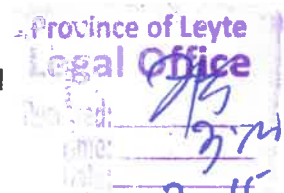

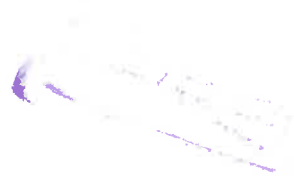

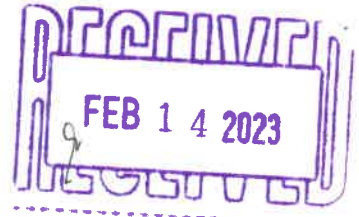

"AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, LEYTE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF".

PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, in Article 2, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution, the state shall recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being and shall inculcate in the youth the patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10742 or otherwise known as the SK Reform Act of 2015 amending Republic Act No. 8044 otherwise known as the "Youth in Nation-Building Act" both give recognition to the youth's responsibility to fulfil their vital role in nation building and in RA No. 10742, Section 25 thereof provides "There shall be in every province, city and municipality a Local Youth Development Office which shall be headed by a youth development officer with the rank of at least division chief. Such may be put under the Office of the Local Chief Executive, the Office of the Planning and Development, the Office of the Social Welfare, or in any other office deemed appropriate by the local government unit. If the funds of the local government unit are sufficient, it can be a separate department with divisions and units for policy and planning, administration and finance, and programs and operations. In the event when the local government unit has exceeded the prescribed personal services limitations, the local chief executive may designate existing personnel whom he or she deems fit to serve this purpose until such time that the local government unit can already create this office, and in Section 26 of the same Act, it provides: The local government unit shall incorporate in its annual budget such amount as may be necessary for the operation and effective functioning of the Local Government;

WHEREAS, the realities and circumstances faced by the youth of today put them at high risks that will adversely affect their future, and these risk behaviors are beyond the control of the youth themselves and therefore require whole and comprehensive package of,

interventions especially policy and program interventions of the government, whether national or local;

WHEREAS, this policy intervention for the youth is a sustainable development measure taking note and ensuring that the care and focus for the youth today will secure the long-term development goals and a protection measure to ensure that the young generation will be prepared for the responsibility in the future;

WHEREAS, the development of the youth sector in the Municipality of Kananga is one of the priorities in terms of the promotion of their general welfare, as well as the youth's participation and development;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Brenzon C. Cabintoy, duly seconded by All Sangguniang Bayan Members, be it;

RESOLVED, to enact:

"AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE LOCAL YOUTH CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, LEYTE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF".

Be it ordained by the 23RD Sangguniang Bayan session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "Kananga Municipal Youth Code Ordinance of 2022."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It shall be the policy of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte to promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well-being of the Filipino youth, inculcating in the patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civil affairs. As such, it shall also be the policy of the municipality to:

- (a) Recognize, promote, and strengthen the role of young people in the overall human and socio-economic development of the country not only in the future but also in the present;
- (b) Recognize and promote the responsibility of the state to create and sustain an enabling environment for young people to enable them to achieve their development aspirations and potentials as well as mobilize them to positively contribute to the development of the nation;
- (c) Promote and protect the human rights of all individuals including the youth particularly in their exercise of their rights to sexual and reproductive health, equality and equity before the law, the right to development, the right to education, freedom of expression, the right to participate in decision-making, and the right to choose and make responsible decisions for themselves;
- (d) Ensure corresponding interventions that could respond to the socioeconomic, health and emotional needs of the youth, especially young women, with due regard for their own creative capabilities, for social, family and community support, employment opportunities, participation in the political process, and access to education, health, counselling and high-quality reproductive health services;
- (e) Encourage young parents to continue and finish their education in order to equip them for a better life, to increase their human potential, to help prevent early marriages, high-risk child-bearing and repeated pregnancy and to reduce associated mortality and morbidity through comprehensive social protection interventions;

(f) Recognize and promote the rights, duties and responsibilities of parents, teachers, and other persons legally responsible for the growth of young people to provide, in a manner consistent with the evolving capacities of the young, appropriate direction and guidance in all matters relevant to their growth and development; The municipality shall establish adequate, effective, responsive and enabling mechanisms and support systems that shall empower the youth and ensure their meaningful participation in local governance and in nation building.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. As used in this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

(a) Annual Barangay Youth Investment Program (ABYIP) - shall refer to the yearly program based on the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan. It shall contain the specific programs, projects, and activities with corresponding project costs including the necessary fund flows to approximate the reasonable timing in the release of funds;

(b) Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan (CBYDP) - shall refer to the three-year comprehensive youth development plan of the Sangguniang Kabataan that is formulated by the SK councils in consultation and with concurrence of the Katipunan ng Kabataan (KK) and anchored on the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and other Local Youth Development Plan (KMYDP);

(c) Kananga Municipal Local Youth Development Plan (KMYDP) - shall refer to the local youth development plan as initially drafted by the SK Pederasyon, finalized by the KMYDC and approved by the Sanggunian. The KMYDP shall be anchored on the Philippine Youth Development Plan (PYDP) and other local development plans of the municipality;

(d) In-School Youth - refers to a youth attending either formal school or non-school-based educational programs under institutions recognized by the state.

(e) Out-of-School Youth - refers to youth not enrolled in any formal or vocational school, not employed or self-employed, and who is not college or technical/vocational school graduate.

(f) Youth with special needs - refers to youth who suffered physical impairments, which include but not limited to those who are drug dependents, in conflict with the law, and those caught in armed conflicts.

(g) Working Youth - refers to youth who are employed either on a regular or temporary basis.

(h) Youth - Republic Act 10742 or the "Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015" refers the youth to those persons whose ages range from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old as defined in Republic Act No. 8044.

(i) Youth Serving Organization - shall refer to those registered organizations or institutions whose principal programs, projects and activities are youth-oriented and youth-related.

(j) Youth Organization - shall refer to those organizations whose membership/composition are youth.

(k) Kananga Youth Development Office – this is an office of the LYDO.

(l) Kananga Municipal Youth Development Council - shall be composed of at least ten (10) but not more than twenty-one (21) members including the two (2) core members of the SK and at least eight (8) but not more than nineteen (19) other representatives from established youth.

(m) Sangguniang Kabataan - is a council meant to represent the youth in each barangay in the Philippines.

(n) SK Federation – composed of different SK Chairperson in the municipality.

SECTION 4. KANANGA MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM – The Local Government of Kananga hereby established the Kananga Municipal Youth Development Program that will promote the total well-being among the young people and ensure a holistic or balanced formation and development among the young people. The Kananga Municipal Youth Development Program shall implement programs that will respond to the concerns of the youth serving organization, youth organization, Children in Conflict of the Law, Children in Street Situation, in-school youth, out of school youth, the working youth, youth with special needs, and other youth sub- sectors and also pro- active enough to advance the welfare of the young people and empower them to effectively make life choices and decisions.

SECTION 5. CREATION OF THE KANANGA MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL (KMYDC). The Kananga Municipal Youth Development Council (KMYDC) shall be created as policy, coordinating and monitoring body on all youth programs, projects and activities. The KMYDC shall formulate policies and plans that will promote the total development and uphold the rights of the youth in the municipality. Further, the KMYDC shall establish a coordinating mechanism for all entities implementing youth programs, projects and activities and shall monitor implementation of said youth development programs, projects and activities. The said creation shall also ensure wide and multi- sectoral youth participation in local governance.

SECTION 6. OBJECTIVES. - KMYDC shall have the following objectives:

a.) General Objectives:




1. To develop and harness the full potential of the youth as responsible partners in nation-building;
2. To encourage intensive and active participation of youth in all government and non-government programs, projects, and activities affecting them;
3. To harmonize and synergized all government and non-government initiatives for the development of the youth sector; and
4. To supplement government appropriations for youth promotion and development with funds from other sources;

b.) Specific Objectives:

1. To broaden and strengthen the services provided by the national government agencies, local government units and private agencies to young people;
2. To provide information mechanism on youth opportunities on the areas of education, employment, livelihood, physical and mental health, capability-building and networking;
3. To increase the spirit of volunteerism among the youth of the municipality particularly in the maintenance of peace and order and preservation, conservation and protection of the environment and natural resources within their locality;
4. To provide monitoring and coordinating mechanisms for youth programs, projects and activities; and
5. To provide venue for the active participation of the youth in cultural and eco-tourism awareness program.



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SECTION 7. COMPOSITION OF THE KANANGA MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL - The KMYDC shall be composed of at least ten (10) but not more than twenty-one (21) members including the two (2) members from the SK. The two (2) members of the SK shall refer to the president and vice-president of the concerned Pederasyon and shall be supported by at least eight (but not more than nineteen (19) other representatives from registered youth organizations or youth serving organizations, provided that all other incumbent SK officials shall not be eligible as member of the KMYDC. The KMYDC shall be composed of the following:

Chairperson: Pambayang Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan President

1ST Vice Chairperson: Pambayang Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan Vice-President

2nd Vice Chairperson: To be elected from members of KMYDC.

Secretary: To be Elected from members of KMYDC.

Members: Locally registered or recognized YSO and YO under Kananga Youth Development Council.

The members of the KMYDC shall be appointed thru Executive Order issued by the concern Local Chief Executive and shall hold a term of three (3) years co-terminus. The Local Youth Advisory Council (LYAC) under Section 16 of this ordinance is given authority to issue guidelines to clarify the processes and mechanisms in constituting the KMYDC.

In the absence of the SK officials, the KMYDC members shall elect among themselves the Chairperson and 1ST Vice Chairperson of the Council. Upon the election and qualification of the SK Federation President and Vice- President, those elected by the council shall automatically relinquish their respective posts to the SK officials. The full council shall elect the Second Vice Chairman and Secretary from among the members of the KMYDC and those elected shall sit for a term of three years.

SECTION 8. QUALIFICATIONS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE KMYDC - a member of the KMYDC shall possess the following qualifications:

- (a) Must be a citizen of the Philippines;
- (b) Must be resident of Kananga, Leyte for not less than one year immediately preceding the day of his/her election to the KMYDC;
- (c) Must be at least 15 years old but not more than 30 years old on the day of his/her election at the council;
- (d) Must be able to read and write Filipino, English or the local dialect; and
- (e) Must not have been convicted by final judgment of any crime involving moral turpitude.

SECTION 9. MANNER OF ELECTING THE MEMBERS OF THE KMYDC - Within forty five (45) days after the SK Elections, the Local Youth Development Officer or LYDO shall notify all the presidents or authorized representatives of the registered/ recognized youth organizations and or youth serving organizations in Kananga, Leyte, assemble them in a public venue, and by consensus or secret balloting, they shall choose their respective representatives to the KMYDC.

For the first election of the members of the KMYDC, after the passage of this ordinance, the Kananga Youth Advisory Council shall convene the KMYDC subject to the requirements in Section 12 and Section 24 hereof. The Kananga Youth Advisory Council

shall draft further implementing guidelines necessary for the proper constitution of the KMYDC.

SECTION 10. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF THE KANANGA MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL - The following shall be the functions of the KMYDC:

(a) Formulate a Kananga Municipal Youth Development Plan (KMYDP) in consultation with all registered/recognized youth organizations; The KMYDP shall be initially drafted by the respective SK Pederasyon and shall be finalized by the KMYDC. This shall be submitted to the Kananga Youth Advisory Council for endorsement to the Municipal Mayor and for inclusion in the Local Development Plan and subsequently endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for review and approval. This plan shall give priority to programs, projects and activities that will promote and ensure the meaningful youth participation in nation-building, sustainable youth development and empowerment, equitable access to quality education, environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth employment and livelihood, health and anti-drug abuse, gender sensitivity, social protection, capability building and sports development;

(b) Monitor and evaluate the implementation of the Kananga Municipal Youth Development Plan;

(c) Formulate policies and component programs in coordination with the various government agencies handling youth-related programs, projects and activities:

(d) Facilitate municipal wide trainings, lectures and seminars and or including conduct of summer youth camp of all Sangguniang Kabataan and all other youth organizations that shall develop leadership abilities, orient the applicability of all laws relative to the organization, enhance organizational and managerial skills, and evolve a sustained development-training program.

(e) Provide support for the development and coordination of youth projects and design strategies to gain support and participation of the youth;

(f) Coordinate and harmonize activities of all agencies and organizations in the municipality engaged in youth development programs, projects and activities;

(g) Assist the SK Officials in ensuring the implementation of policies, programs and projects in the ABYIP and CBYDP;





(h) Assist various government and non-government agencies in the identification and nomination of qualified youth participants to different programs, projects and activities including the nomination of delegates to the National Youth Parliament;

(i) Recommend youth programs and project proposals to appropriate government agencies and non-government organizations that are designed to enhance the social, political, economic, cultural, intellectual, moral, spiritual and physical development of the youth;

(j) Facilitate conduct of research on various areas necessary for planning and policy formulation on youth development including the gathering of necessary data for preparation of local youth situationer;

(k) Oversee and monitor the functionality of the Sangguniang Kabataan including the regular conduct of meetings among the SK's and recommend incentives programs for outstanding SK or recommend disciplinary actions to erring or non-performing SK Officials;

Officials;



(l) Based on the annual and end of term program accomplishments submitted by the SK, conduct a review and study on how the 10% budget allocation for the youth projects and activities are spent by the barangay's and recommend to the Kananga Youth Advisory Council appropriate actions;

(m) Develop livelihood training programs such as capacity building training and seminars, youth cooperative development, pilot areas for youth base livelihood projects, and Inter-agency linkages;

(n) Initiate advocacy workshops on moral recovery program, good governance, anti-drug abuse, new politics, environmental awareness climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction and resiliency, youth employment and livelihood, adolescent sexual and reproductive health, gender and sexuality, protection from different types of abuses, and youth participation in local governance;

(o) Come- up with youth agenda and empowerment and network building which shall involve consultation and convention and summer youth camp program;

(p) Coordinate with other agencies whether government or private for youth welfare and development.

(q) Establish youth centers as deemed necessary;

(r) Advocate for youth representation in local special bodies and nominate to the Municipal Mayor youth representatives to such local special bodies; and

(s) Perform such other functions as may be provided by law or delegated by DILG, NYC, LCE, Sangguniang Bayan and KYDO.

SECTION 11. CREATION OF COMMITTEES -The KMYDC may create committees, regular or adhoc that shall perform and oversee specific tasks of the council.

SECTION 12. ACCREDITATION/REGISTRATION OF YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS - All youth organizations and youth serving organizations, with a minimum number of ten (10) members in good standing and which are operating in Kananga, Leyte shall register with the Kananga Youth Development Office.

The LYDO shall endeavor to create a database and directory of all youth organizations in the Municipality. It shall facilitate the creation of organizations and cause the creation of federations, when and where possible. The LYDO shall assist the organizations to apply for accreditation with the local government.

Pursuant to the implementing rules and regulations of RA 10742, the LYDO shall send a list of registered and verified youth organizations and youth serving organizations to the National Youth Commission (NYC).

Registered organizations under this Section shall renew their local registration and verification every three (3) years. The LYDO shall conduct a continuing registration procedure taking into consideration the budgetary and manpower requirements and the presence of youth and youth serving organizations. Local registration and verification of youth organization and youth serving organization is a condition precedent for participation in the KMYDC elections. However, if a youth organization or youth-serving organization is denied local registration and verification, such organization can apply for special registration and verification with NYC subject to the mechanisms and procedures issued by NYC. Such special registration entitles the organization to participate in the KMYDC elections.

SECTION 13. INCENTIVES AND PRIVILEGES OF YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS AND ASSOCIATIONS - Any youth organization/association existing within Kananga, Leyte shall register with the KYDO to be entitled of incentives and privileges arising from this ordinance. After three (3) years of effectivity of this ordinance, only those registered by the municipality can qualify for the incentives and privileges including representation in other special bodies.

SECTION 14. INTERNAL RULES AND PROCEDURES OF KMYDC - The first set of KMYDC shall formulate the internal rules and procedures to govern the meetings of the council. The internal rules shall provide for the following:

- a) Regular and special meetings;
- b) Quorum;
- c) The order and calendar of business for each meeting;
- d) Parliamentary procedures which shall include the conduct of all its members during the meeting;
- (e) The manner of making decisions and approving resolutions;

Such other measures as the council may adopt.



SECTION 15. MEETINGS OF THE KMYDC - The Council shall meet at least once every quarter or as often as maybe deemed necessary. If the president or vice-president of the SK Pederasyon fails to convene the KMYDC meeting as scheduled, at least one-third of the total membership of the KMYDC may call for a meeting or the Kananga Youth Advisory Council may convene the KMYDC as third and last option. In the above instances, a written notice shall be sent, either through traditional or non-traditional means to all members setting the date, time, place and agenda of the meeting.

The Chairman shall preside in all council meetings. In his absence, the first vice-chairman and the second vice chairman, in succession shall preside. In instances where the meeting is called by at least one-third of the total membership or by the Kananga Youth Advisory Council, the members present shall elect their presiding officer of such meeting. The presence of the majority of all members of the KMYDC shall constitute a quorum.

SECTION 16. NON-PARTISAN NATURE OF THE KMYDC - The KMYDC shall not allow itself to be used for the purposes of partisan politics and shall adopt measures to ensure that it is adequately shielded from any political partnership or influence.

SECTION 17. KANANGA MUNICIPAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PLAN- The council shall formulate and adopt a three-year Kananga Municipal Youth Development Plan, which shall be duly supported by a resolution sponsored by the Chairman on Youth Development in the Sangguniang Bayan. The said plan shall be the basis for the implementation of youth development projects and services in coordination with the concerned agencies.

SECTION 18. FUNDINGS - The LGU- Kananga shall appropriate an amount through Youth Development Fund amounting to One Million Pesos (Php.1,000,000.00) annually for continuous operation under the Kananga Youth Development Office or KYDO for purposes of Youth Empowerment and Development Project/ Programs and Activities.



SECTION 19. CREATION OF THE KANANGA YOUTH ADVISORY COUNCIL (KYAC)

There shall be a Kananga Youth Advisory Council created to be composed of the following:

Chairman: Municipal Mayor

Vice Chairman: KMYDC Chairman

- Members:
- Municipal Social Welfare & Development Officer
 - Municipal Population Officer
 - Municipal Health Officer
 - Municipal Sports Coordinator
 - Municipal Budget Officer
 - Municipal Accountant
 - Local Youth Development Officer
 - DEPED Division Superintendent or duly authorized
 - Liga Ng Mga Barangay President
 - Vice Chairperson Committee on Youth Development
 - Chairman on Committee on Sports
 - Chairman on Committee on Education,
 - Chairman on Committee Culture & Arts and Heritage
 - Public Employment Services Officer (PESO)
 - Two (2) representatives from CSOs/NGOs
 - Two (2) representatives from faith-based communities

The representatives from the civil society organizations (CSO) or NGO's and the faith-based communities shall be chosen from those organizations with youth programs. The said representatives shall be appointed by the Municipal Mayor for a term of three (3) years co-terminus. As much as practicable, the members shall attend personally the meetings of the Council. Should a representative be designated, he/she shall be the next-in-rank.

SECTION 20. FUNCTIONS OF THE KYAC – The Kananga Youth Advisory Council shall perform the following functions:

- (a) Act as consultative body for the issues and concerns gathered by the KMYDC and act on matters referred by the KMYDC;
- (b) Endorse the Kananga Municipal Youth Development Plan to Sangguniang Bayan for review and approval and finally adoption to the Local Development Plan;
- (c) Review and approve all guidelines, rules and regulations prepared/drafted by the KMYDC;
- (d) Assist the KMYDC in mobilizing resources for the youth programs, projects, activities and services;
- (e) Ensure that the projects identified by the KMYDC are included in the respective plans of the agencies;

- (f) Monitor the implementation of youth programs, projects and activities;
- (g) Approve all the guidelines developed by the KMYDC including the guidelines for selection of delegates for the AMYP;
- (h) Perform such other functions as the Municipal Mayor may request from time to time.

SECTION 21. CREATION OF KANANGA YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (KYDO) - The LYDO shall be created under the Office of the Mayor as the implementing arm of the KMYDC and KYAC. It shall perform the policy and planning, administration and finance, programs and operations and other functions necessary in pursuing youth empowerment and development. It shall perform the following duties and functions:

- a. To perform the secretariat functions of the KMYDC and KYAC and act as the implementing arm of the Local Government of Kananga on the decisions of the KMYDC and the KYAC;
- b. To serve as a liaison of the Local Government of Kananga to the agencies and organizations involved in youth development programs and be able to mobilize resources to implement projects and activities for the youth at the barangay level;
- c. To encourage and assist in organizing the youth at the community level and assist the youth organizations in their application for accreditation with the local government;
- d. Hold an annual parliament for the youth to generate policy recommendations and nominate to the KMYDC delegates to the national parliament and other conventions;
- e. Conduct trainings and seminars for the youth such as leadership training's, skills development trainings including the conduct of summer camps for the youth;
- f. Assist the youth organizations in their advocacy and activities;
- g. Perform such other functions that the KMYDC and KYAC may assign from time to time.

SECTION 22. LOCAL YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICER - There shall be a created a position of Local Youth Development Officer I with Salary Grade 10 shall be hired (designate or appointed) to manned the Local Youth Development Office and take the lead in carrying out the mandate of the said Office.

The LYDO may be augmented through any or a combination of the following options:

- a) Designation or assignment of personnel to the LYDO in concurrent capacities with their existing positions;
- b) Reassignment of personnel of the municipality to the LYDO; and
- c) Full-time or part-time detail of existing personnel to the LYDO.

SECTION 23. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS OF YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICER- The Local Youth Development Officer shall perform the following functions:

- (a) In accordance with Section 12 of this ordinance, register and verify youth and youth-serving organizations;
- (b) Provide technical assistance to the KMYDC in the formulation of the KMYDP;
- (c) Facilitate the election of the KMYDC representatives;
- (d) Serve as secretariat to the KMYDC and KYAC;

- (e) Conduct the mandatory and continuing training of SK officials and KMYDC members, In accordance with the programs jointly designed and implemented by the NYC and the DILG. The local youth development officer and/or his or her staff shall apply for accreditation from the Commission in order for them to conduct the mandatory and continuing training programs of SK officials and KMYDC members.
- (f) Provide technical, logistical and other support in the conduct of the mandatory and continuing training programs, and to such other programs of the NYC and DILG;
- (g) Coordinate, monitor and update youth development programs;
- (h) Submit regular reports on status of youth plans and programs to the KMYDC and the KYAC;
- (i) Serves as Liaison Officer of the Municipality to relevant national and local agencies and public and private institutions involved in the youth programs and activities;
- (j) Coordinate with the NYC, with regard to the youth programs in Kananga, Leyte; and
- (k) Perform such other functions as may be prescribed by law, ordinance, or as the LCE, the DILG or the NYC may require.

SECTION 24. QUALIFICATIONS OF YOUTH DEVELOPMENT OFFICER -In addition to the requirements prescribed by the Civil Service Commission (CSC), the youth development officer shall:

- (a) Be preferably not more than thirty years of age at the time of her/his appointment;
- (b) Be of good moral character;
- (c) Must have acquired experience in youth development affairs involvement in youth or youth serving organizations for at least three (3) years;
- (d) He or she shall be appointed by the Municipal Mayor but in no case is he or she be within the fourth civil degree of consanguinity or affinity of the appointing authority; and
- (e) Must be at least a Bachelor's Degree holder.

SECTION 25. ANNUAL MUNICIPAL YOUTH PARLIAMENT (AMYP) - There shall be an annual youth parliament to be held every August of each year to be organized by the Local Youth Development Office to discuss issues and problems among the youth and to come up with policy recommendations that will guide the KMYDC in the development of plans and programs. Participants to the AMYP shall be selected based on guidelines prepared by the KMYDC and approved by the Kananga Youth Advisory Council.

SECTION 26. SUBMISSION OF REPORTS - All SK Chairpersons and Youth Organizations accredited and or recognized shall submit their monthly and annual accomplishment reports to the LYDO for proper monitoring and assesment of functionality.

SECTION 27. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS - the Kananga Youth Advisory Council is granted authority to issue rules, regulations or guidelines, when necessary to carry out or implement the provisions in the ordinance.

SECTION 28. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other policies or ordinances creating organizations, councils or boards in the municipality, which exist having similar programs with the Kananga Municipal Youth Development Council, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 29. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or

provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and in effect.

SECTION 29. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after the publication of a local newspaper.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, to furnish copies of this ordinance one each to the Municipal Mayor; the Municipal Administrator's Office; the Human Resource Management Office; the Municipal Budget Office; the Municipal Accountant;; the National Youth Commission Office; the Liga Ng Mga Barangay Office; DILG and other concerned offices all in Kananga, Leyte;

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN ON
OCTOBER 18, 2022 AT THE MUNICIPAL GYMNASIUM, KANANGA, LEYTE FOR THE
FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES, TO WIT:**

1. Ordinance No. 23L.23-023(*renumbered from Draft Ordinance No. 22L.21-060*)- An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Kananga Tourism Office (KTO) Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof.
2. Ordinance No. 23L.23-024(*renumbered from Draft Ordinance No. 22L.22-081*) – An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation of Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof.
3. Ordinance No. 23L.22-011- An Ordinance Creating the Local Youth Code of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and Providing Funds thereof.
4. Ordinance No. 23L.22-012- An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) of the Sangguniang Kabataan of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and for such other purposes.

The Public Hearing was conducted by the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan spearheaded by the Office of the Vice Mayor thru Facebook Page, SB Committee on Tourism, SB Committee on Youth Development, SB Committee on Barangay Affairs, SB Committee on Rules and Laws and SB Committee on Transportation and Communication. The Public Hearing was attended by the Punong Barangays of the 23 barangays of the municipality, SK, Head Teacher of the Kananga Central School, Chief of Police James Mark Ruiz, Habal-habal Drivers of the different barangay. It was open at 9:30 in the morning with an opening prayer led by Hon. Sabiano L. Ablen, Punong Barangay of Barangay Lonoy and Sound System for the singing of the Philippine National Anthem. The SB Chairman of the Committee on Barangay Affairs Hon. Nilo Gonzaga acted as the master of the ceremony, after his introductory message the SB Secretary Atty. Allan Castro presented and discussed the provisions per section of the said ordinance, Ordinance No.22L.21-060 entitled "An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Kananga Tourism Office (KTO) Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof".

Atty. Castro said that the Office of the Kananga Tourism is the first office in the municipality presented their own official logo.

The second ordinance was *An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation of Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof*. That was presented and discussed by Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon(SK Fed. President) by section. There is no question/suggestion raised over this ordinance.

The third ordinance was *An Ordinance Creating the Local Youth Code of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and Providing Funds thereof*. That was presented and discussed again by the SK Fed. President Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon. Suggestion raised over this ordinance by the following person.

Ms. Mapple Jelyn C. Elbina(DILG Staff) suggested to the SKs, Youth Organization to institutionalizing of Annual Monitoring/Annual functional assessment of SK shall be integrate every year.

Raymond John Lonzaga suggested to require all SKs and Youth Organization to submit their Monthly and Annual Accomplishment Reports, Monthly Reports and end-of-term program accomplishment based on the plans containing PPAs.

The fourth ordinance was *An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) of the Sangguniang Kabataan of Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and for such other purposes*. That was presented and discussed by Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon (SK Fed. President) by section. There is no question/suggestion raised over this ordinance. However, Chief of Police James Mark C. Ruiz discuss the important and purpose of the said ordinance.

Chief Ruiz said that this Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) was launched in 2019, to support the advocacy campaign of PNP in collaboration with DILG, PDEA, SK and AFP in combating terrorism and illegal drugs problem in the community. He said that he was surprise because why it is this ordinance propose only this time since the targets of this major problem are the youth. He asked the cooperation of the Local Government Unit, Youth Organization for the implementation of this program of course with the aid of the LGU. For the implementation of this ordinance we will be holding dialogues, lectures through the Sangguniang Kabataan and public schools to educate our youth not to fall deceitful or involved the activities of the NPA. He finally called out the KKDAT members, youth organization to organize various activities in their barangay like community service and tree planting to keeps the youth away from illegal drugs and being recruited by the NPA.

The closing and final message was rendered by Hon. Miguel Jorge P. Tan-Municipal Vice Mayor and public hearing formally ended at 12:14 in the afternoon.
