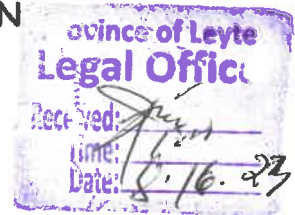

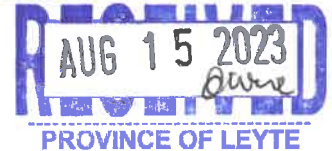

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN, IN SESSION DULY ASSEMBLED THAT:

SECTION 1. TITLE. The Ordinance shall be known as "GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION OF EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLES/RESCUE VEHICLES AND AMBULANCE."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is a declared policy of the Municipality of Tabango, to promote the general welfare by ensuring the health and safety of its constituents.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- A. EMERGENCY- unforeseen or sudden occurrence, especially danger, demanding immediate action.
- B. EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES- refers to rescue and emergency services that offer on-scene care to any trauma and medical incident. This will also apply to any patient that needs to be transported by any medical facility for advanced care.
- C. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT- refers to all transport to other advanced medical facilities supported by a referral.
- D. EMERGENCY TRANSPORT VEHICLE- a vehicle used to transport patients to or from the hospital or any other medical facility.
- E. NON-EMERGENCY TRANSPORT- refers to transport for a dialysis session, consultation, outgoing patients, or laboratory tests such as but not limited to CT scan, X-Ray, Blood and Urine Test, and Ultra Sound.



SECTION 4. GUIDELINES.

- A. All Vehicles shall be available for all, either Tabangohanon or Non-tabangohanon that will cater to emergency and non-emergency transport.
- B. Requesting patient or any representative shall present at the Tabango DRRM Operations Center their respective proof of residency and any documents that will support his/her request.
- C. Personnel-on-duty shall evaluate and assess the said document/s and will advise whether fees are needed or not, and if there is an available vehicle to be used.
- D. There shall be two drivers on duty for every shift. If one driver is being utilized, the other driver shall be on standby for emergency purposes. No non-emergency transport will be catered to in this situation.
- E. If there is a scheduled non-emergency transport and suddenly there is a need for emergency transport, emergency transport shall be prioritized.
- F. Non-emergency transport shall be scheduled at least two days before use except for those admitted patients that need further laboratory tests not available in the community hospital.
- G. Upon transport, all patient/s are monitored by the accompanying responder/s using Patient Care Report which shall be signed by the patient or any representative.
- H. No vehicles shall be allowed to be used without Trip Ticket issued by the dispatch officer at the Tabango DRRM Operations Center.

SECTION 5. FEES. All shall be guided to the following fees schedule:

SECTION 6. TRAINING. The Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office (MDRRMO) shall organize and conduct training/s for Ambulance or Emergency Transport Vehicle Management for proper management and utilization of the vehicle.

SECTION 7. ALLOCATION. The Local Government Unit of Tabango shall allocate to the MDRRMO at least Php 800,000.00 annually for fuel consumption and Php 300,000.00 annually for repairs and maintenance of rescue vehicles.

SECTION 8. TRAVELLING EXPENSES AND ALLOWANCE. All Transport Personnel including drivers and responders excluding Job Order personnel/s shall be entitled to travel expenses and allowances subject to the availability of funds.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, as well as pertinent rules and regulations thereof, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinances, are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and after posting thereof on bulletin boards at the entrance of the municipal hall and in at least two other conspicuous and publicly accessible places within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality.

Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Answered that they usually as practice in their office they asked for proof of residency and referral that reflects the address of the patients or asked the barangay captains.

Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Responded that it is not an emergency transport because as defined emergency transport is from Tabango Community Hospital to other hospital.He further stated that they call it as trauma cases/vehicular accident and usually they manage and transport to the nearest hospital.
Hon. Luis Gabriel U. Veloso SB Member	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Suggested to increase the fees.He stated as an example for the non-resident going to Tacloban to make it in the amount of Php 3,000.00 instead of Php 2,500.00 (additional Php 500.00) for fuel and other maintenance of the vehicle.

Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Responded that it's up to the committee because this public hearing is just only a proposal and if what is decided in the hearing the DRMM Office will just implement.

Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stated that based on this year they have some difficulty or short of budget also the other offices due to the decrease of our era. ● He further stated that there budget based from the MOOE and Capital Outlay is only Php 800,000.00. the Php 500,000.00 is allocated for the fuel and the Php 300,000.00 is for the maintenance for this years budget.
Hon. Jose Welson G. Vosotros SB Member	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● In connection to the fees of non-residents of Tabango he clarifies if the additional Php500.00 is not only for fuel it also includes the maintenance of the vehicles.

Wilfredo Hilo MEO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stated that Biliran have the same distance as Tacloban and suggested to change the rate of Biliran as the same to Tacloban.
Hon. Jose Welson G. Vosotros SB Member	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Commented that Biliran has the same distance as Tacloban and the terrain going there consumes lots of fuel.
Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stated Section 8 and suggested to change the phrase "disregarding their employment status" to "excluding Job Order personnel/s" because during their conference with the Commission on Audit , the Job Orders are not allowed to claim travelling expenses or per diem.
Wilfredo Hilo MEO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Asked how many rescue vehicles.
Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Responded that there are 5 rescue vehicles.
Wilfredo Hilo MEO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Stated that the amount of Php 300,000.00 is not enough for the maintenance of 5 rescue vehicles
Hon. Jojie Arante Punong Barangay Butason I	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Asked about Section 8 Travelling Expenses and Allowance with regards to the rescue vehicle driver that is assigned in there barangay is a Job Order who's working from Monday to Sunday no day off and can't claim travel expenses. ● Suggested if maybe find a way to make him a plantilla because his rate is Php 250.00 per day only.
Jayvon Arcipe MDRRMO	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Answered that the only way their office can do is to recommend to the Local Chief Executive. ● He stated that it is only the Local Chief Executive who can appoint. There were lots of proposals but not all our proposal will be catered by our mayor considering there are also needs from different offices. ● He further stated that the Sanggunian Bayan already created items in the office of MDRRM. Maybe next year we can propose 1 or 2 position but it's up to the Budget Officer and the Mayor. ● Cited that from other towns those Job Order from DRRM Office have a complete 11 days and those who have duties for 24/7 have a complete 15 days of salary

	<p>and he suggested, if we can put it in our ordinance because they have rendered exceed time of duty especially Mr. Bobo because he is on call in there barangay and have dialysis patients on Saturdays and he only received 250 pesos per day.</p>
