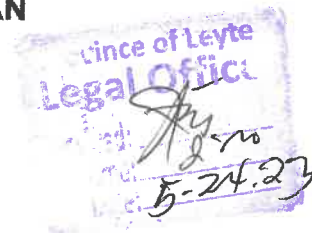

SECTION 2. SCOPE. The ordinance shall be applicable to all fishing vessels three (3) gross tonnage and below owned or operated by the resident of this Municipality:

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS. When use in the Ordinance, the following terms and phrase shall mean as follows:

- (a) **Admeasurements** – means the measurements of the volumetric capacity of the fishing vessel to determine its gross tonnage;
- (b) **Bantay Dagat** – duly deputized Municipal Fishery Law Enforcement Team (MFLET);
- (c) **BFAR** – Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources;
- (d) **Fishing Vessel** – any watercraft used for fishing or in support to fishing operations in Municipal waters weighing three (3) gross tons and below;
- (e) **Gross Tonnage** – the product of vessel tonnage length, tonnage depth and tonnage breadth modified by a factor of 0.70 divided by 2.83;

EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 35TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE 2022 SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALO, PROVINCE OF LEYTE, HELD ON MARCH 28, 2023, AT THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN SESSION HALL.

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- (f) **Homeport** – refers to the LGU where the fishing vessel is registered;
- (g) **License/Permit to Fish**– the privilege to fish in its Municipal waters granted to registered fisherfolk by the LGU;
- (h) **MARINA** – Maritime Industry Authority;
- (i) **Mayor** – refers to the Municipal Mayor of Palo, Leyte;
- (j) **Motorized Fishing Vessel** – a fishing vessel propelled by mechanical means;
- (k) **MUNICIPALITY** – refers to the Municipality of Palo;
- (l) **Net Tonnage** – the gross tonnage modified by a factor of 0.32;
- (m) **PCG** – Philippine Coast Guard;
- (n) **Registration** – an act/process of enlisting a fishing vessel three (3) gross tonnage and below for the purpose of establishing its identity and ownership by assigning it a permanent number [recorded in the registry of municipal fishing vessels;
- (o) **Registered Breadth**– the transverse distance taken at a widest part of the hull, excluding rub rails from the outboard side of the skin on one side of the hull to the outboard side of the skin on the other side of the hull;
- (p) **Registered Depth** – the vertical distance taken at or near midships from a line drawn horizontally through the gunwale of the skin of the sides of the hull (excluding the rail) to the outboard face of the bottom skin of the hull, excluding the keel Registered Length of the horizontal distance between the outboard side of the foremost part of the stem and the outboard side of the aftermost part of the stem, excluding fittings and the attachments;
- (q) **Tonnage Breadth**– measured at the mid-part from the gunwale inside of the skin of the hull to the inside of the other side of the hull;
- (r) **Tonnage Depth** – measured at the centreline from a point below the line of the tonnage deck. Measurement taken at the right angle to the vessel centreline of the vessel down to the inboard of the bottom skin of the hull;



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- (s) **Tonnage Length** – length measured at the centreline of the fishing vessel from the point forward where the line of the tonnage deck intersects in the line of the inboard faces at the stem to the point at where the line of the tonnage deck intersects the inboard face of the stem;

SECTION 4. REGISTRATION

4.A. Registration of Fishing Vessels. No fishing boats, three (3) gross tons or below, shall be allowed to be licensed or be issued with fishing boat license without first registering the said fishing boat to the Municipality. Likewise, no vessel of any size or built shall be allowed to operate or be used for any purposes within the jurisdiction of the Municipality without first registering the said vessel to appropriate Government agency.

4.B. Eligibility to Apply for Vessel Registration. Only Filipino citizens who are residents of Municipality of Palo, single proprietorships, partnerships and/or corporations, duly registered or accredited fisherfolk associations, or cooperatives are eligible to apply for registration.

4.C. Application. Application for registration shall be submitted and processed in the Municipal Agriculture Office. Application for the Municipal Fishing Vessel Registration shall be proper from (MFVR Form 1) and shall be filed under oath.

- a. Requirements. An applicant for fishing vessel registration shall submit the following requirements for evaluation of the Municipal Agriculture Office:
1. Duly notarized application form (MFVR Form 1);
 2. Certificate of Inspection or Admeasurements Form (MFVR Form 2);
 3. Two (2) 5R size (4"x6") picture of the boat (one shot side view, full length and one perspective shot with the applicant on the side);
 4. PNP-Maritime Group Clearance or Local PNP Clearance (if the former is not available);
 5. Payment of the appropriate fees (Registration fee and Inspection fee);
 6. Brgy. Certification as to the residency and no derogatory record of the applicant.

SECTION 5. ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER. The Municipality shall issue a Certificate of Number (MFVR Form 3) once all the documentary requirements are fully complied with and upon payment of the registration fee. The certificate of the number shall indicate the official serial number of the boat and its official name. The certificate of number shall serve as the proof of ownership of the boat.

EXCERPTS FROM THE MINUTES OF THE 35TH REGULAR SESSION OF THE 2022 SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALO, PROVINCE OF LEYTE, HELD ON MARCH 28, 2023, AT THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN SESSION HALL.

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SECTION 6. ASSIGNMENT OF OFFICIAL NUMBER AND FISHING BOAT COLOR. The Municipality shall assign an official number to a registered fishing vessel which shall correspond to the code of the province (LEY), followed by the Municipality (PALO) and the serial number (not less than four digits) assigned to the fishing vessel (i.e. LEY-PALO-00001). The number shall be painted in black, permanently and visibly not less than four (4) inches in height, on both sides of the forward portion of the fishing vessel. The color of the fishing boat for the Municipality of Palo shall be orange for easy identification and recognition.

SECTION 7. ASSIGNMENT OF NAME. The owner/operator shall propose a name to be assigned to the fishing vessel. The Municipality shall ensure that a name shall be assigned only to one (1) fishing vessel regardless of the type of fishing gear being used, design or size of the vessel. If the proposed name has already been assigned to another registered vessel, the owner/operator may add letters of the alphabet, any Arabic number or Roman numeral to the proposed name. The name of the fishing vessel shall be painted visibly not less than six (6) inches but not more than 8 inches in size on both sides in the upper-mid portion of the fishing vessel.

SECTION 8. ISSUANCE OF NEW CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER (CN). The Municipality may issue a new CN to a fishing vessel registered to another city or municipality if the fishing vessel transfers or changes its homeport to this Municipality. A change of homeport may occur if the owner/operator of the said fishing vessel decides to transfer its residence or its principal office of this Municipality or a resident of this Municipality acquired ownership of a fishing vessel registered to other LGU.

SECTION 9. RE-ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER. In cases where the fishing vessel is already registered to the Municipality, re-issuance of CN shall only be made if:

- a. The fishing vessel changes its ownership through a valid sale or any other legal means;
- b. The fishing vessel changes its engine; or
- c. The fishing vessel changes its name.

SECTION 10. REQUIREMENTS FOR RE-ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE OF NUMBER

A. Change of Ownership

1. Duly notarized application form (MFVR Form 1);
2. Copy of duly notarized deed of absolute sale or any legal instrument for transfer of ownership;
3. Certificate of publication executed by the Barangay Chairman that a notice had been posted for seven (7) consecutive days in the premises and that there is no opposition filed against the fishing vessels sale or transfer of ownership;



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4. Copy furnish of the Certificate of publication to Bantay Dagat (MFLET), Municipal Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Management Council (MFARMC) and Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO);
5. Copy of the notice posted in the Barangay Hall where the transfer rule has been made;
6. Copy of the original CN;
7. MFVR Form 2;
8. Payment of appropriate fees (registration and inspection fees).

B. Changes of Engine

1. Duly notarized application form (MFVR Form 1);
2. Copy of the original CN;
3. Copy of the official receipt of the engine purchased and/or;
4. Police clearance that the engine purchased or used is not from a carnapped/stolen vehicle;
5. MFVR Form 2;
6. Payment of appropriate fees (registration and inspection fees).

C. Change of Vessel Name

1. Duly notarized application form (MFVR Form 1);
2. Affidavit stating the reason for a change of name;
3. Certificate of publication executed by the Barangay Chairman that a notice had been posted for seven (7) consecutive days in the premises and that there is no opposition filed against the fishing vessels change of name;
4. Copy furnish of the Certificate of publication to Bantay Dagat (MFLET), Municipal Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Management Council (MFARMC) and Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO);
5. Copy of the notice posted in the Barangay Hall for seven (7) consecutive days that the fishing vessel has applied for change of name, stating the original name of the vessel and the proposed name;
6. Copy of the original CN;
7. MFVR Form 2;
8. Payment of appropriate fees (registration and inspection fees).

SECTION 11. DELETION OR CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION. In cases of lose or sea unworthy of the fishing vessel, the owner/operator shall immediately inform the Municipality and formally request for deletion or cancellation of registration of the said fishing vessel.

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The Municipality may also cancel or delete the registration of any fishing vessel, after due notice for lawful causes to the owner/operator have been served and appropriate due process have been complied with, without prejudice to filing of separate criminal complaint to proper court if found appropriate.

Registration of the fishing vessel may be cancelled or deleted due to any of the following reasons:

1. Utilizing the fishing vessel as coastwise commercial passenger vessel;
2. Involvement in any illegal or criminal activities;
3. Failure to renew the vessels registration for one year;
4. Giving false information in the application form;
5. Continued failure to display the vessels official number and name in violation of Section 9 and 10 of this ordinance.

SECTION 12. RENEWAL OF VESSELS REGISTRATION. Registration of all fishing vessels registered to this Municipality is subject for renewal every year. Application for registration shall be submitted and processed in the Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) not later than the last working day of February every year. Applicants for renewal of vessels registration shall present to the MAO the copy of the Certificate of Number of the vessel for assessment prior to the payment of the appropriate renewal fee. Failure to renew the vessels registration on the prescribed deadline shall subject the owner/operator of the said vessel to pay an additional cost of 25% of the renewal fee.

SECTION 13. RECORD-KEEPING AND SUBMISSION OF REPORTS. The Municipal Agriculture Office shall maintain updated records of all fishing vessels three (3) gross tons and below registered to the Municipality including those deleted and/or cancelled, and prepare the appropriate reports to be submitted to the Regional Office of the MARINA on the first week of April every year, copy furnished the PNP Maritime and the Provincial Offices of PCG and BFAR.

The Office of the Municipal Agriculturist shall be provided with a computer unit, printer and digital camera which shall be utilized for the documentation and vessel registration program of the Municipality.

SECTION 14. REGISTRATION FEES AND OTHER CHARGES. The following are the registration fees based on different categories of the fishing vessel:

SECTION 15. ADMEASURING OFFICER/S. The Agricultural Technologist (AT) fishery sector or as may be designated by the LCE, who shall be coming from the existing personnel of the Municipal Agriculture's Office and who has technical capabilities to discharge the function and duties of an admeasuring officer and shall be responsible in conducting an orientation seminar for the fishing vessel owners/operators prior in the issuance of CN. The admeasuring Officer/s shall undergo the necessary training from the MARINA or BFAR.

SECTION 16. ADMINISTRATIVE CLAUSE. Any person caught operating an unregistered fishing vessel within the jurisdiction of this Municipality in violation of Section 4 of this ordinance shall be fined by not more than two thousand five hundred pesos (2,500.00) for motorized vessels, and five hundred pesos (500.00) for non-motorized vessels and confiscation of the fishing boat and fishing paraphernalia. Failure to comply with the provisions of Section 10 and 11 of this ordinance within 60 days after the issuance of the CN shall be fined by not more than five hundred pesos (500.00).

SECTION 17. IMPLEMENTATION. The Philippine National Police – Maritime Command (MARICOM), Philippine Coast Guard (PCG), Fishery Law Enforcers/deputized fish wardens and all other law enforcement agents authorized by existing laws to enforce fishery laws, rules and regulations are hereby empowered to enforce this ordinance.

Provided, that the Mayor in times of calamities and crisis or with the authority given by the Sangguniang Bayan may enforce a moratorium or suspension on the collection of registration and renewal fees. The registration is free of charge during the first year of its implementation of fishing boat registration in the Municipality. Provided, further, the renewal of the vessel registration shall be subject to the provisions in Section 14 of this ordinance, thereafter. Provided, finally, that the applicants for vessel registration during the first year of implementation shall still be subject to other fees and requirements as provided in the Section 10 and 14 of this ordinance.

SECTION 18. SHARING PERCENTAGE OF PENALTIES COLLECTED. The total yearly accumulated penalties collected or derived by the Municipal Treasurers Office in violation of the local fishery ordinances and other existing fishery laws with following percentage:

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a. Local Government Unit (LGU)	50%
b. Municipal Fishery law Enforcement Team (MFLET)	40%
c. Municipal Fisheries and Aquatic Resources and Management Council (MFARMC)	<u>10%</u>

SECTION 19. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reasons, any part of ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.


SECTION 20. REPEALING CLAUSE. Previously approved Ordinances or parts thereof, which are in conflict with any provision of this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 21. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after completion of the posting and publication requirements as provided by law.


