- A RESOLUTION APPROVING ON THIRD AND FINAL READING, PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE 131
- NO. 2023-___, ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF PROVINCIAL ROADS 132
- WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE PROVINCE OF LEYTE AND FOR OTHER 133
- 134 PURPOSES".

WHEREAS, data from the Provincial Engineering Office provides that there are 135 Five Hundred Ninety-Four (594) kilometers, more or less, that are classified as Provincial 136 Roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte; 137

WHEREAS, of those classified as provincial roads, eighty-five percent (85%) are 138 139 already paved, and the rest are still classified as gravel roads;

WHEREAS, the technical design insofar as the thickness is concerned of existing paved provincial roads is either six (6) inches or eight (8) inches only;

WHEREAS, with a such technical design of said provincial roads, thus, can cater only to light vehicles or equipment.

WHEREAS, it has been observed that the unimpeded ingress and egress of heavy equipment or vehicles specifically those that are loaded with quarry or sand and gravel resources along this provincial road network whether paved or unpaved, undeniably, had caused material damage and had, in fact, caused damaged thereof, including but not limited to, cracks, creating potholes or shortening the useful life of the concrete roads, thus, posing inconvenience and imminent danger and safety of motorists and pedestrians;

152 153 154	WHEREAS, the interests of the few should not prevail over the good of the greater number in the community whose, among others, the safety, good order and general welfare, to which the elected officials are under a legal obligation to protect.
155 156 157	WHEREAS , every local government unit has the sworn obligation to enact measures that will enhance, among others, the safety and convenience, and promote the general prosperity of the inhabitants of the local units.
158 159 160 161 162	WHEREAS, Section 155, Republic Act No. 7160, authorizes the Sanggunian to prescribe the terms and conditions and fix the rates for the imposition of toll fees or charges for the use of any public road, pier or wharf, waterway, bridge, ferry or telecommunication system funded and constructed by the local government unit concerned. $x \times x$.

172	Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, that:
173 174 1 7 5	Section 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Use of Provincial Roads Within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, Prescribing Penalties Fess for Violation Thereof."
176 177 178 179 180	Section 2. – PROHIBITED VEHICLES - The use of Provincial Roads, whether paved or unpaved is hereby regulated, any and all vehicle or equipment of whatever type with a Gross Vehicle Weight of more than Seventeen Thousand (17000) Kilograms, is strictly prohibited from entering, traversing or exiting all provincial roads within the territorial jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte.
181	Excepted from the coverage of this Ordinance, to wit:
182 183 184	 Vehicles and/or equipment of the Provincial Government of Leyte, and its component city and municipalities, if any;
185 186 187 188	 Vehicles and/or equipment of the national government doing construction projects, or other governmental activities along or near or within the vicinity of a provincial road, if any;

- Vehicles and/or equipment used for humanitarian, emergency, peace and order, disaster, and health operations, and analogous activities, if any;
- 4. Such other vehicles and/or equipment as may be exempted or authorized by the Provincial Governor or his duly authorized representative.

Provided, however, and subject to the gross vehicle weight provided for under Section 1 hereof, the owners of private vehicles/equipment and/or vehicles/equipment used by private contractors doing government construction projects, or other governmental activities along or near or within the vicinity of a provincial road, if any, may be allowed to enter, traverse or exit the said provincial roads, upon posting of an appropriate bond in cash or surety to answer for whatever damage that be caused to the provincial roads as a result of the use thereof in an amount to be determined by the Provincial Engineering Office payable to the order of the Provincial Treasurer's Office and issuance of permit to use by the Governor or his duly authorized representative.

Section 3. **DEPUTIZATION OF MUNICIPAL AND BARANGAY TREASURERS** – Subject to bonding requirements, the respective Municipal and Barangay Treasurer of each component city, municipalities, and barangays of the Province of Leyte are hereby deputized and authorized to issue citation tickets for violations of this ordinance committed within its jurisdiction.

The deputized collectors shall be entitled to collect an honorarium in the amount equivalent to ten percent (10%) of the total amount paid to the Provincial Treasurer's Office on a weekly basis as a result of their performance as deputized officers.

- Section 4. PENALTY Any person who is found to have violated this Ordinance shall be meted with the civil penalty of Five Thousand (5,000) Pesos per meter traversed beginning from the point of entry to exit basis and without prejudice to the filing of a civil and/or criminal action appropriate under the circumstances for violation hereof.
- Section 5. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE If for any reason or reasons, any part of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- **Section 5. REPEALING CLAUSE** All other Ordinances, orders, issuances, and rules. and regulations inconsistent with this Order are hereby modified and/or repealed accordingly.
- Section 6. EFFECTIVITY This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.

HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

Mr. Chair, as a background, this is a revised proposed ordinance. The original was submitted to us crafted by the Provincial Legal Office and then we referred it to the Committee on Environment because we saw that there were lack of connection between the "lawful subject and the lawful means". Now, this proposed ordinance as revised, has a "vinculum juris" between the "lawful subject and the lawful means."

The lawful subject being the preservation of Provincial Roads and lawful means is to provide penalties for violation. This was emailed to me by Atty. Acol, the Assistant Provincial Legal Officer.

On that note, Mr. Chair, I move that we approve this on First Reading and refer this to the Committee on Environment and the Committee on Rules. I so move.

HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

Yes, the Honorable Ebbie Apostol.

HON. TRINIDAD G. APOSTOL: 2ND DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

My observation of this proposed provincial ordinance, Mr. Chairman. According to the Provincial Ordinance, there are 594 kms. of Provincial Roads classified by the Provincial Engineering Office and Eighty-Five (85%) percent are already paved and the rest are still classified as gravel roads.

This representation would like to know if these 594 kms. of roads are still paved, because in my first term as Congresswoman, we have already converted several Provincial Roads to National Roads. So, I would like to know if this is a correct figure the 594 kms., what is being proposed by this ordinance. Thank you, Mr. Chairman, thank you, Mr. Floor Leader.

HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

Mr. Chair, I do not have an updated communication or data as to the length of the Provincial Roads that still remain as Provincial Roads. Nonetheless, we can pass a

resolution asking the Provincial Engineer or summon the Provincial Engineer for that purpose, Mr. Chair.

HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER Anyway, this is only for first reading.

HON. CARLO P. LORETO: FLOOR LEADER/5TH DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

Yes. At any rate, Mr. Chair, the gravity of the offense in this Provincial Ordinance is that, once it is an existing Provincial Roads and then you go there with a truck with a gross vehicle weight of more than 17,000 kilogram then you are in violation of this ordinance. It if is no longer a provincial road then it is not a violation of this ordinance, Mr. Chair. So, it is a matter of proof in court, Mr. Chair.

At any rate, we can pass a resolution after approving this ordinance on first reading, we can pass a resolution requesting the Provincial Engineering Office.

The Honorable Reposar, Mr. Chair.

HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER
The Honorable Reposar, you are recognized.

HON. RONNAN CHRISTIAN M. REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER

Thank you very much, Honorable Presiding Chair, and Honorable Floor Leader. This is just a query with reference to the title of the ordinance. The confusion actually emanates from the attached resolution wherein the title is "An Ordinance, Regulating the Use of Provincial Roads within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte and for other purposes." While on the Body of the ordinance, Section 1 particularly, the title is "Use of Provincial Roads within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte prescribing penalties, fees for violation thereof." So, may we know from our movant, which title we will approve since the 2 differs in some words? Actually I have a suggestion, "An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Provincial Roads within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, Prescribing Fees and Imposing Penalties for Violation thereof."

Further, perhaps, instead of just Provincial Road we can include Municipal and Barangay Roads because it is the Province who is maintaining and spending for the concreting and maintenance of Municipal and Barangay Roads as well. So perhaps, the title would be as follows:

"An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Provincial Roads, Municipal Roads and Barangay Roads within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the Province of Leyte, Prescribing Penalties, Fees, for Violation thereof and for other purposes."

In several instances where there are application for titling or possessions of old Spanish Roads, the Provincial Engineering Office has consistently made a certification to the effect that it is not part of the Provincial Road system. The Provincial Engineering has been consistent.

HON. MICHAEL L. CARI: TEMP. PRESIDING OFFICER/5TH DIST. BOARD MEMBER

Yes, the Honorable Vincent Rama.

As the movant was stating, this is a revised ordinance. The question of this representation is, since penalties are prescribed and there are fees, does this have to go through another public hearing? Or is this a revised ordinance?
