
















JOINT RESOLUTION REQUESTING HIS EXCELLENCY PRESIDENT FERDINAND R. MARCOS, JR., PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE REHABILITATION OF THE PROVINCIAL ROAD OF BARANGAY HINABAY TO BARANGAY CABULISAN, INOPACAN, LEYTE

WHEREAS, Barangays Hinabay, Cabulisan, Caminto, and De los Santos, are all upland barangays in the Municipality of Inopacan, Leyte—a fourth income class municipality in located in the southwestern portion of the Leyte province;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Inopacan, Leyte, is one of the many municipalities that were badly affected by typhoons "Odette" and "Agaton", leaving totally and partially damaged houses and public infrastructures;

WHEREAS, the provincial road of Barangay Hinabay to Cabulisan, Inopacan, Leyte, was among the numerous public infrastructures that sustained severe damage during the aforestated weather disturbance, prompting the Municipal Government of Inopacan, Leyte to issue Executive Order No. 37, s. 2022: "An Order Prohibiting all Motor Vehicles other then Motorcycles to Traverse the Landslide-affected Provincial Road of Brgy. Hinabay and Cabulisan, Inopacan, Leyte;

WHEREAS, the foregoing precautionary measure is an acknowledged necessary consequence of the continuing landslide that have continually worsened the damage to the provincial road, thereby posing greater threat to the safety of the affected residents in the four (4) barangays represented herein, and causing inconvenience to the residents in the barangays and disruption in the economic activity in the municipality;


WHEREAS, the Municipality of Inopacan, Leyte, including the Barangay Local Government Units of affected barangays, have insufficient funds to cover the expenses required for its rehabilitation;

NOW THEREFORE, in a Joint Meeting of the Barangay Local Government Units of Hinabay, Cabulisan, Caminto and De los Santos, BE IT RESOLVED AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to request His Excellency President Ferdinand R. Marcos, Jr., President of the Republic of the Philippines, financial assistance for the Rehabilitation of the Provincial Road of Barangay Hinabay to Barangay Cabulisan, Inopacan, Leyte;

RESOLVED FURTHER that a copy of this Joint Resolution No. 01, Series of 2023. be forwarded to the Office of the President and the Provincial Governor of Leyte, for their information and appropriate action.

The Municipality of Inopacan, Leyte is a fourth-income class coastal municipality located in the southwestern portion of Leyte which top two hazards are flooding and landslide.

Prone to the hazard of landslide are the upland barangays of Hinabay, Cabulisan, Caminto and De los Santos, which are all rural barangays contiguously connected and are traversing the provincial road of in Brgys. Hinabay and Cabulisan.

The successive onslaughts of typhoons "Odette" and "Agaton", caused flooding and landslides in hazard-prone barangays, leaving major damages to public infrastructure in the municipality including the aforementioned provincial road, which due to the damages it sustained have been temporarily closed to four-wheel vehicles.
