MINUTES OF THE MEETING:

The meeting was called to order by the chairman Mr. Edwin I. Milleza at 4:00 in the afternoon. It started with a prayer led by Mr. Elmer Sendrijas followed by singing of the Philippine National Anthem led by the sound system. A roll call was done by the Coop. Secretary. Only 23 members were absent, so there was quorum.

Oder of Business:

A. Approval of the agenda

Mr. Marianito G. Tabudlong moved for the approval of the agenda duly seconded by Mr. Egine D. Matugas.

B. Matters arising from the Previous Minutes
None

AGENDA:

1. Proposed Amendments:

Mr. Edwin I. Milleza (Bantrans Coop. Chairman), introduced to the General Assembly for the following Amended agendas that includes:

- a. Members of the Bantrans Coop who violated the agreement and were delinquent only faced a fine of 300 pesos only. Physical (body contact) violations are punishable by two warnings, a threeday suspension, a fine of 300 pesos, and, after the third offense, dismissal as a cooperative member will be imposed.
- b. Absent from the Annual General Assembly meeting results in a 3-day suspension and 300 pesos fine. Drivers or owner-drivers will still be suspended 3 days by not taking hours at Baybay Terminal, even if already paid the amount of 300 pesos. The dispatcher should log book all suspended drivers, owner-drivers, and anyone who have paid at the terminal.
- c. Absent from BOD meetings, special meetings, and any other crucial cooperative events, for which drivers and owner-drivers are only subject to 300 pesos fine without suspension.
- d. The chairman emphasized that all multicabs start in Brgy Pangasugan with every 5 minutes before 8:00am, with no "U-TURN" in between interval. The Pangasugan parking lot, where the multicabs seem to park and ride, will not pick up commuters for the Baybay-Bunga and Baybay-Caridad routes; but, the Baybay-Bunga and Baybay-Caridad can already pick-up the passengers if no multicabs are seen in the area then multicabs are permitted to do a "U-TURN at Pangasugan after 8am. However, they should not pick up passengers from Pangasugan-Tab-ang, only from Brgy. Tab-ang/ Kilim and beyond if they are in a time concern.

2. Update on PUV Modernization

On the subject of PUV Modernization, the chairman is being requested for several of the most recent necessary papers. He said that the application process for all the papers was still ongoing. Acquisition for a coop. garage hasn't realized yet. A 1,000 sq. m land with declaration and land title is needed. He went on to say that the PUV modernization is ongoing process and that our coop is required to purchase 12 additional units for the modernization. Additionally, he stated that all drivers and owner-drivers were required to participate on the Drivers and Academy Training at Brgy. Pangasugan, Basketball Court, Baybay city, Leyte. He even admitted to the body that the processing fee for the confirmation was paid out of his own pocket rather than from the coop's. Some of members disagreed and not open to modernization. Mr. Tabudlong, Mr. Nenez, and Mr. Desabille provided explanations and were critical of PUV Modernization. Assurance of operators if modernized which is their great concern. The chairman told the body that modernization was highly recommended since the coop must adhere to and follow what the national informed us. For the sake of the coops and operators, we must obey the higher-ranking government authorities. Mr. Edwin Milleza emphasized to fellow members that an association is far different to a cooperative in many aspects as to the Fundamentals of Cooperation and By-Laws. He goes on to say that the coop must comply since failing to do so greatly increases the likelihood that other commercial companies will be forced to operate commercial transportation in our region as it is an open route. Any authorized location is open to anyone who wants to conduct business in the area. Mr. Milleza made the extremely wise decision to avoid the situation in order to safeguard his fellow drivers, owner-drivers, and business owners.

3. Update on the Proposed Garage

The chairman informed the group that he and the general manager (Mr. Elmer Sendrijas) had worked to find Coop Garage a location as quickly as possible. Unfortunately, Mr. Milleza hasn't come across yet for a garage, for other requests were turned down because they lacked the necessary documentation or were in locations that were too distant from the highway. Our chairman and general manager haven't given up yet, and they appear to be trying to persuade other members who have land that we might rent for the garage. In order to receive permission and to comply with LTFRB Memorandum Circular No. 2018-008 for Consolidation of Franchise in the Name of the Cooperative, a garage is essential.

4. Audited Coop Financial Statement Year Ended Dec. 31, 2022

Mrs. Shirley D. Fortaliza, the coop treasurer, spoke and outlined the financial report during the assembly. If a specific amount was deposited or withdrawn, a bank account was indicated. After her discussion, questions and answers were accepted.

5. Partial Payment for the Consolidation of Provisional Authority (PA) and Filling Fee

The chairman said that 1,200 will be paid for each operator and owner-driver's Provisional Authority (PA) and Filling Fee. The PA must first be paid for by the coop, and only then will the PA be released if already paid to the coop. If the specified sum is not paid yet, then the unit will not be permitted to make trips at the Baybay terminal, as decided by the BOD Officers and the body.

6. Proposed Daily Payment for all Bantrans Member for SSS, PhilHealth, Pag-ibig, Daily dues, Separation Pay and Capital build-up

Mr. Milleza commented about the monthly dues (100), separation pay (100) for drivers only. The following list includes drivers and owner-drivers (400); CVU (100); SP (100); MO (200); and PO (300). On the other side, Mr. Nenez has worries about the separation money, and Mr. Bacalso (a BOD officer) starts arguing over the reserve fund, which causes a disagreement between Mr. Nenez and the chair. On the other side, Mr. Lito Almendra (former chairman) provided a full explanation of separation pay. On March 1st, 2023, the 400/mo. monthly dues will commence to effect.

7. SSS, PhilHealth, Pag-ibig Benefits---Compulsory for all Coop Members

All coop members as mentioned by the chairman, SSS, Philhealth, Pag-ibig benefits will not be able to cover yet to all members because with not enough money to shoulder. He stated that personal payment is appreciated for now. Mr. Almendra, stated that the compliance with coop has 3,000 (operators) and 1,000 (drivers) having full payment of 12,000 will be a regular member and if a member resigns, the entire payment of 12,000 will be collected as long as the member has not fallen behind on his dues. Moreover, renewal of license (1,000), hospitalization for 3 days (1,000) while daughter or wife will only have (500) instead of 1,000 because he is not a coop member.

8. Proposed Coop. Business (Negosyo)

The body was informed by the chairman that there will be internal business in the coop. According to Mr. Tabudlong, lending is one type of a business. If so, disciplinary measures might be taken against delinquent members. Mr. Nenez proposed for a Rice Pangkabuhayan for all members. It must be required to make payments on the specified date. Members who support cooperative businesses will get a patronage refund as privileges.

9. Proposed Coop. Office ASAP

The BOD officers decided and agreed to build the new coop office next to Mr. Chairman's home in the Gabas, Baybay City, Leyte after it was brought up in the assembly. The aforementioned place is more convenient for customers and drivers. The new structure will house the coop's office, a shop for replacement components, and a rice storage area.

10. Imposed Wearing of Polo Shirt (White) MWF and rest of the days will be any color, pants and shoes (any kind): A Reminder

The significance of wearing a proper uniform has been discussed by the chairman of the board. All drivers and owner-drivers should wear white polo shirts with collars on weekdays and any color on weekends and holidays, he said. T-shirts and shorts are also only permitted on Saturdays and Sundays. On weekdays, wear long pants and rubber shoes or topsiders. Slippers are not allowed; rain boots with stockings are also prohibited. Drivers and owner-drivers may not wear their full uniforms during periods of heavy weather or on holidays. In the event that a BOD officer is unable to wear shoes during the workweek, a medical certificate must be provided.
