**WHEREAS**, on January 12, 2023, Thursday at 1:00 in the afternoon, a public hearing was held at the Centennial Building, Burauen Public Market this Municipality;

**WHEREAS**, in attendance were the drivers, stakeholders and the Presidents of the various associations of motorized tricycle for hire in the municipality appealing to the August Body to grant them an increase of fare considering the tremendous increase of the prices of fuel, oil and spare parts for the motorized tricycles, and likewise the increase on the prices of basic commodities due to the high inflation rate that affects both the local and the world market, which the members of the tricycle associations could hardly meet their daily sustenance or means of livelihood;

**WHEREAS**, the appeal of the different tricycle associations was properly addressed by the members of the Sangguniang Bayan in order to sustain the economic growth and development of this sector of the community;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Cipriano R. Relatorres, Jr., Chairperson, Committee on Transportation, Public Utilities and General Services, duly seconded by all Sangguniang Bayan Members present,

**BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Burauen, Leyte, in regular session assembled, that:

**SECTION 1 – Title.** This ordinance shall be called “AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RATE OF FARES FOR MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE OPERATING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURAUEN, LEYTE, AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 11-07, SERIES OF 2011”.

**Section 3 – Fare Matrix.** All franchised tricycle operators having been benefited by this ordinance are all deemed to have individually applied for a fare increase and shall pay to the Municipal Treasurer the corresponding fare matrix fee of **One Hundred Fifty Pesos Only (₱ 150.00)** for every unit, provided, that the operator/driver shall present documents showing proof that requirements to operate the business has been complied with.

The fare matrix must be in original copy which shall contain the franchise number/ side car number and QR code of the particular unit and shall be conspicuously displayed inside the vehicle or motorcycle. The unauthorized reproduction of the fare matrix is strictly prohibited.

**Section 4 – Penalties.** Any violation of this ordinance shall be penalized with FINES upon:  
a. First Offense - ₱ 500.00  
b. Second Offense - ₱ 1,000.00  
c. Third Offense (and subsequent offenses) – Cancellation of Motorized Tricycle Operators Franchise and Mayor’s Permit, and shall be banned for applying another franchise for period of one year.

**Section 5 – Repealing Clause.** Any existing ordinance the provisions of which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

**Section 6 – Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.



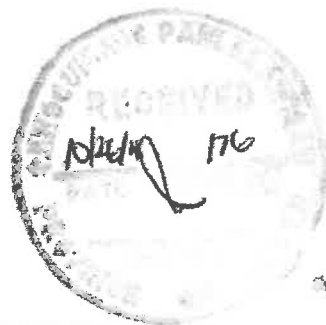

**WHEREAS**, in attendance during today's session were the Presidents of the various associations of motorized tricycle for hire in the municipality appealing to the August Body to grant them an increase of fare considering the tremendous increase of the prices of fuel, oil and spare parts for the motorized tricycles, and likewise the increase on the prices of basic commodities which the members of the tricycle associations could hardly meet their daily sustenance or means of livelihood;

**WHEREAS**, the appeal of the different tricycle associations was properly addressed by the members of the Sangguniang Bayan in order to sustain the economic growth and development of this sector of the community;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Honorable Marissa D. Carilla, Chairperson, Committee on Public Utilities, General Services and Public Safety, jointly seconded by all SB Members present,

**RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved, to enact the following ordinance, to wit:

**Section 1 – Title.** This ordinance shall be called “AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE RATE OF FARES FOR MOTORIZED TRICYCLES FOR HIRE OPERATING IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BURAUEN, LEYTE, AMENDING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 04, SERIES OF 2004”.

**Section 4 – Repealing Clause.** Any existing ordinance the provisions of which are inconsistent herewith are deemed repealed or modified accordingly.

**Section 5 – Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.







PUBLIC HEARING:

The public hearing started at 1:30 in the afternoon. Hon. Oscar A. Cagara led the prayer. Hon. Noel P. Alpino gave a short message afterwards. Hon. Alpino gave the floor to Hon. Cipriano R. Relatorres, Jr. for the public hearing proper.

Hon. Cipriano R. Relatorres, Jr. called the roll of the TODAs and drivers present and gave his message. He mentioned the fare that drivers illegally ask from their passengers which is ₱ 10.00 and above from the existing approved fee that is ₱ 8.00. He encouraged the drivers to avoid queues in prohibited areas and have a recognized and accredited association for them to have proper and legal terminal in their respective places.

The SB Members asked the group that improperly and illegally queuing along the one-way street at San Ramon St. in front of Fejuren Store to face the direction of Sto. Niño St. instead of San Agustin St., counter facing the said one-way street to give respect to the ordinance and enforcers present. Drivers agreed.

Senior Tourism Operations Officer II, Ms. Carmela Corazon A. Crebillo introduced to the MCH Franchisees/drivers/operators, the Bureau, Leyte's branding color and tagline sticker that is part of promoting the tourism industry. It will be put on the MCHs as the only decoration aside from the requirement of plain green color of MCHs and their police number. No fees to be collected on the stickers and will only be issued to the compliant franchisees.

The MCH drivers complained about the painting of MCHs numbers which was previously provided by the LGU until the demise of the painter. Hon. Cipriano R. Relatorres, Jr., moved to resolve the matter. Some MCH drivers asked and complained to the presiding officer on the additional fees imposed by the Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) on additional units and the transparency of the said fees on the official receipts issued. The presiding officer Hon. Relatorres told them to not pay without clear receipts.

Ms. Carmela Corazon A. Crebillo requested the *habal-habal* drivers taxing to Brgy. Mahagnaon to be presentable and groomed, and to be gentle with the tourist passengers in their driving. She added that their office can give t-shirts to the drivers.

Hon. Relatorres, stated that their job as legislators don't include apprehending violators. It's the job of the Philippine National Police.

He then showed the proposed fare matrix to the public.

Brgy. Buri TODA president, Solomon N. Parado, Jr., discussed the proposed fare to the actual fare they impose. They collect ₱ 20.00 on regular passengers, ₱ 10.00 on elementary pupils, ₱ 15.00 on Bureau National High School students and ₱ 20.00 to Bureau Comprehensive National High School, Eastern Visayas State University – Bureau Campus and Bureau Community College students.

Hon. Relatorres discussed the proposed fare matrix and acknowledged the request of Buri TODA fare imposed on succeeding kilometres reached provided that they will not abuse them. He also told everyone to follow laws on giving discounts to senior citizens.

Arado MCH driver (Quimbo) told the body their ₱ 18.00 - ₱15.00 fare to Arado/Tambuco and Balorinay regular passengers respectively contrary to the proposed fare matrix and discussed it with the presiding officer and resolved with the agreed computations.

The presiding officer Hon. Relatorres requested the drivers to not force the passengers with not enough money to give exact fares. The drivers agreed.

The EVSU – market group agreed with the proposed fare.

A driver complained on instance where mother and child passengers only give ₱ 10.00 for both. The presiding officer assured them that the approved matrix can solve their problems on such. Said matrix will be available at the BPLO and will be issued to compliant franchisees. Photocopying of the fare matrix is strictly prohibited by law. Sanctions will be imposed.

The discussion on the fare matrix went clear and resolved.

The presiding officer reminded the MCH operators and drivers who doesn't have a franchise to apply and for the existing to renew on time. He also reminded the Cantimawa, Lusad and other drivers to not queue on highways and main roads pursuant to Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) memorandum circular on road clearing. He also reminded them to stop the practice of using licensed driver on their application of franchise yet unlicensed drivers on the actual travel. The consequences of which and their obligations to the Land Transportation Office (LTO).

The presiding officer also discussed that there will be an increase in violation penalties from ₱ 50.00 - ₱ 100.00 of the existing ordinance to ₱ 500.00 minimum.

Majority of the operators and drivers agreed.

Hon. Relatorres discussed the franchising fees and penalties.

Hon. Relatorres encouraged the other drivers to have their own associations and have them accredited or recognized for their complaints to be heard officially.

The drivers mentioned on the pre-empted cash assistance from the Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE). The SB members present told them that they will issue resolution to DOLE following up about the cash assistance.

A driver asked them when would be the matrix be available? Hon. Relatorres told them the earliest possible would be February for the ordinance will undergo 3 readings.

Drivers raised their concern about the lightings in their terminal for it is dark at night, thus, they were transferred for the time being. The presiding officer sought for the Market Supervisor Mr. Nilo T. Ontimare for some queries but he was not around.

The drivers and the council also observed the terminal at the back of the office of the market supervisor being parked with private vehicles (cars) owned by stall owners. The purpose of the public terminal is defeated. The MCH drivers duly assigned on the said terminal complained to the presiding officer. The presiding officer assured them that the matter will reach to the Municipal Mayor and encouraged them to file their own complaint. Some of the drivers complained with their scattered queue areas. They want them on one centralized terminal.


A driver also complained on the fees he paid on one unit franchise different with the other unit he owns.


