The Leyte People's Council (LPC) will make civil society organizations more involved in local governance, create a stronger partnership between the government and private sector and create an environment where people can participate in policy and decision-making processes.

Under DiLG Memorandum Circular 2021-054, the People's Council shall be composed of civil society organizations (CSOs) that will be accredited by the local sanggunian, who shall elect from among themselves their representatives to all local government bodies, boards, councils, committees, task forces, special government bodies and other similar workgroups which the local government or national laws may create;

The People's Council, however, is not allowed to engage in partisan politics and shall adopt measures to ensure that it is adequately shielded from any political partisanship or influence.

Under the Constitution, all CSOs are recognized as independent and autonomous selfhelp organizations and are encouraged to organize into formal cooperatives, interest
