

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 2023-11

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE DISPENSING, SELLING AND RESELLING OF DRUGS AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER SIMILAR RETAIL OUTLETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HILONGOS, LEYTE

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Section 15, Article II of the 1987 Philippine Constitution mandates the State to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 30 of Republic Act No. 10918, otherwise known as the Philippine Pharmacy Act prohibits the compounding, dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products through retail drug outlets not licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA);

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8203, otherwise known as the Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs, prohibits any person from manufacturing, selling offering for sale, donating, distributing, trafficking, brokering, exporting, importing, or possessing counterfeit drugs;

WHEREAS, in Advisory No. 2020-1348, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has issued a public health warning against the purchase and use of several counterfeit drug products that proliferated the market, including commonly known medicines such as Phenylephrine HCl/ Chlorphenamine Maleate/ Paracetamol (Neozep Forte), Loperamide (Diatabs), lbuprofen/Paracetamol (Alaxan FR), Carbocistine (Solmux) and others;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued a Memorandum Circular No. 2022-025, to all local government units (LGUs) and local operating units of the Philippine National Police (PNP) to enforce the regulations set forth in RA 10918 on the dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products;

WHEREAS, the proliferation of counterfeit pharmaceutical products and the sale of medicines by sari-sari stores, without authorization from the FDA, are a potential cause of serious harm to the health and safety of the general public;

WHEREAS, health is one of the top priorities of the Municipal Government of Hilongos, Leyte.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Hilongos, Province of Leyte in regular session duly assembled that;

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known an "An ordinance prohibiting the dispensing, selling and lifting of drugs and other pharmaceutical products in sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets in the Municipality of Hilongos, Leyte".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY AND OBJECTIVES.

- A. Section 447 of the Local Government Code, states that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the Municipality of Hilongos shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions, and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code.
- **B.** Enforce the regulations set forth in Republic Act No. 10918 "*Philippine*. *Pharmacy Act*" on the dispensing, selling, or selling of pharmaceutical products.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- Brand name refers to the proprietary name given by the manufacturer to distinguish its product from those of competitors.
- Counterfeit Pharmaceutical Products refer to pharmaceutical products which do not contain the amounts as claimed, with wrong ingredients; without active ingredients; or with insufficient quantity of ingredients, which result in the reduction of the product's safety, efficacy, quality, strength or purity. These also refer to products that are deliberately and fraudulently mislabeled with respect to identity and/or source or with fake packaging, and can apply to both branded and generic products.
- Dangerous drugs refer to those listed in the (1) Schedules annexed to the 1961 Single Convention on narcotics Drugs, as amended by the 1972 Protocol; (2) Schedules annexed to the 1971 Single Convention on Psychotropic Substances and (3) Annex of Republic Act No. 9165, otherwise known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002", and its amendments.
- Dispensing refers to the sum of process performed by a pharmacist from reading, validating and interpreting prescriptions; preparing; packaging; labeling; record keeping; dose calculations and counseling or giving information in relation to the sale or transfer of pharmaceutical products, with or without a prescription or medication order.
- **Emergency cases** refer to life threatening situations where a patient needs immediate attention and treatment, including the occurrence of epidemic or natural calamities.
- **Expiration date** refers to the end date when the manufacturer ca guarantee that a product possesses its claimed potency, efficacy, quality, and safety; after which its sale or distribution is prohibited.
- Food/Dietary Supplements refer to processed food products intended to supplement the diet that bears or contains one (1) or more of the following dietary ingredients: vitamins, minerals, herbs, or other botanicals, amino acids, and dietary substance to increase the total daily intake in amounts conforming to the latest Philippine-recommended energy and nutrient intakes or internationally agreed minimum daily requirements. It is usually in the form of capsule, tablets, liquids, gels, powders, or pills and not represented for use as a conventional food

or as the sole item of a meal or diet or replacement of drugs and medicines, as defined under R.A. No. 9711 "Food and Drug Administration Act of 2009".

- **Generic name** refers to the scientifically and internationally recognized name of the active ingredients, as approved by the FDA pursuant to R.A No. 6675 "Generic Act of 1988".
- Household remedies refer to any preparation containing pharmaceutical substances of common or ordinary use to relieve common physical ailments and which may be dispensed without a medical prescription in original packages, bottles, or containers, of which the nomenclature has been duly approved FDA.
- **Medicines** refer to drugs in their appropriate dosage forms, with assured quality, safety and efficacy for humans or animals or both.
- Over-the Counter (OTC) medicines refer to medicines used for symptomatic relief of minor ailments of which may be dispensed without a prescription.
- Pharmaceutical products refer drugs, medicines, biologicals, to pharmaceutical and biopharmaceutical products/specialties, veterinary products, veterinary biologics, and veterinary medical products.
- **Pharmaceutical establishments** refer to entities licensed by appropriate government agencies and which are involved in the manufacture, importation, exportation, repacking, and distribution of pharmaceutical products to pharmaceutical outlets.
- Pharmaceutical outlets refer to entities licensed by appropriate government agencies and which are involved in compounding and/or dispensing and selling of pharmaceutical products directly to patients or end-users.
- Pharmacist refers to a health professional who has been registered and issued a valid Certificate of Registration (COR) and Professional Identification Card (PIC) by the PRC and the Professional Regulatory board of Pharmacy.
- Pharmacist-only OTC medicines refer to Over-the-counter medicines classified by appropriate government agencies to be obtained only from a licensed pharmacist, with mandatory pharmacist's advice on their selection or proper use.
- **Prescription medicines** refer to medicines which can only be dispensed by a pharmacist to a patient, upon the presentation of a valid prescription from a physician, dentist, or veterinarian and for which a pharmacist's advice is necessary.
 - Sari-Sari Stores refer to retailing stores selling a general line of merchandise, classified as micro-enterprises.

SECTION 4. GENERAL GUIDELINES

Pursuant to Section 30 of RA 10918 "Philippine Pharmacy Act", no pharmaceutical product of whatever nature and kind, shall be compounded, dispensed, sold, or resold or otherwise be made available to the consuming public, except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the FDA.

- B. Sari-sari stores and other similar retail outlets and micro-enterprises are prohibited from dispensing, selling or reselling prescription and pharmacist-only OTC medicines, as defined and classified by the FDA, as these medicines may only be dispensed by or obtained from a licensed pharmacist and with said licensed pharmacists' advice, pursuant to R.A. No. 10918 "Philippine Pharmacy Act".
 - Owners of these establishments may, however, authorization from the FDA to dispense, sell and resell pharmaceutical products, limited to household remedies and OTC drugs (which are not pharmacist-only).
- C. Other stores such as convenience stores, cooperative-run stores and other small and medium enterprises which intend to sell household remedies and OTC drugs (which are not pharmacist-only) are first required to apply as a retail outlet for non-prescription drugs (RONPD) pursuant to FDA Circular No. 2014-028, and secure the following:
 - A License to Operate (LTO) from the FDA;
 - The employment of the supervision and oversight of a duly registered and licensed pharmacist, pursuant to Section 31 (b) of RA 10918; and
 - Other requirements imposed by the FDA on its LTO applicants
- D. The distribution of the COVID-19 drugs shall be governed by policies set forth by the FDA and the Department of Health.
 - The possession, dispensing, selling, or reselling of counterfeit pharmaceutical products are prohibited and shall be governed by the provision of RA 8203 "Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs".

SECTION 5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT

- A. The LGU shall ensure the integration of these guidelines and regulations in their existing business permit and licensing systems and requirements.
- B. They are also directed to coordinate with the Philippine National Police and the FDA and assist theses agencies in their drive to crack down on counterfeit drugs and illegal distribution of pharmaceutical products. LGUs shall also report violations by authorized drug retailers with the FDA for proper regulatory
- Through our Municipal Health Office, and in coordination with the FDA and component barangays, LGUs shall also ensure the functionality of Botika ng Bayan within our locality to secure unhampered access to authentic pharmaceutical products.
- LGUs shall also establish an enabling mechanism designed to assist owners of sari-sari stores and other retail stores in securing proper authorization from the FDA to dispense, sell and resell pharmaceutical products, as described in Section 4.3.a and Section 4.4 herein.

- If necessary, referring violators to the municipal government and/or the PNP for apprehension; and

SECTION 6. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE

- The Philippine National Police are hereby directed to coordinate with the FDA A. regarding the investigation and apprehension of those involved in the unauthorized dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products, in line with R.A. No. 10918 "Philippine Pharmacy Act".
- B. The local operating units of the Philippine National Police (PNP) shall likewise work with our LGU in the enforcement of the latter's corresponding ordinance, as per DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2022-025, under Policy Guidelines on the Responsibility of the Philippine National Police.

SECTION 7. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts are hereby prohibited:

- A. It shall be unlawful for any person, peddlers, sari-sari store, and other similar retail outlets to dispense, sell or resell drugs and other pharmaceutical products.
- No medicine, pharmaceutical, or drug of whatever nature and kind or device shall be compounded, dispensed, sold, and resold, or otherwise be made available to the consuming public by any person except through authorized drug outlets, establishments, and facilities of health products, as determined by the Department of Health and Food and Drug Administration.

SECTION 8. PENAL PROVISIONS

- Any sari-sari store and/or peddler dispensing, selling and reselling drugs, A. medicines or suspected counterfeit medicines shall be reported to the Food and Drug Administration for regulatory action.
- Any person, peddler, drugstore, or pharmacy who violates the provisions of B. Section 7, Paragraph b. shall be penalized as follows:

First Offense

- Warning letter issued by our Municipal Health Officer upon the verification and recommendation of the Municipal Pharmacist.

Second Offense

- A fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱1,500.00). Cessation of pharmaceutical products and cancelation of business permit.

Third Offense

- A fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) or imprisonment of not more than six (6) or both at the discretion of the court.

- **SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that the rights that are vested upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.
- **SECTION 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** Should any provision, section or part of this ordinance declared as invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections, or parts hereof which shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- **SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a local newspaper of general circulation.

Together with the Midwives and Nurses as assigned in the Municipality of Hilongos, Hon. Nerves presented an ordinance which titled "AN ORDINANCE PROBIHITING THE DISPENSING, SELLING AND LIFTING OF DRUGS AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER SIMILAR RETAIL OUTLETS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF HILONGOS". She stated the said ordinance and call to focus on the medicines that vend in the barangays specially over the counter or what may call OTCs medicines that other stores sell the item which may not valid because according to the Section 4. (c) these medicines may only be dispense by a licensed pharmacist and with said licensed pharmacist advice to R.A. No. 10918 "Philippine Pharmacy Act".

COMMENTS/CORRECTIONS/SUGGESTIONS:

- Mr. Aruelo, Pharmacist suggested to provide anyway medicines from the local pharmacy/drugstore instead. He will take charge to communicate to the barangay for the supervision of the retail drugs or retail outlet for nonprescription drugs (RONDP)
- Dr. Villaruel, Rural Physician commented that registered pharmacy is legible
 to dispense OTCs and other prescribe products if there is a Pharmacist
 Assistant that are completed training or have gone trained in TESDA in
 pharmacy services II. She added that it is crucial to hang a certificate of
 registration in a designated establishment because the store will not operate
 if there is no licensed pharmacist.
- Dr. Gabisan corrected In Section 5 (e) to develop <u>Midwives</u> to assist the barangays to give information and educate the benefit of sari-sari store owners and integrate their permit requirements.




