#### **RESOLUTION NO. 325**

RESOLUTION URGING ALL SANGGUNIAN PANLALAWIGAN. SANGGUNIANG PANGLUNGSOD, SANGGUNIANG BAYAN AND SANGGUNIANG BARANGAY TO EXPRESS COLLECTIVE SUPPORT FOR THE PHILIPPINE GOVERNMENT'S EFFORTS IN PROTECTING THE WEST PHILIPPINE SEA

WHEREAS, the West Philippine Sea, a vital part of Philippine territory and an important maritime region encompassing various features and resources, is currently facing territorial disputes and incursions by foreign entities, which pose a significant threat to the sovereignty, security, and economic interests of the Philippines:

WHEREAS, the Philippines has an inherent and exclusive right over the West Philippine Sea as affirmed by the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS), the 2016 ruling of the Permanent Court of Arbitration, and various international treaties and agreements:

WHEREAS, the preservation and protection of the West Philippine Sea are crucial for the livelihaad of millions of Filipinos who rely on its marine resources for sustenance and economic activities, including fishing and trade;

WHEREAS, recent events have raised concerns about the presence and activities of foreign vessels and entitles within the West Philippine Sea, which threaten the territorial integrity and sovereignty of the Philippines:

WHEREAS, it is the solemn duty of every local government unit to support and cooperate with the national government in matters concerning national sovereignty, territorial integrity, and security and to stand united behind the Philippine Government's efforts to protect the nation's interests in the West Philippine Sec:

WHEREAS. Section 16 of the Local Government Code of the Philippines empowers local government units to participate in the formulation of policies affecting their jurisdiction and to support the national government in the pursuit of its goals and objectives;

WHEREAS, the Sanggunians as local legislative bodies across the Philippines, have a responsibility to represent and protect the interests of their respective constituents and contribute to the overall well-being and security of the nation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sanggunian Panlalawigan of the Province of Aurara hereby expresses unwavering support for the Philippine Government's peaceful and lawful actions in the defense of the West Philippine Sea, reaffirming the country's sovereignty and territorial integrity in the face of external challenges:

**RESOLVED FURTHER.** that the Songgunian encourages all local government units within its jurisdiction to:

- Actively promote awareness among their constituents about the significance of the West Philippine Sea to the nation's security, economy, and heritage:
- Collaborate with national government agencies, particularly the Department of National Defense, Department of Foreign Affairs, and the Philippine Coost Guard, to enhance maritime surveillance and security efforts in the West Philippine Sea;
- 3. Foster cooperation with local fishermen and stakeholders engaged in marine activities to ensure their welfare and protection within the West Philippine Sea.
- Advocate for the peaceful but urgent resolution of disputes through diplomatic means, adherence to international law, and respect for the principles of freedom of navigation and over flight;
- 5. Support initiatives aimed at strengthening the capacity of the Armed Forces of the Philippines particularly the Philippine Navy and the Philippine Coast Guard, and other relevant agencies in safeguarding Philippine interests in the West Philippine Sea; and

6. Encourage international cooperation and partnerships that promote the responsible and sustainable management of marine resources in the West Philippine Sea.

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE**, that this Sanggunian is calling upon its counterparts in other provinces, cities, municipalities, and barangays across the country to pass similar resolutions in support of the Philippine Government's stance on the West Philippine Sea, thereby demonstrating a unified and resolute commitment to defending the nation's sovereignty and maritime interests;

**RESOLVED FINALLY.** that copies of this resolution be furnished to the President of the Philippines, the Secretary of the Department of the Interior and Local Government, the Secretary of the Department of National Defense, the Secretary of the Department of Foreign Affairs, the United States of America Embassy and other relevant government agencies, as well as to all local government units, in order to rally collective support for the Philippine Government's steadfast commitment to protecting the West Philippine Sea.
