**"AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERRORISMO (KKDAT) OF THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OF MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, LEYTE AND FOR SUCH OTHER PURPOSES"**

### PREFATORY STATEMENT

**WHEREAS**, in Article 2, Section 13 of the 1987 Constitution, the state shall recognize the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being and shall inculcate in the youth the patriotism and nationalism, and encourage their involvement in public and civic affairs;

**WHEREAS**, the existence of the Sangguniang Kabataan gives a meaningful participation in the development of an empowered society;

**WHEREAS**, Section 20 of Republic Act No. 10742, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015, provides that ten percent (10%) of the general fund of the barangay shall be set aside for the Sangguniang Kabataan which shall be disbursed solely for youth development and empowerment purposes;

**WHEREAS**, statistics based from the records of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) proves the fact that youths and innocent minors have been victims of illegal drugs related activities in the community, and languishing in a life deprived of liberty;

**WHEREAS**, the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terrorismo (KKDAT) has been successfully organized, designed to empower the youths, students, as well as, the out of school youths, basically to serve as pro-active partners of the government in the nationwide campaign against illegal drugs activities in coordination with the Philippine National Police (PNP), Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), and the Municipal Social Welfare Development Office (MSWDO), also in implementing programs involving anti-terrorism and social re-integration;

**WHEREAS**, the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT), should not only remain a mere program of the SK's, but rather, it has to be an active institution that spearheads the function for a total reformation of the youths, developing them into productive citizens in a holistic approach.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of SB Member Nilo Gonzaga, duly seconded by All Sangguniang Bayan Members, be it;

RESOLVED, to enact:

"AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTIONALIZING THE KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERORISMO (KKDAT) OF THE SANGGUNIAN KABATAAN OF MUNICIPALITY OF KANANGA, LEYTE AND FOR SUCH OTHER PURPOSES"

Be it ordained by the 23<sup>RD</sup> Sangguniang Bayan session duly assembled that:

**SECTION 1. TITLE-** This Ordinance shall be known as "Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) Ordinance 2022.

**SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY-** It is hereby declared to be the policy of the municipality to promote and protect the physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual and social well- being of Filipino youth, inculcating in them the patriotism and nationalism, and encouraged their involvement in public affairs. The Local Government Unit of Kananga, will recognized the vital role of the youth to become proactive partners of the government in the nationwide campaign against illegal drugs and anti- terrorism by giving the most effective approach and awareness program across the 23 Barangays through the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) program of the Sangguniang Kabataan.

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS -** For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

(a) KKDAT - shall refer to Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo.

(b) Youth - shall refer to those persons whose ages range from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years old as defined in Republic Act No. 8044. For the purpose of targeted programming for the youth, the age disaggregation shall be considered: 15-17 - child youth 18-24 - core youth 25-30 - adult youth;

(c) Youth Organizations - shall refer to those organizations whose membership composition are the youth;

(d) Youth-Serving Organizations - shall refer to those registered organizations whose principal programs, projects and activities are youth-oriented and youth- related, and whose composition are not limited to the youth. The organization shall be duly recognized or accredited by proper local government registering entities;

(e) Child / Children - refers to person below eighteen (18) years of age or those over but are unable to fully take care of themselves or protect themselves from abuse, neglect, cruelty, exploitation or discrimination because of a physical or mental disability or condition;

(f) Drug - any chemical substance which alters the mood and behaviour as a result of alterations in the function of the brain (*World health organization*);

(g) Anti-illegal drug operation - covers the intelligence or case build-up and/or negation operation for the arrest of violator/s and suppression, seizure or confiscation of dangerous drugs, plant sources of dangerous drugs, and controlled precursors and essential chemicals of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) and/or other law enforcement agencies in support of the PDEA, whether joint operation or not.

**SECTION 4. INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF THE KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERORISMO (KKDAT) OF THE SANGGUNIAN KABATAAN** - The implementation and adoption of the Kabataan Kontra Droga, at Terorismo (KKDAT) program in the annual 10% SK Funds in the Barangay is hereby institutionalized as a basic program of the Sangguniang Kabataan as part of its youth development programs in every calendar year and shall be adopted in the Annual Barangay Youth Investment Program (ABYIP) and the Comprehensive Barangay Youth Development Plan (CBYDP).

**SECTION 5. THE SALIENT FEATURES OF THE YOUTH KABATAAN KONTRA DROGA AT TERORISMO (KKDAT) PROGRAM**- to ensure appropriate implementation of the Kabataan Kontra Droga, at Terorismo Program, the Sangguniang Kabataan are enjoined to observe and adopt the salient features of this program, as follows:

a.) 5Cs of a Positive Youth Development

a. 1. Connection - a feeling of safety, structure and belonging, positive bonds with people and other social institutions.

a. 2. Confidence - a sense of self-worth and mastery, having a belief in one's capacity to succeed.

a. 3. Character - taking responsibility, a sense of independence and individuality, and connection to principle and values.

a. 4. Competence - the ability to act effectively at school, in social situations and at work.

a. 5. Contribution - active participation and leadership in variety of settings, making a difference.

b.) Republic Act 9165 - policy of the State to safeguard the integrity of its territory, and the well-being of its citizenry, particularly the Youth.

c.) History and Main Objective of KKDAT - aimed to be an organized youth movement that encourages and strengthens the youth's ability to minimize and or, gradually suppress the illegal drugs and terrorism problem in our country;

d.) Crime Situation and Statistical Overview of the Municipality of Kananga;

e.) Crime incidents involving youth

f.) Crimes victimizing youth

g.) Lecture on the ill effects of prohibited drugs through Republic Act 9165 or the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002".

h.) Violence against Women and Children (VAWC) Awareness Lecture

i.) Republic Act 8049 or the "Anti-Hazing Act of 1995"

j.) Republic Act 8353 otherwise known as the "Anti-Rape Law of 1997"

k.) Republic Act 9208 or the "Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003"

l.) Republic Act 10627 or the "Anti-Bullying Act of 2013"

m.) Republic Act 7877 of the "Anti-Sexual Harassment Act of 1995"

n.) Executive Order No. 70 series of 2018 - Institutionalizing the whole-of- nation approach in attaining inclusive and sustainable peace, creating a national task force to end local communist and armed conflict, and directing the adoption a national peace framework.

o.) Republic Act 8044 or the "Youth in Nation Building Act of 1995"

**SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTATION OF THE KKDAT PROGRAM** - The Sangguniang Kabataan Federation as the mother organization of the SK Councils across the 23 Barangays will spearhead the implementation of the KKDAT Program for the roll-out and also cascading across the 23 Barangays in a form of lecture, training, workshop, youth leadership summit or camp, and other educational setting, in partnership with the



Philippine National Police (PNP), Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), Municipal Social Welfare and Development Office (MSWDO), the Kananga Youth Development Office (KYDO), Youth For Peace and Development Movement, Inc., Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terrorismo (KKDAT) Municipality and or Provincial Chapter, and other youth organizations, government agencies and offices, if deemed necessary.

**SECTION 7. THE ROLE OF THE SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN** - To ensure holistic participation of the youth sector and the residents in the barangay, the Sangguniang Kabataan shall mobilize and organize activities in accordance to the salient features of the KKDAT Program and shall maximize if necessary a creative medium such as but not limited to Information Education Campaign and/ or youth for peace and development movement programs, community education and training for youth financial literacy and entrepreneurship, slogan making contest, poster making contest, mural painting, video documentary contest, jingle making contest, virtual or online contest, and other arts literacy activities or similar medium that highlights youth empowerment and youth development approaches.

**SECTION 8. FUNDING** - The funding of this Program shall be taken from the 10% SK Fund in the Barangay but the appropriated amount shall not be less than P20, 000.00, per year in the implementation of this Kabataan Kontra Droga, at Terorsimo Program. The aforementioned amount shall be utilized in the expenses that may be acquired for the implementation of their barangay-based lectures, seminars and trainings, projects and activities subject to existing auditing laws, rules, and regulations.

**SECTION 9. INFORMATION DISSEMINATION USING MULTIMEDIA PLATFORMS** - To ensure maximum audience reach among the youth sector in the grassroots level, multimedia platforms such as newspaper, radio, television broadcast, social media networking sites, and other forms of communication channels should be utilized to establish inspiration to more young people in the community and to create an enabling avenue that will serve as a credible source of information.

**SECTION 10. PARTNERSHIP TO OTHER STAKEHOLDERS AND NON-GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS** - Partnerships and collaborations to interested stakeholders and other non-government organizations may also be done as part of the interventions to strengthen and ensure the effectivity of the program.

**SECTION 11. CREATION AND ELECTION OF KKDAT CHAPTER IN THE BARANGAY** - There shall be in every barangay a KKDAT Chapter to be composed of a President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Auditor and Public Relations Officer. The election will be facilitated by the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) Officials. The SK Kagawad representing the Committee on Barangay Drug Abuse Council shall automatically serve as an ex-officio member of the board of officers in the KKDAT Barangay Chapter.

**SECTION 12. QUALIFICATIONS** - An official of the KKDAT, must be:

- a.) an active youth citizen of the Philippines at least 15 years old but not more than 30 years old;
- b.) a resident of the barangay for not less than one (1) year immediately preceding the day of the elections;
- c.) must be an active youth leader and is a member of accredited/ recognized barangay youth organizations or youth- serving organizations;
- d.) a model of integrity, discipline, excellence with a good moral character;
- e.) must have a sincere desire to serve and a passion to be an advocate in fighting illegal drugs and terrorism.

**SECTION 13. POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE KKDAT OFFICERS** - The officers of the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) in the Municipality and Barangay shall exercise the powers and discharge such duties as follows:

- (a) Take the lead in the cascading of policies and awareness campaign on the importance of the youth in nation building by teaching and empowering the students and youths to become proactive partners of the government in the nationwide campaign against drugs and terrorism.
- (b) Ensure the implementation of programs, projects, and activities of the Sangguniang Kabataan through the Committee on Drug Abuse Council and its advocacies.
- (c) Coordinate with the sangguniang barangay and other youth organizations within her/his barangay on youth-related programs and projects that they wish to initiate and implement; and
- (d) Exercise such other powers and perform such other duties and functions as may be prescribed in Republic Act 10742, otherwise known as the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 or delegated by the Philippine National Police, Sangguniang Kabataan Federation, Kananga Municipal Youth Development Council and Kananga Youth Development Office.

**SECTION 14. TERM OF OFFICE** - The Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo Officers Barangay and Municipality Chapter shall hold office for a fixed term of (3) years, starting 90 days after the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Election, unless removed for cause, permanently incapacitated, have died or resigned from office. Any elected KKDAT Officer who possesses all the qualifications and none of the disqualifications is eligible for re-election.

**SECTION 15. MANNER OF ELECTING THE OFFICERS OF THE KKDAT BARANGAY AND MUNICIPALITY CHAPTER** – Ninety (90) days prior to the end of term of office of the incumbent officers, the Local Youth Development Officer shall issue an advisory notifying all the KKDAT barangay chapter presidents for the conduct of special assembly for the purpose of electing new set of officers by consensus or secret balloting and likewise the elected KKDAT Barangay Chapter President will have its election for the federation 30 days after the Barangay Chapter Election for the purposes of electing the Federation President and officers in the Municipality Chapter. The Federation Presidents will set as automatic members of the Kananga Municipal Youth Development Council.

**SECTION 16. KKDAT KANANGA LEYTE CHAPTER** - there shall be an organization of the federation of the KKDAT to be known as KKDAT Kananga Leyte Chapter, which shall be composed of the KKDAT Barangay Chapter Presidents across the 23 Barangays.

**SECTION 17. MEETINGS AND ANNUAL GENERAL ASSEMBLY** - There shall be a meeting once in every two months in the barangay level and a general assembly every 3<sup>rd</sup> Monday of the Month of November every year while in the Municipal level the meeting will be quarterly held.

**SECTION 18. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** - if any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.


**SECTION 19. REPEALING CLAUSE** pertinent provisions of all other laws, ordinances, executive orders and rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.


**SECTION 20. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE** - this ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon its approval and after due compliance with all the requirements provided under R.A. 7160. Otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

**MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING HELD BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN ON  
OCTOBER 18, 2022 AT THE MUNICIPAL GYMNASIUM, KANANGA, LEYTE FOR THE  
FOLLOWING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES, TO WIT:**

1. Ordinance No. 23L.23-023(*renumbered from Draft Ordinance No. 22L.21-060*)- An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Kananga Tourism Office (KTO) Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof.
2. Ordinance No. 23L.23-024(*renumbered from Draft Ordinance No. 22L.22-081*) – An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation of Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof.
3. Ordinance No. 23L.22-011- An Ordinance Creating the Local Youth Code of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and Providing Funds thereof.
4. Ordinance No. 23L.22-012- An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) of the Sangguniang Kabataan of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and for such other purposes.

**(Attendance hereto attached)**

The Public Hearing was conducted by the Office of the Sangguniang Bayan spearheaded by the Office of the Vice Mayor thru Facebook Page, SB Committee on Tourism, SB Committee on Youth Development, SB Committee on Barangay Affairs, SB Committee on Rules and Laws and SB Committee on Transportation and Communication. The Public Hearing was attended by the Punong Barangays of the 23 barangays of the municipality, SK, Head Teacher of the Kananga Central School, Chief of Police James Mark Ruiz, Habal-habal Drivers of the different barangay. It was open at 9:30 in the morning with an opening prayer led by Hon. Sabiano L. Ablen, Punong Barangay of Barangay Lonoy and Sound System for the singing of the Philippine National Anthem. The SB Chairman of the Committee on Barangay Affairs Hon. Nilo Gonzaga acted as the master of the ceremony, after his introductory message the SB Secretary Atty. Allan Castro presented and discussed the provisions per section of the said ordinance, Ordinance No.22L.21-060 entitled "*An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Kananga Tourism Office (KTO) Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof*".

Atty. Castro said that the Office of the Kananga Tourism is the first office in the municipality presented their own official logo.

The second ordinance was *An Ordinance Adopting the Official Logo/Seal of the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation of Kananga, Leyte, Prescribing the Use and Imposing Penalty for Unofficial/Unauthorized Use Thereof*. That was presented and discussed by Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon(SK Fed. President) by section. There is no question/suggestion raised over this ordinance.

The third ordinance was *An Ordinance Creating the Local Youth Code of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and Providing Funds thereof*. That was presented and discussed again by the SK Fed. President Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon. Suggestion raised over this ordinance by the following person.

Ms. Mapple Jelyn C. Elbina(DILG Staff) suggested to the SKs, Youth Organization to institutionalizing of Annual Monitoring/Annual functional assessment of SK shall be integrate every year.


Raymond John Lonzaga suggested to require all SKs and Youth Organization to submit their Monthly and Annual Accomplishment Reports, Monthly Reports and end-of-term program accomplishment based on the plans containing PPAs.

The fourth ordinance was *An Ordinance Institutionalizing the Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) of the Sangguniang Kabataan of Municipality of Kananga, Leyte and for such other purposes*. That was presented and discussed by Hon. Jeffsbor G. Cuizon (SK Fed. President) by section. There is no question/suggestion raised over this ordinance. However, Chief of Police James Mark C. Ruiz discuss the important and purpose of the said ordinance.

Chief Ruiz said that this Kabataan Kontra Droga at Terorismo (KKDAT) was launched in 2019, to support the advocacy campaign of PNP in collaboration with DILG, PDEA, SK and AFP in combating terrorism and illegal drugs problem in the community. He said that he was surprise because why it is this ordinance propose only this time since the targets of this major problem are the youth. He asked the cooperation of the Local Government Unit, Youth Organization for the implementation of this program of course with the aid of the LGU. For the implementation of this ordinance we will be holding dialogues, lectures through the Sangguniang Kabataan and public schools to educate our youth not to fall deceitful or involved the activities of the NPA. He finally called out the KKDAT members, youth organization to organize various activities in their barangay like community service and tree planting to keeps the youth away from illegal drugs and being recruited by the NPA.

The closing and final message was rendered by Hon. Miguel Jorge P. Tan-Municipal Vice Mayor and public hearing formally ended at 12:14 in the afternoon.
