MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS (MD&A)

The SOULS-FA generated a net income of 266,100 in 2022, attributed to the successful execution of various farming activities, including poultry, pig farming, farming, and aquaculture. Additionally, the association received membership dues amounting to 16,500. The expenses incurred by the association amounted to 405,400, primarily attributed to the cost of farm inputs and administrative expenses. Despite the high expenses, the association maintained a healthy financial position, with a total fund balance of 266,600. The association's assets totaled 2,890,500, with the largest component being the Poultry Fund at 2,700,000, and had no liabilities during the year. The cash flow statement indicated a positive cash flow of 266,100, with the majority of inflows coming from the various farming activities.

Looking forward, the association aims to continue its successful farming activities and explore other potential sources of income. It plans to invest in additional equipment to increase efficiency and reduce costs. Furthermore, the association intends to continue managing its expenses efficiently to maintain a healthy financial position.

In conclusion, the SOULS-FA had a successful financial year in 2022, generating a net income of 266,100 and maintaining a healthy financial position. The association's management is committed to continuing its successful farming activities and exploring new potential sources of income while maintaining a financially sustainable operation.
