BE IT ORDAINED BY THE 19TH SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ABUYOG, LEYTE IN A **REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED; that:**

The new inserted provisions and or sections will now be read as follows; to wit:

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall be known and referred to as AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THRU INSERTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 14, SERIES 2020 AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ABUYOG FISH LANDING AND TRADING CENTER IMPOSING REGULATORY FEES AND CHARGES AND PENALTIES FOR **VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

All fish vendor (postors) shall signify with the Office of Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) and shall fill up a duly accomplished registration form.

b. The MENRO or his duly authorize representative shall issue order of payment in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (P2,000.00) payable at the Municipal Treasurer's Office.

The Municipal Treasurer's Office or his duly authorized representative shall issue

Official Receipt (OR) with the corresponding amount as stipulated in the order of payment

d. The Official Receipt shall be presented to the MENRO as basis for the issuance of a Registration Certificateduly signed by the Local Chief Executive.

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE ABUYOG FISH LANDING AND TRADING CENTER IMPOSING REGULATORY FEES AND CHARGES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be it ordained by the 18th Sangguniang Bayan of Abuyog, Leyte, that,

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and referred as "THE 2020 ABLIYOG LEYTE FISH LANDING AND TRADING CENTER ORDINANCE"

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND COVERAGE - This Ordinance shall cover the municipality of Abuyog, Leyte for the purpose of operation and management of the Abuyog Fish Landing at Barangay Sto. Niño and shall be declared as the trading post of fish and all other fresh and marine products in the municipality and from other places to bolster economic growth of the fishing industry and trade of our locality.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

> 1. Trade- is the buying and selling of goods and services with compensation paid by a buyer to a seller for the exchange of goods or services between

parties.

- 2. Fish Landing Center facility situated at Barangay Sto. Niño, Abuyog, Leyte along the Cadac-an River where buying and selling of seafood are being conducted at a prescribed time of a day.
- 3. Trader a person who conducts trading by accepting trade and declaring good sold.
- 4. Marginal Catch the minimal catch of a fisherman which shall not exceed five (5) kilograms of low grade type fish.
- 5. Fisher folk Organization refers to the qualified and/or identified beneficiary which has undergone a series of trainings and orientation for the project and shall be duly accredited and/or registered by the DOLE and the municipal government through the Sangguniang Bayan that shall enter a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the local government unit for the purpose of managing the facility for livelihood.
- 6. Loading & Unloading Fee the fee collected from fish producer/supplier who loads and unloads fish and other marine products qualified for trade per kilogram at the AFLTC.
- 7. Fish Broker A person whose business is to bring a seller of fish and shellfish and other qualified legally for sell marine products and a purchaser.

SECTION 4. THE FISH LANDING AND TRADING CENTER

The Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) consist of a building, is equip with ice storage, weights and measures and other facilities capable of handling variety of fish landed and other marine produce, maintaining their quality and freshness for safety and sustainability;

Fishing boats and vessels shall only unload their catch at the Fish Landing and Trading Center; likewise, the fish suppliers from other municipalities or cities.

Fish buyers/postor from coastal barangays are strictly required to deliver/bring their fishery products directly to the fish landing center for the purpose of paying certain fees before the transport within or outside the municipality.

SECTION 5. RULES GOVERNING THE CONDUCT OF FISH TRADING

All fishing vessels, fish buyer, dealers/traders/broker (importer local traders, Fish Cars and the like are hereby mandated to dock, load, unload their marine products, and hold their business at the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center. Trading shall be undertaken twenty-four (24) hours daily unless suspended through the recommendation and/or resolution of the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (MDRRMC) due to storm surge and other similar natural calamity.

Fishermen shall directly sell their catch to their respective fish buyers in the barangay and all fish buyers/postor are required to deliver the product at the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) and be given the priority in the conduct of fish distribution for retail.

The Trader. There shall be designated trader that shall be responsible in the conduct of trading for all seafood products docked and unloaded at the Fish Landing and Trading Center.

The trader shall be responsible in determining the initial trade value of seafood products unloaded at the center.

Manner of Payment. Immediately after docking, operators and/or boat owner shall pay the required berthing fee. No watercraft and vehicle shall be allowed to leave the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center without paying the berthing fee and other charges prescribed by the local government unit of Abuyog.

Evidence of Payment. All fees and charges shall be issued ticket stubs or corresponding forms or official receipts from the Office of the Municipal Treasurer. Proceeds shall accrue to general and trust fund of the municipality. Trust fund will be used for the operation of the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC).

- **SECTION 6. FEES AND CHARGES** There shall be collected fees and charges in the conduct of fish trading and other activities within the Fish Landing and Trading Center.
 - A. Entrance Fee. For purpose of this ordinance. The following entrance fees shall be collected during "operation hours" for Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center AFLTC clients.

a.	2 to 3 wheeled motor vehicle	Php10.00
b.	Bongo/Elf/Multicab/Jeepney	Php15.00
c.	6 wheeler fish car/vehicles	Php 30.00

B. Space & Table Rentals.

- a. Table rental Php 300.00 per month (papag at the ground floor)
- b. Second Floor shall be intended for SUTUKIL (Sugba, Tula, Kilaw), a Twenty Pesos (Php 20.00) per square meter/month shall be collected. A contract of agreement shall be made to be facilitated by the MENR Officer or his/her authorized assigned personnel.
- C. Berthing/Docking Fee. The owner of vessel docking in the Abuyog Pish Landing and Trading Center shall pay the following berthing fees to the designated collector the following:

a.	Passenger & Service boat	Php	5.00/day
b.	Small Scale Commercial Fishing Boat	Php	30.00/docking
c.	Medium Scale Commercial Fishing Boat	Php	50.00/docking

f. Berthing in excess of 1 day shall be charge at the rate of Php 50.00 per day provided it shall not obstruct the Fish Landing Facility operation.

- E. Water Fee- All accredited stall owner & Fish vendors is entitled to use the water facility of the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) and pay the monthly water fee amounting to Php 50.00.
- **F.** Electricity Fee- All accredited stall owner & vendors inside the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) are obliged to pay the monthly electricity fee amounting to Php 50.00.
- **SECTION 7. MANAGEMENT AND ADMINISTRATION.** The AFLTC shall be manage, administered and operated only by the qualified identified beneficiaries who have undergone a series of training and orientations intended for the purpose. The second floor or the roof top shall be managing by the qualified/identified person to rent as provided for in Section 6 par. B letter "b" hereof.
 - **A. MANAGEMENT OF PEOPLES ORGANIZATION**. The Peoples Organization (PO) shall create rules, regulations and 'guidelines in the management of the Trading Center not inconsistent with this ordinance and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Board of Trustees.
 - **B. SHARE OF INCOME**. Prior to the turn-over to the fisher folk association, the capital and income of the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) during the LGU management shall be remitted back to the coffer of the local government.

During the People's Organization (PO) management, the gross receipts shall be divided as follows:

- 1. Ten percent (10%) of Income per month shall be directly the share of the Municipality of Abuyog and shall be remitted to the Municipal Treasurer's Office on or before the 5th day of the succeeding month.
- 2. Ninety percent (90%) shall be the share of the fisher folk's organization to cover utilities, personnel, security and other operational expenses including maintenance to ensure the effective and efficient service of fish landing. The remaining amount from the 90% share shall be considered as net profit of the Peoples Organization (PO) that is gradually be summed up to cope up the investment capital. The Peoples Organization (PO) shall create a resolution through the officers regarding a profit sharing scheme of the members when the financial capacity is already in place.


SECTION 8. RESTRICTIONS

- **A.** Gambling of any form is prohibited in all areas. Selling/dispensing Alcoholic beverages are allowed in Second floor of the Facility.
- **B.** No endangered marine species/products that are prohibited under existing laws and local ordinances shall be allowed to land or to be traded in the fish landing center and its premises.
- C. No major repair and/or construction of fishing vessels is allowed within the fish landing center and its premises.
- **D.** All owners and operators of fishing vessels that dock in the fish landing center shall maintain the cleanliness and seaworthiness of their vessels and avoid all forms of pollution within the fish landing center and its immediate docking areas.

- E. The solid waste management in the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) shall be strictly observed.
- F. No private entities shall be allowed to operate another fish landing center within the territorial jurisdiction of this municipality.
- **G.** Conduct of seafood trading activity along the coastal barangays of the municipality of Abuyog shall no longer be allowed except for those considered marginal catch.
- **SECTION 9. SUPERVISION** the Municipal Mayor thru the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office shall monitor, administer and issue the necessary rules and regulations for the effective and efficient implementation of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 10. WHERE TO PAY** The fees imposed in this ordinance shall be paid to the Municipal Treasurer or his/her duly authorized representatives.

3. MENRO shall:

- a. Act as the Vice Chair of the Board of Trustees (BOT).
- **b.** Formulate measures and provide technical assistance and support to Local Chief Executive (LCE) in carrying out measures to ensure the delivery of basic services.
- **4. Fee Collector-** a person in-charge in the collection of fees in transactions inside the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC). Collected amount will be recorded and be remitted to the cashier.
- 5. Trader-a person who conducts trading by accepting trade and declaring good sold.
- **6. Maintenance Personnel-** performing routine building and surrounding maintenance task.
- 7. Community Facilitator A person, who is technically capacitated responsible for the supervision in management of Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC), recommends training/seminar of AFLTC personnel when it is necessary. He is also in charge in keeping records of operation and financial that will be periodically submitted to MENRO for evaluation.
- 8. AFLTC Manager a person who is responsible for dealing daily operation of the AFLTC.
- 9. Cashier/Bookkeeper in charge for the collected amount from the operation and keep records for accounting. Responsible also in the remittance to the LGU as prescribed hereto the schedule of the same. He/she is also responsible in preparing of financial reports to be presented during BOT meting for update.

SECTION 12. PENALTY CLAUSE

A. In violation of Section 5 of this ordinance shall be penalized by confiscating the fishery products in favor of the Local Government Unit (LGU) and shall have the following administrative sanctions:

- **SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE**. All ordinances, executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.
- SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If, for any reason or reasons, any part or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- SECTION 15. TRANSITORY PERIOD- The Office of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources (MENRO) is mandated to organize and train the fisher folk association and its officers, shall jointly managed the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) as designated by the Municipal Mayor. The LGU shall provide an amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php 250,000.00) as capital for buying of all seafood products inside the Abuyog Fish Landing and Trading Center (AFLTC) if in case there are excessive volumes of fish catch delivered.

The facility (AFLTC) will be turn over to the People's Organization (PO) after one year or at the time that they are now ready and capable of managing the operation of the facility. The profit gained in the operation of the facility shall be turn over to the municipal local government. The PO must have sufficient amount that can run the fish trading business as well as the management and maintenance of the entire facility. However, the PO shall still be under the supervision of the LGU in terms of management, operation, price control and the settlement possible dispute among members.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after the publication required by law has been satisfied.
