ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE UTILIZATION OF THE PHILHEALTH TB-DOTS BENEFIT PACKAGE RECEIPTS AND ACCRUING TO THE TRUST FUND OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU ) OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE, AS AMENDED .

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte, in a session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the "ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING THE UTILIZATION OF THE PHILHEALTH TB-DOTS BENEFIT PACKAGE RECEIPTS AND ACCRUING TO THE TRUST FUND OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT ( LGU) OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE, AS AMENDED ".

#### SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

- 1. It is the policy of the Municipality of Calubian, Leyte to ensure that management of TB DOTS program is effectively and efficiently undertaken through a PhilHealth accredited facilities and the Millennium Development Goals for Tuberculosis (TB) is achieved as well.
- 2. It is likewise a declared policy of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte to ensure the efficient and effective delivery of the basic services and facilities, particularly xxx Section 447 (a)( 5) (xiv) of R.A. 7160 which provides that the Sangguniang Bayan shall enact ordinances which xxx Provide for the care of paupers, the aged, the sick, persons of unsound mind, disabled persons, abandoned minors, juvenile delinquents, drug dependents, abused children and other needy and disadvantaged persons, particularly children and youth below eighteen (18) years of age and, subject to availability of funds, establish and provide for the operation of centers and facilities for said needy and disadvantaged persons. Xxx;
- 3. The municipality of Calubian, Leyte supports the National TB Control Program of the Department of Health ( DOH ) which aims to reduce mortality and incidence from tuberculosis in the country, reduce catastrophic costs and provide patient- responsive health services.
- 4. The National TB Control Program of the Department of Health (DOH) also facilitates the development of policies and standards for TB elimination in the country, particularly in the municipality of Calubian, Leyte and the equitable distribution of TB drugs, laboratory supplies, technical assistance and material support to local government units.

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND APPLICATION. This ordinance shall be adopted by the municipality of Calubian, Levte and shall cover the implementation of the TB-DOTS Program Package, to include new cases, pediatric, and extra-pulmonary TB.

- 1. Presumptive TB case Any person whether adult or child, with signs and/or symptoms suggestive of TB (pulmonary or extra-pulmonary), or those with chest X-Ray findings suggestive of active TB.
- 2. TB infection or latent TB Infection (LTBI) A condition in which an individual has no signs and symptoms presumptive of TB or radiologic or laboratory evidence but has positive Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) reaction.
- 3. TB disease a presumptive TB who after clinical and diagnostic evaluation is confirmed to have TB.
- 4. Classification of TB Disease classification based on the DOH Tuberculosis Control Program Manual of Procedures 6th Edition, 2020.

SECTION 5. TRUST FUND CREATION AND MAINTENANCE. The LGU of Calubian, Leyte shall create and maintain a Trust Account solely for PhilHealth TB DOTS receipts and shall maintain a ledger for the utilization thereof.

SECTION 6. SHARING OF THE PHILHEALTH TB DOTS BENEFIT PACKAGE RECEIPTS. The following sharing scheme is hereby established in the utilization of the PhilHealth TB DOTS Benefit Package Receipts trust fund in compliance with PhilHealth Circular No. 014, S. 2014:

1. 40% of the receipts shall be the Facility Fee. The 40% breakdown shall be as follows:

Assistance for TB patients referred for GenXpert/Referral of patients to higher centers in cases of MDRTB	10%
Quality Assurance for Sputum Microscopy (e.g. maintenance of microscope, etc.) including medical waste management for infection control	20%
Purchase of supplies needed for processing of samples	10%
Contingency for CAT 2/TB in children TB Drugs	20%
Trainings & Seminars	20%
Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses	20%
TOTAL	100%

2. 60% of the receipts shall be the service incentive of Calubian Rural Health Unit staff who are involved in the delivery of health service for TB including treatment partners. The 60% breakdown shall be as follows:

Accredited Referring Physician/Municipal Health Officer/Rural Health Physician/Doctor to the Barrio	12.5%
Medical Technologist	15%
Nurses	12.5%
Midwives and Other Support Staff (e.g. NDPs, RSI, IT IS, etc.)	50%
Incentive for Barangay Health Workers, Informal Lab Workers, Ambulance Drivers, and PhilHealth Encoder	10%
TOTAL	100%

SECTION 7. MONITORING, REPORTING, AND EVALUATION. The Municipal Health Office shall maintain a regular monitoring scheme and reporting and shall make all data and information available for evaluation.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any of the provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid other parts or provisions that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders or rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon review and favorable approval of the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.

SECTION 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any of the provision of this ordinance shall be held invalid other parts or provisions that are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 9. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other ordinances, resolutions, local executive orders or rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SECTION 10. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon review and favorable approval of the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.
