident.

E. Section 23, Article IV (Integrated Provision)

There shall be no other waiting area for Public Utility Vehicles and passengers aside from the TERMINAL in Brgy. Poblacion del Sur. However, for purposes of this ordinance, the stopping place for taking on and letting off passengers for single motorcycles in the municipality shall be the four (4) designated areas, namely:












- 1) In front of the municipal building
- 2) In front of the DPWH,
- 3) An area in the municipal park facing the Holy Child Parish Ground, and
- 4) The Terminal.

Section 11. Penalty. – a) It shall be deemed liable for any person to undergo punishment as he commits any of the following acts:

1. Operating/driving a single motorcycle without a permit and not having settled other concomitant dues;
2. Operating/driving a single motorcycle outside the streets, roads and areas designated in the Municipal Traffic Ordinance (Ordinance No. 104, S. 2019) and Municipal Ordinance No. 118, S. 2020 relating to the route plan on the National Road/Highway;
3. When caught up in a tangible actuation of violating the rest of the provisions of this ordinance, including those that are incorporated herein.

The above-stated offenses shall, hereby, be penalized as follows:

First Offense	-	₱300.00
Second Offense	-	₱500.00
Third Offense	-	₱700.00
Subsequent Offenses	-	₱1,000.00



b) **Other Punishable Act.** – Any person found allowing or tolerating the use of his single motorcycle to load passenger or be hired without a permit/license as necessitated in this ordinance shall be inflicted a fine of not less than three hundred pesos (P300.00); and the person driving this unregistered vehicle shall also be exacted an equal fine of three hundred pesos (P300.00)

Section 12. Final Provisions

- A. **Repealing Clause.** – All existing ordinances, resolutions, executive orders, rules and regulations, or parts thereof, which are inconsistent with this ordinance shall hereby be amended, repealed or modified accordingly.
- B. **Separability Clause.** – Should any part or provision of this ordinance be found unconstitutional or invalid by a court of law, such part or provision shall be severed from this ordinance and such action shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining parts or provisions.
- C. **Effectivity Clause.** – This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval and being published in a newspaper of general circulation.
