

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary the attached Ordinance No. 149 of the SB of Matag-ob, Leyte, recommending for the declaration of validity pursuant to its power under Section 56 (c) of R.A 7160, for it is within the powers of the local council to repeal/amend its prior acts either expressly or by the passage of an essentially inconsistent resolution (Constantino v. Desierto, 288 SCRA 654). Provided, That the penalty of "Community Service", desired under Section 3 (b) (l), & (2) of subject ordinance, does not violate the prohibition under the 1987 Constitution against INVOLUNTARY SERVITUDE.



(Proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 156)

ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 44 SERIES 2007, ENTITLED: AN ORDINANCE ENSURING THE WELFARE AND PROTECTION OF MINORS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte, in its regular session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title - This ordinance shall be known as "YOUTH WELFARE AND PROTECTION OF MINORS ORDINANCE IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE".

Section 2. Definition of Terms - Section 4 of the Definition of Terms shall be amended so as to add the foregoing terms:

k. Lodging House – a house in which rooms are rented, especially a house other than an inn or hotel

I. Hotel - an establishment providing accommodations, meal and other services for travelers and tourists

m. Motel - a roadside hotel designed primarily for motorists, typically having rooms arranged in a low building with parking directly outside

Section 3. Loitering During School Hours - Section 5 of Municipal Ordinance No. 44 series 2007 - Loitering During School Hours shall be amended to add the foregoing provisions:

b. To curtail this bad habit, students and/or school children who will be caught loitering in public places outside their school

rounds/campuses during school/class hours (without being accompanied by their parents/guardians or attending an official school function/duty) shall be sanctioned as follows:

- 1. FIRST OFFENSE a penalty of four (4) hours of community service to the Municipal Government under the supervision of the MSWDO plus two (2) hours of counselina.
- 2. REPEATED OFFENSE a penalty of six (6) hours of community service to the Municipal Government under the supervision of the MSWDO plus four (4) hours of counseling.
- e. On the other hand, commercial establishments such as, but not limited to restaurants/carenderias, videoke bars, house/arcades, billiard pool halls, and other forms of recreation, amusement centers, and parlors/barber shops that allow students/schoolchildren to loiter in their premises during school days from 7:00 o'clock in the morning to 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon shall be subjected to a fine of Five Hundred Pesos (Php500.00) for every student caught.
- **Violators** whose business involve recreational/sports/amusement related activities shall suffer the same fine (above).

Amendments (per offense):

1st. Offense – fine of One Thousand (Php1,000.00) Pesos; 2nd. Offense – fine of One Thousand Five Hundred (Php1,500.00) Pesos;

3rd. Offense – fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred (Php2,500.00) Pesos and 3 months suspension of business permit:

Section 4. Restricted Areas for Minors - Section 6 shall be amended to add the foregoing provisions:

b. Lodging House/Hotel/Motel and other establishments of the same nature.

> 2. It shall be unlawful for any adult person to check-in in any lodging house with minors who are not blood related

Section 5. Fraternity and Gangs - Section 7 shall be amended as follows:

FRATERNITY AND OTHER ORGANIZATIONS. All newly formed youth organizations must apply for accreditation from the Office of the Municipal Mayor upon recommendation of MYSC, and, accordingly, be issued a Certificate of Accreditation. The MYSC is hereby tasks to guide, monitor, and supervise these organizations.

- c. Hazing or initiation rites are not allowed in conformity with RA 8094.
- d. If the juvenile/minor subjected to hazing or other forms of initiation rites suffers any physical injury or dies as a result thereof, the officers and members of fraternity, sorority, or organization who actually participated in the infliction of physical harm shall be liable as principals and will suffer the sanctions as provided under Republic Act 8094.

The owner of the house/premises where the initiation rites/hazing is conducted shall be likewise liable.

Section 6. Other Act/s Prejudicial to the Child's Development - Section 8 shall be amended as follows:

a. It shall be unlawful for any person of establishments such as, but not limited to eateries, restaurants, bakeries, market stalls, general merchandise, hardware and construction supplies to sell liquor and/or any intoxicating drink, tobacco products, including ENDs (electronic nicotine delivery systems) such as vapes, illegal drugs, "rugby" and other habitinducing solvents, pornographic materials (video-beta, vhs, cd, vcd, dvd, magazines or any publication, books or tapes and other materials including all type of digital media that are detrimental to the development of the child or minor Lodging House/Hotel Motel and other establishments of the same nature.

Section 7. Separability Clause – The provision of this Ordinance are separable, and in the event that any or more of such provisions are declared invalid, the validity of all other provisions shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 8. Repealing Clause - Ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.


