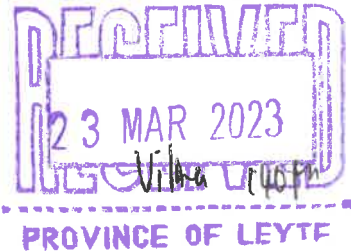

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ENTRY OF RIDER OR RIDING IN TANDEM OF MOTORCYCLES WITH CLOSED / TAINTED HELMETS & BONNETS OR CLOTHINGS AND ANY OTHER GADGETS THAT COVER HIS OR THEIR FACES UPON ENTERING BRGY. NIPA & BRGY. PETROLIO UNTIL BRGY. VILLALON, CALUBIAN, LEYTE & OR VICE VERSA.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte in a session assembled, that :

**SECTION 1. TITLE:** *This ordinance shall be known as " ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ENTRY OF RIDER OR RIDING IN TANDEM OF MOTORCYCLES WITH CLOSED / TAINTED HELMETS & BONNETS OR CLOTHINGS AND ANY OTHER GADGETS THAT COVER HIS OR THEIR FACES UPON ENTERING BRGY. NIPA & PETROLIO UNTIL BRGY. VILLALON, CALUBIAN, LEYTE & OR VICE VERSA ".*

**SECTION 2. RATIONALE.** *A It shall be also the basic policy of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte to regulate and implement traffic rules, policies & regulations for the convenience, security and protection of all concerned residents as provided under Section 447 (a)(5)(vi) of R. A. 7160.*

*B. The Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte is cognizant of the recent shooting incidents in the municipality which caused to the loss of lives of certain individuals, and the same is unresolved because, for one reason, the perpetrators can not be identified due to the wearing of closed/ tainted helmets, bonnets and cloth coverings or gadgets on their faces.*

*C. Section 447 of R. A. No. 7160 - Powers, Duties, Functions and Compensation xxx provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code, and shall: xxx (ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances;*

*D. The Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte has come up with a legislation to curtail this kind of serial fire arms shooting incidents and put the perpetrator (s) to pay a price of his / their crimes.*

**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.**

**A. Motorcycle (motorbike, bike, or trike (if three-wheeled))** *is a two or three-wheeled motor vehicle steered by a handlebar from a saddle-style seat. It is motorized two-wheeled vehicle used for transporting one or two riders, which is capable of the same speed as that of an automobile and can be licensed for public use;*

**B. Motorcycle bonnets or bonnets-** *a covering of the face used by motorcycle riders against dust and protection from crashes on the roads; It is a protective cover is made of high quality material, which is resistant to dirt and does not affect motorcycle engine speed.;*

**C. Motorcycle Helmet -** *is a type of helmet used by motorcycle riders. Motorcycle helmets contribute to motorcycle safety by protecting the rider's head in the event of an impact. They reduce the risk of head injury by 69% and the risk of death by 42%. Their use is required by law in many countries. Motorcycle helmets consist of a polystyrene foam inner shell that absorbs the shock of an impact, and a protective plastic outer layer;*

**D. Closed Helmets-** *are type of helmets which are closed and has no opening at the front;*

**E. Tainted helmets-** *are those type of helmets with tainted glass or blurred on the front side of the helmet;*

**F. Standard Protective Motorcycle Helmets -** *are those appropriate types of helmets for*

motorcycle riders that comply with the specifications issued by the Dept. of Trade & Industry (DTI);

G. Cloth covering or mask – a cloth protection from dirt, dust or virus;

H. Traffic – Movement of cars, motorcycles, trucks, vans, jeepneys, and other motor vehicles along a street, roads, highways or passages, subways, overpass, etc.;

I. Local Roads- refer to provincial roads, municipal and barangay roads;

J. Barangay Roads- refer to other public roads within the barangay and not covered in the definitions of provincial, municipal and city roads;

K. Citation ticket – is issued for the apprehended violator corresponding the amount of fines/ penalty imposed in this ordinance;

L. Traffic signs or signages- are those given symbols or written words in relation to traffic rules & regulations;

M. Municipal Streets - these are the streets or roads within the Town Proper such as San Juan Street, Sta. Felomina Street, San Roque St., Abuno St., San Isidro St., Majait., Seaside St., San Juan Extension and Agas Avenue;

N. Citations Tickets- shall be issued to the apprehended violators corresponding to the fines/ penalty imposed in this ordinance by the duly authorized PNP Officer of Calubian, Leyte;

O. Ord. No.2013- 02 of Calubian, Leyte is known as “ The Motorcycle Helmet Ordinance of the Municipality of Calubian, Leyte, Proving Penalties Therefore and for Other Purposes “;

P. Rider of Motorcycle- a person driving on a motorcycle;

Q. Riding in Tandem – two persons, one driving a motorcycle and the other one, back riding the same motorcycle, either related or not related with each other;

R. Muffler - a device to deaden noise especially : one forming part of the exhaust system of an automotive vehicle or motorcycle; and

S. Metro Calubian – for purposes of this ordinance, comprises the barangays of Cristina Garganera, Veloso, Mahait, Obispo, T. Poblacion, Espinosa, Cabalquinto, F.E. Marcos and Gutosan.

**SECTION 5. RESTRICTIONS.** Rider or Riding in Tandem of Motorcycles with Closed Helmets & Bonnets, or clothings and any other gadgets that cover his or their faces are hereby prohibited or restricted to enter and pass through Brgy. Nipa & Brgy. Petrolio until Brgy. Villalon and or vice versa.

**SECTION 6. OFFICIAL PASS OF ENTRY & EXIT OF RIDERS OR RIDING IN TANDEM OF MOTORCYCLES.** Upon taking out or stripping off of Helmets or Motorcycle Helmets, Bonnets or Motorcycle Bonnets or clothings and or gadgets of Riders or Riding in Tandem of Motorcycles covering his or their faces, an official printed pass for entry & exit duly signed or countersigned by the PNP Personnel delegated for the purpose at Brgy. Nipa & Brgy. Petrolio until Brgy. Villalon, Calubian, Leyte and or vice versa shall now be given & granted. The design and content of the official pass shall be provided by the Calubian Municipal Police Station personnel who are assigned / detailed at the designated checkpoints mentioned in this ordinance.

**SECTION 7. SUPPLEMENTARY CLAUSE.** The following are basic supplementary provisions to further enhance the implementation of this ordinance, to wit :

A. Riders or Drivers of the motorcycles shall also observe traffic rules and regulations as imposed by the Calubian PNP Personnel while within the vicinity or premises between the municipal roads of Brgy. Gutosan to Brgy. Obispo, Calubian, Leyte and or vice versa.

B. Riders or Drivers of motorcycles can not operate if they are under the influence of liquor or narcotic drugs while within the vicinity or premises between the municipal roads of Brgy. Gutosan to Brgy. Obispo, Calubian, Leyte and or vice versa.

C. Riders or Drivers of Motorcycles shall likewise observe the Specified Places where parking is prohibited and other related provisions pursuant to R. A. 4136 :

1. Parking prohibited in specified places- No driver shall park a vehicle, or permit it to stand, whether attended or unattended, upon a highway in any of the following places:

- i. Within an intersection;
- ii. On a crosswalk;
- iii. Within six meters of the intersection of curb lines;
- iv. Within four meters of the driveway entrance to any fire station;
- v. Within four meters of a fire hydrant;
- vi. In front of a private driveway;
- vii. On the roadway side of any vehicle stopped or parked at the curb or edge of the highway;
- viii. At any place where official signs have been erected prohibiting parking.


2. Driving or parking on sidewalk- No person shall drive or park a motor vehicle upon or along any sidewalk, path or alley not intended for vehicular traffic or parking;

3. Obstruction of Traffic – No person shall drive his motor vehicle in such a manner as to obstruct or impede the passage of any vehicle, nor, while discharging or taking on passengers or loading or unloading freight, obstruct the free passage of other vehicles on the highway;

4. There shall be no “ double parking” on any streets within the Metro Calubian ; and

**5. Overtaking is prohibited along the mun. streets within the Metro Calubian.**

**D. Inspection & Calubian PNP Duty** - It shall be the duty of the Calubian Chief of Police to designate or assign Policemen to enforce the inspection of individuals whose identity can not be identified or ascertained, by asking them their valid IDs and or proof of identities. In line thereto, two (2) official PNP Checkpoints shall be established, one located at Brgy. Gutosan, Calubian, Leyte and the other one, located at Brgy. Villalon, Calubian, Leyte.

**E. Traffic Volunteers - Civilian Duty for Traffic** is hereby enjoined especially those Barangay Tanods within Metro Calubian. Barangay Tanods, to include Brgy. Nipa, Bgy. Gutosan and Brgy. Villalon shall volunteer only to duty in their respective barangay jurisdiction;

**F. Speed Limit** - There is hereby a speed limit imposed to the following areas :

1. Along the highway in front of the Calubian Central School, CNVS-TESDA, CNHS and MSH Academy - 20 kph. max. speed;
2. Within the Town Proper comprising the barangays of T. Poblacion, Cabalquinto, Espinosa, Mahait, Garganera & Veloso - 20 kph. max. Speed;

**G. Riders or drivers of motorcycles** are prohibited likewise to use motorcycles with cracked, damaged, altered and loud mufflers installed in their respective vehicle from Brgy. Nipa & Brgy. Petrolio to Brgy. Villalon, Calubian, Leyte and or vice versa, in order to avoid unwanted sounds and noise pollution within the premises of the barangays mentioned;

**SECTION 8. PENALTY CLAUSE.** A. Any person or persons caught in violation of this ordinance, in whole or in part, shall be penalized as follows:

1. First Violation : Fine of Five hundred pesos ( P 500.00);
2. Second Violation : Fine of One thousand pesos ( P 1,000.00 );
3. Third or More Subsequent Violations : Fine of Two thousand pesos ( P 2,000.00) and imprisonment of one (1) month or upon discretion of the court.

**B. Citations Tickets-** shall be issued to the apprehended violators corresponding to the fines/ penalty imposed in this ordinance by the duly authorized PNP Officer of Calubian, Leyte. The payment of the amount corresponding the penalty shall be made at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer of the municipality.

**SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE** - Section 5 of Ord. No. 2013- 02 of Calubian, Leyte, also known as " The Motorcycle Helmet Ordinance of the Municipality of Calubian, Leyte, Proving Penalties Therefore and for Other Purposes " is hereby repealed in compliance of this ordinance. All other ordinances or resolutions, local issuances or rules inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, revoked and or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE-** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provision not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force & effect.

**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY-** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval from the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.



5. A Public Hearing was held/ conducted for the passage of the proposed ordinance on Feb. 6, 2023 at 2:00 p.m. at the Calubian Sports Complex, in which some Barangay Officials , NGOs, dept. heads & other concerned persons representing some offices of the unit had attended;
6. During the Public Hearing, traffic rules and regulations were likewise discussed, like those of minors driving during school days , the use of large sound mufflers of motorcycles which caused noise pollution and disturbance at night and conduct of seminars for all drivers of motorcycle for hire and pedicabs for hire;
7. Also, presented during the Public Hearing, essential suggestions that there must be installed CCTV Cameras & Police checkpoints at strategic places in the barangays, and the activation of Barangay Tanods to monitor & report any unwanted incidents in their respective barangays; and
8. Majority of the participants present during the Public Hearing favorably supported and favored the approval of the said ordinance;
