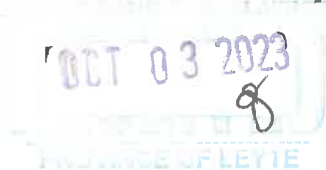

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 14 S.2023 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Macarthur, Leyte, recommending for the declaration of its validity, pursuant to its power under Section 56 (C) of R.A. 7160ⁱ, the same being to the opinion of the Provincial Legal Office, an exercise of the power essential to the promotion of the General Welfare, authorized Section 16ⁱⁱ of the Code and in accordance with Section 447(5)(v)ⁱⁱⁱ thereof.

ⁱ Section 56(C) - If the sangguniang panlalawigan finds that such an ordinance or resolution is beyond the power conferred upon the sangguniang panlungsod or sangguniang bayan concerned, it shall declare such ordinance or resolution invalid in whole or in part. The sangguniang panlalawigan shall enter its action in the minutes and shall advise the corresponding city or municipal authorities of the action it has taken.

ⁱⁱ Section 16 - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

ⁱⁱⁱ Regulate the use of streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks and other public places and approve the construction, improvement, repair and maintenance of the same; establish bus and vehicle stops and terminals or regulate the use of the same by privately-owned vehicles which serve the public; regulate garages and the operation of conveyances for hire; designate stands to be occupied by public vehicles when not in use; regulate the putting up of signs, signposts, awnings and awning posts on the streets; provide for the lighting, cleaning and sprinkling of streets and public places;

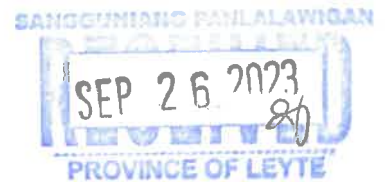

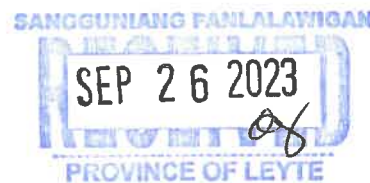

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING BICYCLE LANES DESIGNATING ROADS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MACARTHUR, LEYTE AND PROVIDING FUNDS THEREOF

SPONSORED BY : Honorable Leonardo R. Leria Jr.

WHEREAS, Section 16 of Republic Act No 7160, also known as the Local Government Code of 1991 empowers the Sangguniang Bayan to enact measures directed towards the promotion of a safe and life, protection and conservation of environment and general welfare;

WHEREAS, as the country prepares for its transition to the "New Normal" amid the COVID-19 pandemic, the stringent social distancing protocols required to maintain safe public transportation system will limit its current capacity. The use of bicycles and walking paths have been promoted as essential and safer modes of transport as this allows physical distancing and provides the needed mobility for citizens to proceed with their daily activities;

to accord highest priority to the development for proper sidewalks and networks of bicycle lanes to promote a more sustainable and inclusive transport system that encourages active transport and provides safe and direct access to priority services;

WHEREAS, the Department of Interior and Local Government Memorandum Circular No. 2020-100 dated July 17, 2020 provides the Guidelines for the establishments of a Network of Cycling Lanes and Walking Paths to Support People's Mobility;

WHEREAS, there is a need to establish bike lanes in designated roads in the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte in order to safe guard bikers and cyclist and reduces road-related incidents. Moreover, establishing bike lanes and road sharing schemes will promote the use of bikes which is an alternative mode of transportation, emission-free, affordable to the masses and occupies less space;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Leonardo R. Leria Jr., duly seconded by Honorable Xandrix P. Pantin, Honorable Jonathan T. Barquin, Honorable Raul E. Mundala, Honorable Pepito C. Guimalan, be it

Ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte that

SECTION 1. TITLE – This ordinance shall be known as the MacArthur, Leyte Bicycle Ordinance.

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION – The application of this ordinance shall be limited to human bikes/bicycles on designated bike lanes in the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS – For the purpose of this ordinance, the following terms shall mean:

Active Transport – refers to non-motorized means to travel, including walking or use of travel, including walking or use of bicycles, skateboards or scooters.

Bike/Bicycle – refers to any two-wheeled vehicle which is solely and wholly human powered.

Designated Bike Lanes – refer to the areas designated as priority lane for passage of wholly human-powered vehicles/ bikes/ bicycles. This is a 1.5-meter-wide pavement marked by either a solid or broken line and located on the rightmost side of the road to indicate where bikers/ cyclist should ride their bike/bicycles. Bike lanes with solid lines to indicate that no motor vehicle encroachment shall be allowed at all times.

Bike/Cycling Lane – refers to a road, street or path where private motorized transport is not allowed in order to ensure the safety of

Bicycle users or those using light mobility transport.

Bicycle Racks – bicycle parking facility that shall allow the bicycle to be supported upright by its frame (2) places and should allow the frame and one or both wheels to be secured by locking the frame and one wheel of each bicycle parked therein with the use of either the u-locks or cable locks.

Cyclist/Biker – refers to the person riding a bicycle

Bicycle Safety Gear – refers to protective gear such as helmet and night blinkers/ lights and reflectors

Light Mobility – refers to travel using electronic or non-motorized vehicles weighing not more than 100kg.

Local Roads – refer to Provincial/Municipal and Barangay Roads.

Provincial Roads – connect municipalities without traversing national roads, connect national roads to barangays through rural areas and connect to major/provincial government infrastructures;

Municipal Roads – roads within the Poblacion, roads that connect to provincial and national roads, roads that provide inter-barangay connections to major municipal infrastructure without traversing provincial roads.

Barangay Roads – other public roads within the barangay and not covered in the above definitions.

Pedestrian – refers to a person who uses the shared paths or sidewalks

Walking Paths – refers to the pathways which can be used by pedestrians

Motorized Transport – refers to motorized vehicles weighing more than 100kg.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF THE LOCAL PUBLIC TRANSPORT ROUTE TEAM – (Route Team for Bicycle Lane) The LPTRT for Bicycle Lane shall be created which will comprise the following:

SECTION 5. FUNCTIONS AND DUTIES OF THE LPTRT for BICYCLE LANE - It is the function and responsibility of the team for the following:

- a) Develop a plan for the establishment of network of bike lanes and walking paths
- b) Implement programs, projects and activities to support the bike lanes;
- c) Oversee the implementation of the plan and/ or proposed scheme;
- d) Develop a monitoring and evaluation mechanism to ensure proper implementation;
- e) Ensure strict law enforcement in accordance to local and national laws and policies.

SECTION 6. CLEARING OF ROADS OF ILLEGAL OBSTRUCTION - LGU MacArthur, Leyte shall strictly and effectively implement the provisions under the Municipal Ordinance No. 04, Series of 2019. This also include illegally parked cars on streets, thereby local roads cleared of illegal obstruction may be utilized as bike lanes and walking paths.


SECTION 7. SAFE INTERSECTIONS - The LPTRT for Bicycle Lane shall evaluate all intersections to ensure that people using active transport are able to safely cross and change directions. Further, LGU MacArthur, Leyte shall consider the following:

- a) Provision of bike boxes on intersections
- b) To ensure that Traffic Enforcers and MacArthur Emergency Rescue Team are equipped with first aid kits to ensure immediate response to those in need.

SECTION 8. RIGHTS, DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS OF BIKERS/CYCLIST - The following shall be the rights, duties and obligations of bikers/ cyclist, to wit;

- 1. Bikers/Cyclist are required to wear helmets and reflectorized vests or bright-colored shirts while riding their bikes;
- 2. Bikers/Cyclist shall always keep a two-hand drives at all times unless doing hand signals or when he is a person with disability
- 3. Bikers/Cyclist are prohibited on carrying back riders while on transit and thereby directed to carry only minimal loads as bicycles are not designated to carry much cargo.

4. Bikers/Cyclist are prohibited from counter flowing or maneuvering between vehicles outside their designated lanes.
5. Bikers/Cyclists shall at all times have bicycle reflectors both in its front and rear side
6. Bikers/Cyclists must register their bikes by securing a plate number at the Office of the Municipal Treasurer
7. Bikers/Cyclists must follow traffic or road signs or signage's and abide by all existing traffic laws, rules and regulations as enumerated in Municipal Ordinance No. 03, Series of 2017
8. Minors may be allowed to bike under the supervision and guidance of an adult

SECTION 9. BICYCLE PARKING – All public places, government offices, schools, major business establishments, banks, restaurants, hospitals and the like within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte are hereby required to provide bicycle racks for bicycle parking.

SECTION 10. RESPONSIBILITY OF BICYCLE PARKING FACILITIES USERS – In this ordinance, the bicycle users are encouraged to be equipped with chain and padlocks u-lock or cable locks

SECTION 11. PROHIBITED ACTS – The following are prohibited acts:

1. No person shall cause or create any and all kind of obstruction along the bicycle lanes such as but not limited to, parking of vehicles, sidewalk, vending, dumping of constructions materials and loading and unloading of goods except in emergency cases or situations.
2. No biker shall be allowed to bike under the influence of alcohol and prohibited substances;
3. Bikers shall all time traverse within the designated bike lanes;
4. No person shall operate a bike on a roadway unless he or she is equipped with proper breaks, lights and reflector and wearing safety gear
5. No person operating a bicycle on a highway shall ride on a seat other than the permanent and regular seat;

SECTION 12. PENALTIES – The following are the penalties of this ordinance:

Every offense a citation ticket will be issued for such purpose.

SECTION 13. ENFORCEMENT – The LPTRT for Bicycle Lane shall be responsible for the strict implementation of this ordinance.



- a) Traffic Education Enforcement
- b) Motorist Awareness
- c) Bicycle and Pedestrian Safety

The programs will be designed for traffic enforcers, motorists, bikers/cyclists and the commuting public.

SECTION 15. APPROPRIATIONS – For the implementation of this ordinance, a fund allocation must be appropriated, under Special which its source of funds will be taken from a Regular Annual Budget.

SECTION 16. PARTICIPATION TO THE CELEBRATION OF WORLD CAR FREE DAY AND ON DESIGNATED DAY OR DAYS FOR THE PURPOSE – To promote the use of bicycles, the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte shall participate in the annual celebration of World Car Free Day every second Sunday of September, by organizing events and on such day or days consistent with the public welfare

SECTION 17. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE – If for any reason or reasons, any part of provision of this ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 18. EFFECTIVITY – This Ordinance shall take effect after the approval from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and the requirement of posting prescribed in RA 7160 is complied with.

ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled on September 4, 2023 at MacArthur, Leyte, Philippines.



The activity was to tackle the following proposed Municipal Ordinances:

Municipal Ordinance No. 10, Series of 2023
Municipal Ordinance No. 05, Series of 2023
Municipal Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2023

The program started at 10:42 in the morning. It began with a prayer and singing of the national anthem and MacArthur Hymn and followed by acknowledging the participants done by Ms. Judelyn Eusebio.

Afterwards, The Local Chief Executive, Honorable Rudin T. Babante, graced the event with his welcome address. He thanked everyone for their presence and stated the relevance of the public hearing. He shared that he received complaints from drivers/operators, and some are going to his residence to raise their complaints. He also stated that, to generate income, permit holders should pay their obligations. After he delivered his message, he excused himself to attend into his commitments.

Along this line, Honorable Lazar, Chairman on the Committee on Transportation, proponent of proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 10, Series of 2023. He presented his proposal highlighting the following provisions:

- ARTICLE III DEFINITION OF TERMS SECTION 1.
- ARTICLE V RESTRICTIONS ON THE MANNER OF DRIVING AND SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES SECTION 2 and 3

do not have permits causes rivalry in the accommodation of passengers. Mr. Noya, President of TODA suggested to have the traffic enforcers to render duty the whole day. Honorable Lazar answered by citing Chapter 7 stating that the traffic management office is mandated to monitor the traffic. Meanwhile Honorable Milar, Punong Barangay raised his concern on those motorpots who has the maximum capacity of 6 passengers, who does not accommodate or denies transporting passengers with less than the number of 6 passengers. Honorable Lazar stated that drivers are not allowed to refuse. Mr. Noya there could only be two passengers based on the policy of TODA. A participant from Barangay Causwagan suggested that there should be waiting time. Mr. Noya added that in terms of emergency cases they immediately go. Honorable Canete, Punong Barangay stated to consider the drivers since they are also incurring fuel expenses. The Honorable Vice Mayor declared that it is case to case basis and in terms of emergency, it shall be accommodated. He also asked the number of colorum operators operating without permit. Mrs. Acala, BPLO, answered that there are approximately 20. Furthermore, Honorable Mundala said to identify what type of emergency is being catered to. Mr. Noya shared that their group are giving community services such as librenng sakay for students. Meanwhile, Honorable Pantin recommended that the habal-habal should reorganize and submit to the MTO the names of its members. Mr. Molero, habal-habal operator said that they are willing to pay but still waiting for the ordinance. He also aired his sentiments that habal-habal are considered private and only Angkas is the only single motorcycle transportation that is being recognized by the government to accommodate passengers.

Furthermore, Mr. Pille, a member of TODA answered to Mr. Paguipo that situation is on case to case basis like if there are members of TODA who are willing to transport passengers to upland barangays. Honorable Remanes Jr. suggested to have specific routes for habal-habal and motorpots. He also added that habal-habal must give the list of its members and have an organized association.

Ms. Acala, BPLO-Designate suggested that there will be a ticket to be issued in the amount of 10.00 per day of per operation. Honorable Pantin also manifested to have fare matrix schedule and the regulatory fees will be based on the Local Revenue Code.

After the open forum for the proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 10, Series of 2023, Honorable Leria Jr. presented the proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2023. Immediately it was followed with the open forum. Mr. Pille asked if the pedicabs will still be allowed to pass through the bicycle lane. Honorable Leria Jr. answered that they will still be allowed given that they will give priority to bicycle riders.

Since there no much concerns raised with the proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 14, Series of 2023, it was followed with the presentation of the Municipal Ordinance NO. 05, Series of 2023. It was presented by Honorable Remanes Jr. After the presentations was made, Honorable
