RESOLUTION NO. 2023-01 Series of 2023

APPROVING THE 1" QUARTER SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM (SIP) OF THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2023 WITH A TOTAL FUNDING REQUIREMENT OF TWO BILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-EIGHT MILLION FIVE HUNDRED FIFTEEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO PESOS & 05/100 (PHP2,748,515,372.05) AND ENDORSING THE SAID SUPPLEMENTAL INVESTMENT PROGRAM TO THE SANGGUNIANG PANLALAWIGAN FOR APPROPRIATE ACTION

WHEREAS, the preparation of the Annual Investment Program (AIP) of the Province of Leyte is mandated by law under Section 109(a)(2) of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160) and Article 410 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the said Code;

WHEREAS, the AIP constitutes the indicative yearly expenditure requirements of the Province for programs, projects and activities, consisting of the annual capital expenditure and the regular operating requirements of the Province for personal services (PS), maintenance and other operating expenditures (MOOE), capital outlay, statutory and contractual obligations and other budgetary requirements;

WHEREAS, the Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2011-1 issued by the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) on April 13, 2011 was considered in the identification of the programs, projects and activities in the AIP;

WHEREAS, the Province's 1st Quarter Supplemental Investment Program for CY 2023 has a total funding Two Billion Seven Hundred Forty-Eight Million Five Hundred Fifteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Two Pesos & 05/100 (Php2,748,515,372.05). The said amount shall be sourced from the continuing and current 20% Development Fund of the Province;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Nolie C. Caña, President, Liga ng mga Barangay duly seconded by Mr. Eugene Tan of the Pintados Foundation;

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to approve the 1st Quarter Supplemental Investment Program No. 1 of the Province of Leyte for Calendar Year 2023 with a total funding requirement of Two Billion Seven Hundred Forty-Eight Million Five Hundred Fifteen Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Two Pesos & 05/100 (Php2,748,515,372.05);

RESOLVED FURTHER, to endorse the said 1st Quarter Supplemental Investment Program No. of the Province of Leyte for Calendar Year 2023 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan (SP) of the Province of Leyte for the august body's appropriate action, pursuant to Section 114 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 [Republic Act (RA) No. 7160], our review of the **Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Supplemental Budget (SB) No. 3** of the Province of Leyte, involving total appropriation of **P57,325,000.00** under **Appropriation Ordinance (AO) No. 2022-04, Series of 2022**, submitted to this Office for review on January 26, 2023, reveals substantial compliance with the same law and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), except for the

1. Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) Deficiently Programmed in the Annual Investment Program (AIP)

Section 305 (i) of RA No. 7160 explicitly provides that the local budgets shall operationalize approved local development plans. Consequently, the IRR of RA No. 7160 is very instructive on how to ensure that the local budgets are linked to harmonized local plans and policies. Article 410 thereof is clear on the following: 1) That the AIP should be prepared and approved before the start of the local budget preparation phase; and 2) That the local budgets shall fund PPAs included in the AIP.

Relatedly, Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for the Local Government Units (LGUs), 2016 Edition provides that the Appropriation Ordinance shall be declared inoperative in part under the following conditions:

- a. When some PPAs not included in the approved AIP are funded under the annual/supplemental budget; and
- b. When the amount appropriated in the AO is higher than the amount provided in the AIP for the same PPA.

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





1. Programs, Projects, and Activities (PPAs) Deficiently Programmed in the Annual Investment Program (AIP)

Section 305 (i) of RA No. 7160 explicitly provides that the local budgets shall operationalize approved local development plans. Consequently, the IRR of RA No. 7160 is very instructive on how to ensure that the local budgets are linked to harmonized local plans and policies. Article 410 thereof is clear on the following: 1) That the AIP should be prepared and approved before the start of the local budget preparation phase; and 2) That the local budgets shall fund PPAs included in the AIP.

Relatedly, Budget Operations Manual (BOM) for the Local Government Units (LGUs), 2016 Edition provides that the Appropriation Ordinance shall be declared inoperative in part under the following conditions:

Thus, the appropriation for PPA in excess over the programmed amount in the AIP is hereby disallowed.

Likewise, it is noted that in the FY 2022 AIP, the PPA "SPA — Capital Expenditure Fund" is presented in lump-sum with short description of the specific PPAs lodged under it. The AIP as a planning document and an instrument to ensure linkage of plan and budget should provide specific details of PPAs and their corresponding expected outputs.

2. Appropriations for Grants and Donations under the Sangguniang Panlalawigan

Appropriations for the grants and donations in the total amount of **P70,019.00** under the Sangguniang Panlalawigan violates the doctrine of separation of powers, thus, should be **disallowed**.

Accordingly, we deem it necessary to remind anew the *case of ABAKADA*¹, applied by analogy, wherein the Supreme Court ruled that from the moment the law becomes effective, any provision of law that empowers the congress or any of its members to play any roles in the implementation or enforcement of law violates the principle of separation of powers and thus unconstitutional.

Anent thereto, the role of the Legislative comes to an end once the Appropriation Ordinance is enacted, and the implementation of the budget is vested under the Executive branch.

Therefore, the subsidies and donations must be implemented by the Executive Branch or in this case the Provincial Governor as the one vested with the power to execute the appropriation ordinance.

In view of the above, the budget is declared **inoperative in part** effective on its approval date, subject to the posting requirements under Section 59 of R.A. No. 7160, and further subject to the following conditions:

1. Prior Years' Unobligated Expenditures

The amount of **P7,788,244.00** appropriated for Prior Years' Unobligated Expenditures should have been taken up in the accounts of the respective years when obligations were incurred.

Section 350^2 of RA 7160 stipulates accounting for obligations, that is, all lawful expenditures and obligations incurred during a fiscal year shall be taken up in the accounts of that year.

2. Use of Savings

That the use of savings shall be in accordance with Article 417 of the IRR of RA No. 7160 as amended by Administrative Order No. 47, dated April 12, 1993.

3. Terminal Leave Benefits (TLB) and Monetization of Leave Credits (MLC)

The AO contains allocations for TLB and MLC in the total amount of P7,790,843.00.

The grant of said benefits be made in accordance with Civil Service Commission (CSC) Omnibus Rules on Leave per CSC Memorandum Circular No. 41, s. 1998³, Budget Circular No. 2013-1⁴ dated April 12, 2013 and 2016-2⁵ dated March 29, 2016.

4. Acquisition of Motor Vehicles (MVs)

The SB has a total appropriations of **P115,000,000.00** for acquisition of MVs, of which, the total amount of **P60,000,000.00** has no particulars/specifications as to the type of MVs to be procured.

In the absence of details of MVs to be purchased, it cannot be ascertained whether or not the purchase of motor vehicles are compliant to existing policy, rules and regulations for the purpose.

Accounting for Obligations. – All lawful expenditures and obligations incurred during a fiscal year shall be taken up in the Amendments to Pulce Lead the County of the the County

Thus, the purchase and specifications of the motor vehicle shall be subject to the provisions of Administrative Order (AO) No. 14^6 series of 2018 and Budget Circular (BC) No. $2022-1^7$, as well as the procurement, budgeting, accounting, and other applicable laws, rules and regulations.

The LGU should likewise seek an authority from the appropriate office for the purchase of MVs depending on MV type pursuant to item 6.0 of the same BC.

5. Disaggregation of Lump Sum Appropriation of various expenditures

The SB No. 2 contains lump-sum appropriations in the total amount of **P20,002,674.00** under the following PPAs:

It may be noted that if an appropriation ordinance contains lump-sum appropriations for capital outlays or described projects in generic terms without details, Sanggunian approval is required for a covering contract for every specific project.

Further, in the case of Quisumbing vs. Garcia, the Supreme Court rules that should the appropriation ordinance already contain in sufficient detail the project and cost of a capital outlay such that all the local chief executive needs to do is to execute the contract, no further authorization is required. In the case of Hon. Gabriel Luis Quisumbing, et.al. vs. Hon. Gwendolyn F. Garcia, et.al., the Court affirmed the indispensability of the Sanggunian's authorization for the disbursement of appropriations stated in generic terms while dispensing with such authorization for appropriations with specific details.

The previously mentioned appropriations described in generic terms shall therefore be supported with specific project details or require approval of SP for their disbursements.

Furthermore, the implementation of the lumpsum appropriations for the "Other Personnel Benefits" shall adhere to existing applicable laws, rules and regulations governing compensation matters.
