

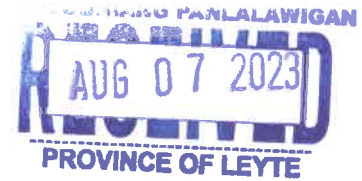

Organizations of LIT System, Inc.), (amended August 20, 2004)**

**ARTICLE I
MEETINGS**

Section 1. Annual Meetings – The annual meetings of the members shall be held at the principal office of the association on last Saturday of April of each year. The President shall render his annual report to the members regarding the activities of the association. The election of directors shall also be held during this regular meeting.

Section 2. Special Meetings – Special meetings of the members shall be called as the need thereof arises, by the Board of Trustees or the President or upon petition of 1/3 of the general membership. The General Assembly composed & with equal representation of officers of Members-alumni orgs. or associations may hold special session called by its Chairperson or a petition by the Federation President (amended August 20, 2004).

Section 3. Notices – Notices of the time and place of annual, and special meetings of the members shall be given either personally or by special delivery mail, at least two (2) weeks before the date set for such meeting. The notice of every special meeting shall state briefly the purpose or purposes of the meeting.

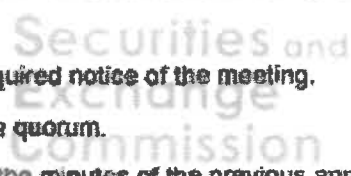
Section 4. Quorum – A quorum for any meeting of the members shall consist of a majority of the members and a majority of such quorum may decide any question at the meeting, except those matters where the Corporation Code requires the affirmative vote of a greater proportion.

Section 5. Order of Business – The order of business at the annual meeting of the members shall be as follows:

- a. Proof of service of the required notice of the meeting.
- b. Proof of the presence of a quorum.
- c. Reading and approval of the minutes of the previous annual meeting.
- d. Unfinished business.
- e. Report of the President.
- f. Election of the Trustees for the ensuing year.
- g. Other matters.

There shall be a General Membership Assembly & Homecoming of the Federation to be held on every two years thereafter to be determined by the General Assembly.

Section 6. Voting Proxy – Each member shall be entitled to one vote, and he may vote either in person or by proxy which shall be in writing and filed with Secretary of the Association before the scheduled meeting. Proxy shall be among members and for one time only. No proxy shall be allowed in the Board and Gen. Assembly. The Board shall prescribe rules to implement these provisions.

ARTICLE II

TRUSTEES

Section 1. Board of Trustees – The corporate powers of the association shall be exercised, its business conducted and its property controlled by the Board of Trustees. The Gen. Assembly is the highest policy-making and shall have the power to review all measures passed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Qualifications – The trustees to be elected must be of legal age and members of the association. After registration of the Articles of Incorporation, the General Assembly shall elect at least fifteen (15) Trustees with equal representation of not less than three (3) Trustees from among the officers of the members-alumni organizations/associations of the Federation (amended August 20, 2004).

Section 3. Disqualification of Trustees or Officers – No member convicted by final judgment of an offense punishable by imprisonment for a period exceeding six (6) years, or a violation of the Corporation Code of the Philippines committed within five (5) years prior to the date of his election or appointment, shall qualify as a trustee or officer.

Section 4. Term of Office of Trustees – The Trustees shall hold office for two years and until their successors are duly elected and qualified. Provided, that of the trustees first elected, one-half shall have a term of two (2) years while the other half shall have a term of one (1) year. Trustees elected thereafter shall have a term of two (2) years.

Section 5. The Board shall submit annual budget and plan of activities to the General Assembly for review and approval.

ARTICLE III

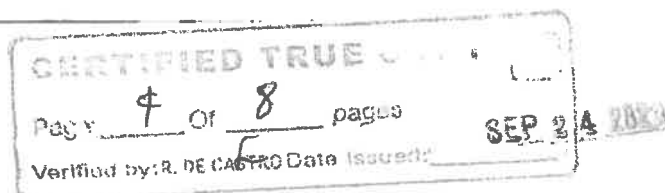
OFFICERS

Section 1. Officers – The officers of the association shall be a President, a Vice-President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. They shall be elected by the Board of Trustees from among themselves. The Board may combine compatible offices in a single person. The Board may elect/appoint other officers & prescribe their functions & duties deemed necessary.

Section 2. Term of Office of Officers – All officers of the association shall hold office for one year and until their successors are duly elected and qualified.

Section 3. The Chairperson of the Gen. Assembly shall be the Chairperson and Presiding Officer of the Board who shall be elected from among the Members of the Gen. Assembly. He shall appoint the Secretary General and call and preside meetings of the Gen. Assembly and Board and shall perform such other functions delegated by the Gen. Assembly.

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ARTICLE IV

FUNCTIONS & POWERS OF OFFICERS

Section 1. President – The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the association. He shall preside all meetings of the members of the association and he shall represent the Federation to the Board of Regents of EVSU and other committees (amended August 20, 2004).

He shall execute all resolutions of the Board of Trustees. He shall be charged with directing and overseeing the activities of the association. He shall submit to the Board as soon as possible after the close of each fiscal year, and to the members of each annual meeting, a complete report of the activities and operations of the association for the fiscal year under his term. He shall perform other functions & duties as the Gen. Assembly & Board may authorize from time to time.

Section 2. Vice-President – The Vice-President, if qualified, shall exercise all powers and perform all duties of the President during the absence or incapacity of the latter and shall perform duties that may be assigned by the Board of Trustees and by the General Assembly.

Section 3. Secretary – The Secretary shall give all notices required by these by-laws and keep the minutes of all meetings of the members and of the Board of Trustees in a book kept for the purpose. He shall keep the seal of the association and affix such seal to any paper or instrument requiring the same. He shall have custody of the members register and the correspondence files of the association. He shall also perform all such other duties and work as the Board of Trustees may from time to time assign to him and as the General Assembly may authorize from time to time.

Section 4. Treasurer – The Treasurer shall have charge of the funds, receipts and disbursements of the association. He shall keep all moneys and other valuables of the association in such banks as the Board of Trustees may designate. He shall keep and have charge of the books of accounts. He shall also perform such other duties and functions as may be assigned to him from time to time by the Board of Trustees. He shall post a bond in such amount as may be fixed by the Board of Trustees. He shall discharge such other functions and duties as the Gen. Assembly may prescribe from time to time.

ARTICLE V
MEMBERS

Section 1. Qualifications for Membership – The board shall determine the qualifications of an applicant for membership. Each EVSU Campus shall have only one (1) alumni-organization or association as legitimate member, and their respective members shall automatically members, of the Federation (amended August 20, 2004).

Section 2. Rights of Members – A member shall have the following rights:

- a. To exercise the right to vote on all matters relating to the affairs of the association;
- b. To be eligible to any elective or appointive office of the association;

- c. To participate in all deliberations/meetings of the association;
- d. To avail of all facilities of the association;
- e. To examine all the records or books of the association during business hours.

Section 3. Duties and Responsibilities of the Members – A member shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. To obey and comply with the by-laws, rules and regulations that may be promulgated by the association from time to time;
- b. To attend all meetings of the association;
- c. To pay membership dues and other assessments of the association.

Section 4. There shall be general registration of members of the Federation to be determined by the Board duly approved by the General Assembly.

ARTICLE VI

SUSPENSION, EXPULSION AND TERMINATION OF MEMBERSHIP

Suspension, expulsion and termination of membership, shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the association.

Any member of the association may file charges against a member by filing a written complaint with the Secretary of the association. The Board of Trustees shall call a special meeting to consider the charges. The affirmative vote of majority of all the trustees shall be necessary to suspend a member; Provided that where the penalty is expulsion, the affirmative vote of majority of all the members of the association shall be necessary. The decision/s by the Board may be appealed to and shall be reviewed by the Gen. Assembly and its decision/s shall be executory unless competent authority provides otherwise.

ARTICLE VII

Section 1. Funds – The funds of the association shall be derived from admission fees, annual dues and special assessments of members, gifts, or donations.

Section 2. Disbursements – Withdrawal from the funds of the association, whether by check or any other instrument shall be signed by the Treasurer and countersigned by the President. If necessary, the Board of Trustees may designate other signatories.

Section 3. Fiscal Year – The fiscal year of the association shall be from January 1st to December 31 of each year.

ARTICLE VIII

CORPORATE SEAL

Section 1. Form – The corporate seal of the association shall be in such form and design as may be determined by the Board.

We, the undersigned majority members of the Board of Trustees and the Secretary, do hereby certify that the By-Laws of the **FEDERATION OF ALUMNI ORGANIZATIONS OF LIT SYSTEM INC.** was amended by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members at a meeting held for that purpose at the principal office of the corporation on August 20, 2004.

The amendment to the By-Laws was necessary to conform the provisions of Republic Act No. 9311, "An Act Converting the Leyte Institute of Technology (LIT) in the Province of Leyte into a State University to be Known as the Eastern Visayas State University and Appropriating Funds therefore" signed into law by Her Excellency President Gloria Macapagal-Arroyo on August 7, 2004. The said law was published in the national general circulation of Malaya and Tribune on August 13, 2004. Attached are the duly signed Republic Act No. 9311 and Affidavit of publications as integral part of this certification.

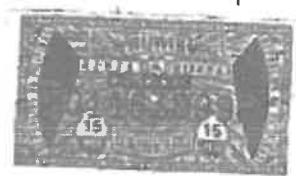
