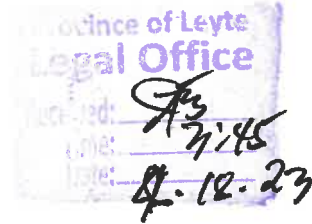

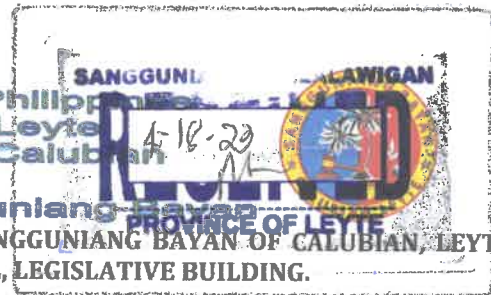

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE UTILIZATION OF PHILHEALTH MATERNITY CARE PACKAGE RECEIPT AND ACCRUING TO THE LGU TRUST FUND OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte in a session assembled, that :

SECTION 1. TITLE. *This ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE UTILIZATION OF PHILHEALTH MATERNITY CARE PACKAGE RECEIPT AND ACCRUING TO THE LGU TRUST FUND OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE.*

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

2.1 *It is the policy of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte to implement a Comprehensive and Integrated Maternal and Child Health Programs in order to ensure the welfare, and well- being of mothers and children in the Municipality.*

2.2. *It is likewise a declared policy of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte to ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities, particularly xxx Section 447 (a)(5) (xiv) of R.A. 7160 which provides that the Sangguniang Bayan shall enact ordinances which xxx Provide for the care of paupers, the aged, the sick, persons of unsound mind, disabled persons, abandoned minors, juvenile delinquents, drug dependents, abused children and other needy and disadvantaged persons, particularly children and youth below eighteen (18) years of age and, subject to availability of funds, establish and provide for the operation of centers and facilities for said needy and disadvantaged persons. Xxx;*

2.3 *The municipality of Calubian, Leyte supports the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PhilHealth) Program, which provides that all expectant mothers who are not yet PhilHealth members, to immediately enroll in the National Health Insurance Program to be automatically eligible for the benefits.*

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND APPLICATION. *This ordinance shall be adopted by the municipality and shall cover the implementation of the Maternal Care Incentive Program (MCIP).*

SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall be defined as follows:

- 1. Maternal and Child Health Care Program** - *includes the total packages of services provided to mothers and children. For mother- from prenatal, during delivery, up to the postpartum period. For children, it will include babies from birth up to one (1) year of age.*

2. **Birth Facility** - Shall refer to health facilities of the Municipality of Calubian duly accredited by PhilHealth, to render normal (uncomplicated) vaginal deliveries and new born screening services.
3. **Community Health Team** - A group of community health volunteers such as Barangay Workers (BHW), Barangay Nutrition Scholars (BNS), Barangay Service point Officer (BSPO) and Traditional Birth Attendants (TBAs) who provide support and assistance to expectant mother and their newborns before, during, and after delivery in the birthing facility.
4. **Skilled Birth Attendant** - according to World Health Organization (WHO) this refers to "an accredited health professional such as midwife, doctor or nurse who has been formally educated and trained to proficiency in the skills needed to manage normal (uncomplicated) pregnancies; childbirth and the immediate postnatal period, and in the identification, Management and referral of complications in women and newborns". Traditional Birth Attendants (TBAs) either trained or untrained are excluded from the category of skilled birth attendants.)
5. **Normal (uncomplicated) Delivery** - birth characterized by spontaneous onset of labor; low risk at the start of labor, throughout labor and delivery; infant in vertex position; and 37-42 weeks of completed pregnancy. For purposes of this ordinance, delivery shall include services for prenatal care, actual delivery, postpartum care and new born care.
6. **Basic Emergency obstetric and Newborn Care (BEMONC) Facility** - A BEMONC Facility provides maternal and newborn and newborn services to pregnant woman and should be reached within a travel time of thirty minutes. It is a well-equipped birthing facility, with competent and trained personnel to attend to the needs of the mother and newborn.
7. **"No Balance Billing" Policy** - shall mean that no other fees or expenses shall be charged or paid for by the Philhealth patient-member above and beyond the package rates.

SECTION 5. SHARING OF THE PHILHEALTH MATERNITY CARE PACKAGE RECEIPTS.

In compliance with Article VI (A) of PhilHealth Circular No. 022-2014, the following sharing scheme is hereby established in the utilization of the PhilHealth Maternity Care trust fund:

5.1 The 40% - Professional Fee

Forty Percent (40%) of the Maternity Care Package benefit payment collected from PhilHealth shall accrue to the Municipal Health Office as Professional Fee and shall be shared by the staff and personnel involved in the operation and maintenance of the facility, as follows:

- 70% - Shall be shared equally among accredited Midwives
- 12% - Shall be shared equally by other support personnel (Utility, RSI, Medtech, driver, Nursing aide, Laundry staff, PhilHealth Encoder, etc.)
- 9% - Shall be shared equally among accredited Physician (Municipal Health Officer/Rural Health Physician/Doctor to the Barrio)
- 9% - Shall be shared equally among accredited Nurses
- 100% - TOTAL

5.2 The 60% - Facility Fee

Sixty percent (60%) which represents the facility fee shall be utilized as follows

- 5% - DOH-HRH Incentive (NDPs & RHMPPs)
- 20% - Trainings and Seminars
- 10% - Barangay Health Worker Referral.
- 65% - Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses
- 100% - TOTAL

SECTION 6. ROLES & FUNCTIONS OF THE DIFFERENT KEY PERSONNEL OF LGU, CALUBIAN, LEYTE.

6.1 COMMUNITY HEALTH TEAM (CHT):

1. **Members of the CHT** shall tract all pregnant and postpartum mothers in their respective areas and report/refer the same to the health facility for prenatal, natal, and postpartum care.

2. They shall advocate for facility-based delivery.
3. They shall provide health education and counselling to pregnant woman utilizing the maternal and Child book and birth plan in their discussion.
4. They shall provide support and assistance to prospect mother from the prenatal, during the delivery and up to the postnatal period.

6.2 MUNICIPAL HEALTH OFFICE (MHO):

1. Shall perform the necessary BEMONC function and deliver quality maternal and newborn care to clients
2. During prenatal visit, health personnel shall provide counselling on the following:
 - a. Maternal Nutrition
 - b. Danger Signs of pregnancy
 - c. Things to prepare for delivery
 - d. Birth plan
 - e. Family support
 - f. New born care
 - g. Breastfeeding
 - h. Responsible parenting among others
3. Shall ensure that there is pregnancy tracking system in place
4. Shall render a twenty four hour (24 hours) duty, as scheduled. They shall be entitled to one (1) day off for every 24-hour duty rendered.
5. Shall ensure prompt referral of emergency cases to the next level of care as he may be (BHS to MHC to hospital). A property filled up referral; from shall accompany every referral; case. The facility shall maintain a logbook of referral cases
6. Shall be responsible to keeping the birthing facility/s functional at all times - with functioning equipment and adequate medical supplies. The MHO shall conduct Maternal Death Review (MDR) and Under Five Mortality Review (UFMR) as the need arises.
7. Shall ensure and maintain the cleanliness of its birthing facility/s. There should be proper disposal of sharp and infectious waste to include provisions for the disposal of the placenta.
8. Shall implement the PhilHealth Link Project to properly verify and identify patients for possible PhilHealth membership
9. Shall recommend future structural and capability expansion project of the birthing facility/s
10. Shall come up with the components of the prenatal kit, birthing kit, and newborn care kit to be given to the pregnant woman
11. Shall ensure par customer service experience to all clients of the birthing facility/s
12. Shall ensure that drugs medicine and supplies are at all times available in the birthing facility/s.
13. Shall ensure uninterrupted accreditation/licensing of the birthing facility/s and professional/s consistent with the requirements of government regulating agencies (e.g. PhilHealth, Department of Health etc.)
14. Shall endeavour keep abreast with the latest Philhealth policies, rules and regulation relating to the subject matter of this ordinance
15. Shall develop a system to expedite processing and submission of claims filed by PhilHealth member tot eh PhilHealth for prompt payment of PhilHealth benefits.
16. Shall expediently process necessary reports required by regulating agencies consistent with this purpose of this ordinance (e.g. PhilHealth, Department of Health, etc.)

6.3 LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) :

1. Shall facilitate prompt referral of unmanageable and life-threatening cases, the Municipal LGU shall ensure that there is an available transportation when needed. It shall provide adequate budget for fuel, maintenance and repair of ambulance.
2. Shall provide overall logistics and technical support for the successful implementation of the purposes of this ordinance
3. Shall advocate and champion in the registration of birth and marriages for purposes of declaration as qualified of the purpose of this ordinance
4. The Barangay LGUs shall provide necessary support to the pregnant women and their family in instance when the ambulance is not available, the Barangay LGU shall look

for ways and means to provide transportation for the pregnant woman, especially during emergencies

SECTION 7. TRANSITORY PROVISION. *PhilHealth Benefit Payment received before this ordinance shall be utilized according to the sharing scheme herein established. The unutilized balances of the 60% (facility fee) PhilHealth benefit payment receipts of every year shall accumulate automatically as fund solely for the Drugs/Medicines, medical supplies, equipment, and fixtures/furniture of which utilization shall be subject to the proposal submitted by Municipal Health Office and approved by the Local Chief Executive.*


SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. *If any of the provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid, other parts or provision that are not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force effect.*


SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. *All other ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders or rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.*


SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. *The ordinance shall take upon approval of the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.*






