A RESOLUTION APPROVING MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 478-100723
ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF WHEEL CLAMPS TO IMMOBILIZE VEHICLES PARKING OVERNIGHT ALONG THE STREETS OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PALOMPON, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Municipality of Palompon to regulate the use of streets, alleys, and other public places and improve and maintain the same, regulate the use of parking spaces, as well as designate areas to be occupied by public and private vehicles when not in use;

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the Municipality of Palompon to introduce a regulated parking system in areas so designated by the Municipality, so as to improve and enhance traffic flow and distribute equitably the limited parking spaces available;

WHEREAS, with the influx of tourists visiting the municipality's tourist destination areas came the influx of vehicles parking overnight along the streets of the municipality and parked in a spaces not designated as parking areas;

WHEREAS, Section 11 (e) of Municipal Ordinance No. 449-240220 otherwise known as the Municipal Traffic and Parking Regulations Ordinance of 2020 prohibits all vehicles, pot-pots, motorcycles, tricycles, vans, trucks, buses, articulated vehicles, heavy equipment and all types from parking overnight;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) issued DILG Memorandum Circular No. 2019-121 enjoining all local officials including Municipal Mayors and Punong Barangays "to exercise powers essential to reclaim public roads which are being used for private ends, and in the process, rid them of illegal structures and constructions;

WHEREAS, there is a need to implement the use of wheel clamping or tire lock system. Wheel clamp or tire lock is a device used to immobilize vehicles that have been issued official parking violation notices;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion by SANGGUNIANG BAYAN MEMBER RENE A. CAMPOSANO duly seconded *EN MASS*.....

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of Palompon, Province of Leyte, that:

Section 1. Title. – This Ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Palompon Wheel Clamping Ordinance".

Section 2. Definition of Terms. — When used in this Ordinance, the following words or phrases shall have their meaning respectively ascribed therefor, viz:

- a. "WHEEL CLAMP OR TIRE LOCK" means a device or any similar equipment that will be used to immobilize illegally parked vehicles that have been issued official parking violation notices;
- b. "OVERNIGHT PARKING" means parking overnight along the municipal streets and non-designated parking areas from 10 o'clock in the evening to 4 o'clock in the morning.

Section 3. Prohibiting the Parking and Waiting Vehicles along the Main Thoroughfares. No drivers shall:

- 3.1. Leave the vehicle waiting for more than five (5) minutes;
- 3.2. Park a vehicle at any time of the day other than in municipally-designated parking areas;
- 3.3. Leave a vehicle waiting except when loading and unloading from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM in the morning and from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM in the evening.

Section 4. Loading/ Unloading Zones. A driver of a truck may park his/her vehicle in the designated "Loading and Unloading Zones" when actually taking up or setting down goods, provided he is present at all times and attending to the same. Delivery trucks and other vehicles may load and unload cargoes from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM in the morning and from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM in the evening.

A driver of a public utility vehicle shall stop, pick up or unload passengers only at designated loading and unloading zones.

Section 5. Designated Clamping Zones. – The following streets or areas listed hereunder are declared clamping zones, to mention:

- (a) Rizal Street
- (b) Libertad Street
- (c) Taft Street
- (d) San Francisco Street
- (e) Lopez Street
- (f) Zamora Street
- (g) P. del Rosario Street
- (h) Colon Street
- (i) Legaspi Street
- (j) Evangelista Street
- (k) Pintor Luna Street
- (l) Lincoln Street
- (m)Magallanes Street

- (n) Arellano Street
- (o) Burgos Street
- (p) Washington Street
- (q) Mabini Street

- (s) Roads surrounding the Public Market Area
- (t) Roads surrounding the Municipal Hall, Liberty Park and Civic Center
- (u) All national, provincial and barangay roads shall be off-limit to overnight parking

Section 6. Prohibition. – Stopping, standing or parking of vehicle at any given time within the designated clamping zones is hereby prohibited.

Section 7. Enforcement and Implementation.

- a.) Any motor vehicle found: (1) to be parking overnight as defined in Section 3 of this Ordinance; (2) parked in any of the places designated as "Clamping Zones"; (3) violating any provision of any existing law or ordinance which prohibits, regulates or restricts the parking of motor vehicles; or (4) causing danger, obstruction or undue inconvenience to other road users, shall be immobilized with the use of a wheel clamp or tire lock.
- b.) Personnel of the Traffic Management Services (TMS), Barangay Tanods, Philippine National Police (PNP) and other traffic enforcement entity is hereby authorized to immobilize with the use of a wheel clamp or tire lock.
- c.) When immobilizing a motor vehicle, authorized personnel shall carefully attach the wheel clamp or tire lock to the outer part of the front tire at the driver's side of the motor vehicle.
- d.) The Municipality of Palompon or any of its officials or employees shall not be held responsible for any damage to the vehicles caused by any movement or attempted movement of the vehicle by the owner/ driver/ operator while the motor vehicle is clamped.

Section 8. Liability. – The driver, owner and operator of any vehicle found to have violated Section 5 of this Ordinance, shall be held jointly and severally liable to answer for the penalty imposed herein.

Section 9. Penalties, Violation and Fines.

a.) To redeem the clamped vehicle, the claimant or its duly authorized representative shall proceed to the Municipal Treasurer Office and present the citation ticket to the cashier in paying the fine/s and/or penalty, viz:

One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php	For the first twenty-four (24)
1,500.00)	hour period, or a fraction thereof
Five Hundred Pesos	For every succeeding twenty-
(Php 500.00)	four (24) hour period thereafter,
	or a fraction thereof.

b.) Any person who unjustly refuses to pay the fees prescribed in paragraphs (a) of this section within two (2) days shall be liable for an additional fine of Two Thousand Pesos (Php 2,000), or one (1) month imprisonment, or both, at the discretion of the Court.

c.) Any person who tampers, destroys, disfigures, or defaces the wheel clamp or tire lock, or without authority tries to release an immobilized or clamped motor vehicle by destroying the wheel clamp or tire lock, shall be liable for its loss or destruction and shall be penalized, after conviction, with a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php 2,500.00), or one (1) month imprisonment, or both, at the discretion of the Court. Also the offender shall pay the value of the wheel clamp, without prejudice to any liability which the offender might be held accountable for civilly, administratively or criminally, for such destruction.

Section 10. Separability Clause. - If any part, section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the other part or provision hereof which is not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 11. Repealing Clause. - Ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provision of this ordinance, are hereby repealed and modified accordingly.

Section 12. Effectivity. – This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.




