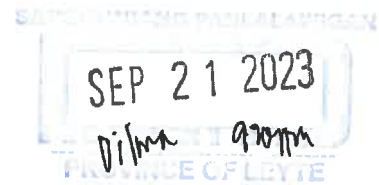

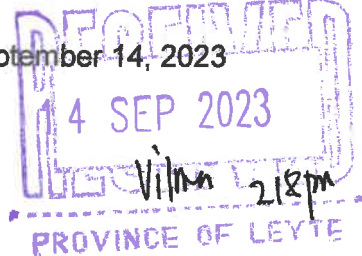

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THRU INSERTION TO SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3, SERIES 2011, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING FOR ROOM TARIFF FOR THE OCCUPANCY OF ABUYOG HOTEL AND THE USE OF ITS FACILITIES PROVIDING FEES, TAXES, OTHER CHARGES AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF"**

**WHEREAS**, Section 447 (a) (3) (vii) of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, empowers the Sangguniang Bayan, which states that: "Upon approval by a majority vote of all the members of the Sangguniang bayan, grant a franchise to any person, partnership, cooperation, or cooperative to establish, construct, operate and maintain ferries, wharves, markets or slaughterhouses, or such other similar activities within the municipality as may be allowed by applicable laws: Provided, That, cooperatives shall be given preference in the grant of such a franchise";

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 3, series 2011 subject for amendment hereof under Section 5 quoted hereunder in a penultimate paragraph;

*Section 5. The rate in the use of other facilities within the hotel shall be govern by the passage of an Ordinance by the Sangguniang Bayan, this municipality.*

**WHEREAS**, the subject ordinance did not specify the rental fee of the restaurant facility of Abuyog Hotel by the time that the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan so decides to grant its operations to any person, partnership, corporation or cooperative;

**WHEREAS**, for more than 10 years now, the aforementioned restaurant of Abuyog

Hotel is not functioning well pursuant to the standards and/or expectations by its costumers/occupants in the establishment owned and operated by the Local Government of Abuyog, Leyte;

**WHEREAS**, the amendment is deemed imperative in order to ensure the continuous viable and competitive operations of the entire establishment.

**NOW THEREFORE, BY THE 19<sup>TH</sup> SANGGUNIANG BAYAN IN SESSION ASSEMBLED DULY CALLED** and upon motion of Honorable SB Member Jeannette A. Valida duly seconded by Honorable SB Member Arnold R. Allera.

**BE IT ORDAINED AS IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED;** that,

**SECTION 1. AMENDATORY AND/OR SUPPLANTING CLAUSE.** Section 5 of Municipal Ordinance No. 3, s. 2011 is hereby further amended as follows:

**SECTION 5.** The rental of the Abuyog Hotel Restaurant shall not be less than Fifteen Thousand (P15,000.00) per month, subject to final negotiations of the Local Chief Executive with the interested operator of the said restaurant. However, an additional 20% increase yearly after 5 years' operations shall be added to the final amount of rental fee that shall be agreed upon by both the LCE and the operator.

**SECTION 5a.** All interested operators to manage the said facility of the hotel are subject for the review of the Office of the Municipal Mayor as to the business experiences, legal papers are required, and the cuisines herein required in this amendatory or supplanting ordinance, such as Japanese, Filipino and other Asian cuisines.

**SECTION 5b.** The restaurant operator is hereby allowed to undertake the necessary repair or improvement inside the restaurant so as to conform the theme or ambiance of the restaurant cuisines including the opening of a separate entrance door for its operations. Provided, however, that any improvement or alteration should not deviate from the original concept of design of the entire hotel.

**SECTION 5c.** That the occupant leasee shall be responsible in the payment of consumed electricity from the installed sub electric meter and shall be paid at the Municipal Treasurer's Office.


**SECTION 2. REPEALING CLAUSE.** Municipal Ordinance No. 3, s. 2011 is hereby amended and/or supplanted accordingly. All other municipal ordinances and resolutions or any parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 3. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If any provision, section or part of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the other provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be operative.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This Ordinance shall be effective in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

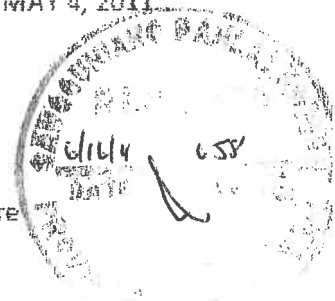

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING FOR ROOM TARIFF FOR THE OCCUPANCY OF ABUYOG HOTEL AND THE USE OF ITS FACILITIES PROVIDING FEES, TAXES, OTHER CHARGES AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATIONS THEREOF

Be it ordained by the 15<sup>th</sup> Sangguniang Bayan of Abuyog, Leyte in session assembled, that:

SECTION I. ABUYOG HOTEL CORRESPONDING ROOM TARIFF FOR THE 24 HOURS OCCUPANCY.

2% (22%) VAT is included on the fees stipulated above.

SECTION II. The rate charge per room category is only good for two (2) occupants and/or guests, an additional of Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) per person or guest shall be charge once the allowed occupants exceed.

SECTION III. A Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) shall be charge for every additional bed and/or extra bed.

SECTION IV. The management of the hotel shall be responsible in the determination of PEAK MONTHS and SHOULDER MONTHS.

SECTION V. The rate in the use of other facilities within the hotel shall be govern by the passage of an ordinance by the Sangguniang Bayan, this municipality.

SECTION VI. That the check in time will be any time of the day and the check out time will be at 12:00 noon the following day.

SECTION VII. That the occupants tenants of the Abuyog Hotel's Room, Restaurant and Coffee Shop shall not be allowed to deviate or destroy the existing condition or construct any extension or additional structures or whatsoever and whatsoever inside and/or outside the Hotel Rooms, Restaurant or Coffee Shop without written authority from the Office of the Municipal Engineer of the Local Government Unit of Abuyog, Leyte, subject to the approval of the Municipal Mayor with the concurrence of the Sangguniang Bayan;

SECTION VIII. No person be allowed to loiter or standby inside the Hotel or its premises except at the waiting area of the lobby of the hotel while transaction with the Hotel is pending.

SECTION IX. Any person violating any of the provision of this ordinance shall suffer a fine of not less than 5,000.00 and the maximum fine would be in proportion to the damages incurred therein or an imprisonment of not less than One (1) month but not more than six (6) months or both but such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court, Article 279, of IRR of R.A. 7160 known as the Local Government Code of 1991;

SECTION X. Any ordinance or parts of this ordinance which are inconsistent to any of the provisions hereof are hereby repealed or modified accordingly;

SECTION XI. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its approval unless the same is disallowed or disapproved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte in the future.

70. accordingly. Section 3. Separability Clause. If any provisions, section or part of this  
71. ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, the  
72. other provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be operative. Section 4. Effectivity  
73. Clause. This ordinance shall be effective in accordance with the provisions of Republic  
74. Act No. 7160 otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991. Kun waray na
