MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 02 Series of 2023

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF A MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANT DEPARTMENT HEAD II (LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICER) - SG 23, PRESCRIBING ITS FUNCTIONS, DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF.

WHEREAS, Section 12 (a) (b), RA 10121 otherwise known as "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010 mandates that every Local Government Unit shall establish the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (LDRRMO) which shall be responsible for setting the direction, development, implementation and coordination of disaster risk management programs within their territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Section 76 of RA 7160 states that every local government unit shall design and implement its own organizational structure and staffing pattern taking into consideration its service requirements and financial capability subject to the minimum standards and guidelines prescribed by the Civil Service Commission;

WHEREAS, Section 447 (A) (1) of the same Code likewise authorizes the Sangguniang Bayan to determine the positions, powers, duties and salaries of officials and employees of the municipality;

WHEREAS, by virtue of Municipal Ordinance No. 11, series of 2021, the LGU has created the position of a Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer V (LDRRMO V) - SG 24 and processed the appointment of one of its employees to fill the said position;

WHEREAS, the appointment was disapproved as the position does not conform with the guidelines set by the NDRRMC/DILG/DBM/CSC through Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2014-1, dated April 4, 2014, which states that, if the LGU is financially capable and has not exceeded the personal services (PS) limitation, the local sanggunian, may elevate the grganization and staffing of the LDRRMO. LGUs shall be guided by the following standards on position titles and salary grades of Department Heads (DH), Assistant Department Head (ADH), and the highest positions below the ADH for third class municipalities:

NOW WHEREFORE, on motion en masse, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matalom, Leyte in session assembled that:

SECTION 1. CREATION OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ASSISTANT DEPARTMENT HEAD II (LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT OFFICER). The position of Municipal Government Assistant Department Head II (Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer) is hereby created with the corresponding salary grade 23.

SECTION 2. APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATION. The Municipal Government Assistant Department Head II (Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer) shall

be appointed by the Municipal Mayor, whose appointment shall be in accordance with the civil service laws and rules and that the appointee shall have met the following qualifications:

Education

: Bachelor's Degree

Experience : 3 years of relevant experience on DRRM : 16 hours of relevant training on DRRM

Training Eligibility

: Career Service Professional/ 2nd Level Eligibility

SECTION 3. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS. The Municipal Government Assistant Department Head II (Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer) shall be responsible for the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Design program and coordinate disaster risk reduction and management activities consistent with the National Council's standards and guidelines;
- b. Facilitate and support risk assessments and contingency planning activities at the local level:
- c. Consolidate local disaster risk information which includes natural hazards, vulnerabilities, and climate change risks, and maintain a local risk map;
- d. Organize and conduct training, orientation, and knowledge management activities on disaster risk reduction management at the local level;
- e. Operate a multi-hazard early warning system, linked to disaster risk reduction to provide accurate and timely advice to national or local emergency response organizations and to the general public;
- f. Formulate and implement a comprehensive and integrated Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Plan in accordance with the national, regional and provincial framework, and policies on disaster risk reduction in close coordination with the local development councils (LDCs);
- g. Prepare and submit to the local sanggunian through the LDRRMC and the LDC the annual LDRRMO Plan and budget, the proposed programming of the LDRRM Fund, other dedicated disaster risk reduction and management resources, and other regular funding source/s and budgetary support of the LDRRMO/BDRRMC;
- h. Conduct continuous disaster monitoring and mobilize instrumentalities and entities of the LGUs, Civil Society Organizations (CSOs), private groups and organized volunteers to utilize their facilities and resources for the protection and preservation of life and properties during emergencies in accordance with existing policies and procedures:
- i. Identify, assess and manage the hazard vulnerabilities and risks that may occur in their locality:
- j. Disseminate information and raise public awareness about those hazard, vulnerabilities and risks, their nature, effects, early warning signs and countermeasures;

- k. Identify and implement cost-effective risk reduction measures/strategies;
- Maintain a database of human resource, equipment directories, and location of critical infrastructures and their capacities such as hospitals and evacuation centers;
- m. Develop, strengthen and operationalize mechanisms for partnership or networking with the private sector, CSOs and volunteer groups;
- n. Take all necessary steps on continuing basis to maintain, provide or arrange the provision of, or to otherwise make available, suitably-trained and competent personnel for effective civil defense and disaster risk reduction and management in its area;
- o. Organize, train, equip and supervise the local emergency response teams and the accredited community disaster volunteers (ACDVs), ensuring that humanitarian aid workers are equipped with basic skills to assist mothers to breastfeed;
- p. Respond to and manage the adverse effects of emergencies and carry out recovery activities in the affected area, ensuring that there is an efficient mechanism for immediate delivery of food, shelter and medical supplies for women and children, endeavor to create a special place where internally-displaced mothers can find help with breastfeeding, feed and care for their babies and give support to each other;
- q. Within its area, promote and raise public awareness of and compliance with this Act and legislative provisions relevant to the purpose of this Act;
- r. Serves as the secretariat and executive arm of the LDRRMC;
- s. Coordinates other disaster risk reduction and management activities;
- t. Establish linkage/network with other LGUs for disaster risk reduction and emergency response purposes;
 - Recommends through the LDRRMC the enactment of local ordinances consistent with the requirements of this Act;
- v. Implement policies, approved plans and programs of the LDRRMC consistent with the policies and guidelines in this Act;
- w. Establish a Provincial/City/Municipal/Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center;
- x. Prepare and submit, through the LDRRMC and the LDC, the report on utilization of the LDRRMF and other dedicated disaster risk reduction and management resources to the local Commission on Audit (COA), copy furnished the regional director of the OCD and the Local Government Operations Officer of the DILG; and

y. Act on matters that may be authorized by the LDRRMC.

SECTION 4. BUDGET. The subject position shall be included in the plantilla of personnel and the corresponding appropriation for salaries and other incidental expenses shall be provided in the budget to be enacted by the LGU.

SECTION 5. TEMPORARY DESIGNATION OF PERSONNEL. In the absence of funds appropriated for the position herein created, the Municipal Mayor shall designate personnel who shall temporarily act on the duties and responsibilities prescribed for the said position.

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any section or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All Ordinances, local issuances or rules inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval and compliance with the mandatory posting and publication requirement prescribed under R.A. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government code of 1991.
