We really need cooperation from the members, and we are hoping that we can be assisted for the construction materials.

4. Other Matters

About the livelihood assistance grant, the amount of forty thousand pesos (P40,000.00) will be given to the association.

It was agreed that the said amount will be used to purchase construction materials for the new layer building.
