A RESOLUTION RETURNING TO THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF ORIGIN MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NOS. 38 AND 39 BOTH S-2023-2025 OF VILLABA, LEYTE, FOR COMPLIANCE TO THE COMMENTS AND OBSERVATION OF THE PROVINCIAL LEGAL OFFICE AND SUBMISSION OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS.

WHEREAS, submitted to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan are Municipal Ordinances from Villaba, Leyte, for approval, to wit:

- 1. Municipal Ordinance No. 38, \$-2023-2025 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COMMERCIAL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT AND OTHER PLACES AND SPACES CONSIDERED AS HIGH RISK TO INSTALL VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS OR CLOSED-CIRCUIT TELEVISION AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES";
- 2. Municipal Ordinance No. 39, \$-2023-2025 entitled: "AN ORDINANCE ENACTED TO ESTABLISH A POULTRY AND LIVESTOCK AUCTION MARKET CENTER IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF VILLABA, PROMULGATING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE OPERATION, MANAGEMENT AND MAINTENANCE; PRESCRIBING FEES AND RATES OF ITS OFFERED SERVICES; AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION, PROVIDING FUNDS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES THEREOF";

"SECTION II Penalty Clause

- a. violation of this ordinance shall be penalized:
 - i. New business establishments (with capital of five hundred thousand (P500,000.00) and above shall be given a business permit if it has not complied with this ordinance

EXPLANATORY NOTE

WHEREAS, Section 447(a) of the Local Government Code of 1991, provides that the Sangguniang Bayan as a Legislative Body of the Municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds, for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to 16 of the code and in the proper exercised of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of the code;

WHEREAS, the establishment of a Poultry and Livestock Auction Market Center in the Municipality of Villaba provides the farmers and dealers an accessible centralize location where the farmers and buyers can efficiently and conveniently transact business, and also this will serve as the core of an organized poultry and livestock marketing system reaching through barangay level which will ensure higher profitability for farmers to augment their income and to established a uniform trading system that will serve as the basis for fair and orderly trading between the farmers and dealers;

WHEREAS, while other Local Government Units have been successfully established their own Poultry and Livestock Auction Market Centers, the Local Government Unit of Villaba is also and even more capable to establish a Poultry and Livestock Auction Market Center due to many of our poultry and livestock raisers engaged in raising in a semi-commercial and commercial enterprise:

ARTICLE 1-TITLE AND SCOPE

SECTION 1-TITLE- This Ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance enacted to establish a Poultry and Livestock Auction Market Center in the Municipality of Villaba. Promulgating Rules and Regulations for the operation, management and maintenance; prescribing Fees and Rates of its offered services; and prescribing penalties for violation, providing funds and for other purposes thereof:

SECTION 2-SCOPE- The provisions of this Ordinance shall control, enforce, direct and supervise the poultry and livestock auction market center in general, and the operation, management and maintenance of the poultry and livestock auction market center in particular, in accordance with the provisions of Presidential Decree No. 7 which prescribe measures for the creation and establishment of a poultry and livestock auction market center, promulgating rules and regulations governing the Animal Welfare Act of the Philippines or Republic Act No. 8485.

ARTICLE 11-DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 3- WORDS AND PHRASES DEFINED; Words and Phrases as used in this Ordinance are conceptually and operationally defined as.

- 1. Livestock Auction Market Center- shall refer to a place or establishment serving as a public market for farmers and dealers, equipped with weighing Scale, Corals Tie rails, Loading ramps enclosures and other attendant facilities which Poultry and Livestock are received, weighed and identified for sale.
- 2. Poultry- refers to all domesticated birds or fowl such as Chicken, Turkey, geese, Ducks and others Livestock - refers to all four - legged animals.
- 3. Farmer- hog raisers shall refer to one who directly sells fattened livestock to buyers and dealers, or buy at the market for fattening, stock replacement, breeding for work purposes.
- 4. Dealers- shall generally refer to one who buys livestock for the purpose of reselling it for profit.
- 5. Shipper or Viagero- refer to a dealer who usually procures livestock for shipment and resale to distant places.
- 6. Handler- shall refer to a person engaged in livestock trading as an employee/ intermediary/ agent or either the farmer or dealer.

Animal Welfare- pertain to the physical and psychological well- being of animals, It includes but not limited to the voidance of abuse, maltreatment, cruelty and exploitation of animals by humans by maintaining appropriate standards of accommodation, feeding and general care, the prevention and treatment of disease and the assurance of freedom from fear, destress, harassment, and unnecessary discomfort and pains, and allowing animals to express normal behavior.

ARTICLE III

THE VILLABA POULTRY AND LIVESTOCK AUCTION MARKET CENTER

SECTION 4. CREATION/ ESTABLISHMENT — There shall be created/ established poultry and livestock auction market center in the Municipality of Villaba, Province of Leyte. Which shall be opened, managed and maintained by the Local Government Unit of Villaba (LGU) in cooperation with the supporting line agencies. A minimum area of one hectare shall be provided by the Loal Government Unit of Villaba for the establishment of different structures and facilities such as holding area of disposable poultry and livestock, yards, corrals pens, weighing scale area and other structures and equipment needed in the compound area. The entire area of one hectare shall be fenced to prevent the unwanted entry of the traders and sellers, there shall be one entry point in entering the compound for weighing their disposable livestock, grading and classification which shall be the basis for setting the price for business transaction between the owner, sellers and traders.

SECTION 6- FUNCTIONS- The Poultry and Livestock Auction Center shall perform the following functions:

- 1. To provide the farmers and dealers an accessible centralized location where they can efficiently and conveniently transact business;
- To serve as the core of an organized poultry and livestock marketing system reaching through barangay level which will ensure higher profitability for farmers and enhanced quality for dealers;
- 3. To house poultry and livestock of farmers under satisfactory conditions that meet the standards government requirements;
- 4. To establish a uniform trading system that shall serve as the basis for fair and orderly trading between farmers and dealers;
- 5. To regulate poultry and livestock supply in the Municipality through and efficient distribution system from production points to the market system;
- 6. To issue required clearance on poultry and livestock intended for slaughter and for other purpose;
- 7. To disseminate regularly the updated reports on the prevailing prices, market trends and data relevant to the poultry and livestock industry in particular and the public in general;
- 8. To conduct basic orientation, management training and development program for farmers, dealers, handlers and other parties involved in the local poultry and livestock industry.
- 9. To implements rules and regulations governing the Animal Welfare Act of the Philippines or RA 8485;

10. To provide adequate water and feeds to the animal within the day.

11.To monitor and regulate live weight price in the market.

12. To confiscate, condemn or hold for quarantine diseased animals that warrant immediate action.

SECTION 7- MANAGEMENT- The poultry and livestock auction market center, shall be operated, managed and maintained by the local government unit of Villaba, Leyte. A market manager appointed by the Municipal Mayor, shall assume responsibilities for overall market operation and exercise supervision over a competent staff who shall also be appointed for the purpose, subject however to Civil Service Law. Overall management shall herein under the Municipal Mayor or his duly authorize personnel in the market exercising managerial functions and prerogatives;

SECTION 8- DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES - The management shall be responsible for posturing, preserving and ensuring a competitive market. It shall operate the market in a just and responsible manner without fear or favor towards any party or individual and it shall maintain the animal calibration, yards, corrals, pens, weighing scale and other structures, facilities and equipment, clean orderly and in good condition.

SECTION 9- MARKET DAYS - There shall be an official market days for poultry and livestock every Sundays of the week which shall be opened from 4:00 a:m for arrival of poultry and livestock for sale at the compound or Arena of the market center, and there shall be a closing time every 6:00 p:m for departure of animals and traders following the all in all out policy by the management of the market center personnel. In case the Animal Owner failed to pull out their livestock or any animal for sale in the compound area, the management can impose charges to the violators.

Article VI, Section 23 of this Ordinance or an option will be given to livestock owners for justifiable reasons for the unavailability of their transport to pick up during the agreed time. The management will not be responsible to watch their unpick up livestock after the market day been closed.

Failure of the animal owners to pull out their livestock or any animal for that matter in two (2) days the management will charge Five Hundred Pesos (PHP 500.00) per day for large livestock (Carabao, Castle, Horse) and Two Hundred Pesos (PHP 200.00) for small livestock (Sheep, Hog, Goat), per day.

SECTION 10- MANDATORY OFFER FOR SALE - Poultry and Livestock offered for sale during market days shall be brought to the market center either privately owned or hired vehicle or any conveyances for rent;

SECTION 11- INSPECTION- Every poultry and livestock entering the market premises shall be subjected to an inspection by a trained Animal Health Officer (AHO) Veterinarian to be appointed by the Municipal Mayor for possible disease transmission. Only poultry and livestock declared by the Animal Health Officer (AHO) from any signs and symptoms and are fitted for sale should be admitted to enter the premises of the auction market center.

SECTION 12- WEIGHING - Every healthy poultry and livestock declared by the Animal Health Officer (AHO) Veterinarian shall be properly weighed, graded at the entrance gate of the premises of the auction market. The weighing personnel shall issue the

SECTION 13- BRANDING AND REGISTRATION FOR LIVESTOCK PARTICULARLY (CARABAO and CATTLE) INTENDED FOR FATTENING PURPOSES – Unregistered and unbranded carabao and cattle brought to the auction market shall first be loaded to an area designated for branding. The owner shall submit their animal for branding after which, a certificate of ownership shall be issued to the owner upon payment of the corresponding fees and service charge.

SECTION 14-SELLING - Trading of livestock between farmers and dealers shall be conducted in a selling area within the location of the poultry and livestock auction market designated for the purpose. Once an agreement is reached, a transfer certificate of ownership shall be issued to the dealer upon payment of the corresponding fees as prescribed under Article IV Section 21 of this Ordinance to formulize the sale.

SECTION 15 – **SERVICE CHARGES** – Service charges shall be imposed to farmers or dealers who would like to avail of market service and bring poultry and livestock for auction in the market which shall be properly assessed and collected prior to the loading out of livestock based on the rates prescribed under Article IV-Section 21 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 16 – **RELEASE FOR LIVESTOCK**- Livestock admitted within the market premises shall only be released to the farmers in case they are not sold, or to the dealer in case the sale is consummated after the presentation of all the necessary documents to the duly authorize personnel who shall supervise the release of livestock for loading.

SECTION 17 – MONITORING TEAMS – There shall be two monitoring teams of market personnel who shall be stationed in the livestock auction market arena to monitor, control and regulate the flow of poultry and livestock in and out of the auction market arena. The management of the poultry and livestock auction market shall assigned 2 monitoring teams to work for the said purpose mention above, in coordination with the Philippine National Police assigned in the Municipality of Villaba. The Philippine National Police shall be authorized to impound and or confiscate poultry and livestock for lacking documents in shipment as required by this Ordinance and other requirements needed in the applicable existing laws. The management shall assume responsibility and accountability over their operation.

SECTION 18- DISPOSITION OF CONFISCATED POULTRY AND LIVSTOCK — Confiscated poultry and livestock shall only be released upon presentation of the necessary documents showing the validity of the certificate of ownership registration coming from the Municipality and or other neighboring Municipality in the Province of Leyte.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTRATION, LICENSING AND FEES

SECTION 19- REGISTRATION - All farmers and other individuals except dealers and handlers engage in poultry and livestock trading, shall register at the auction market center for proper identification, for which they shall be issued and official identification card before admission to the market premises.

SECTION 20 - LICENSING - All dealers and handlers shall be required to secure a license from the Municipal Government through the office of the Municipal Treasurer after complying with the official requirements before they will be allowed to engage in trading activities within the market premises.

SECTION 21 - FEES - The following shall be collected from the farmers, dealers and handlers in the local poultry and livestock industry to cover the cost of services in the operation of the poultry and livestock auction market management with the following rates:

- 1. Entrance Fee: -----P 50.00 a. Poultry (all birds) ----- P 20.00/head b. Livestock Hog -----P 50.00/head Sheep -----P 50.00/ head Goat -----P 50.00/ " Carabao -----P 100.00/ " Cattle -----P 100.00/ "

SECTION 22 - Additional Provisions - hog raisers/owners who has only one (1) to four (4) disposable pigs for sale, no need for them to bring it to the auction market for reasons that if they will transport their pigs from their own piggery going to the market center it reduces the live weight of the animal but just the same they will pay the entrance fee as stipulated in Section 21 of this ordinance:

On the other hand, it was agreed that additional provisions will be incorporated in Section 21, that hog raisers, who wants to sell their marketable pig without bringing it to the livestock auction market center, shall the same pay the entrance fee to be paid direct to the office of the Municipal Treasurer in coordination with the Municipal Agriculture's Office in the Municipality of Villaba for proper guidance and information.

Other animals that are not mentioned in additional provisions, fees shall remain as stipulated in section 21 of this ordinance.

ARTICLE V- FUNDING

SECTION 23- FUNDING - The needed funds thereof including the construction of livestock auction market building and holding pens, Land Banking and facilities such as weighing scales, computers, etc. shall be included in the annual budget for 2024 and thereafter, and shall continue to fund to include Personal Services, Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) and Capital Outlay:

ARTICLE VI - PENALTY

SECTION 24 - PENALTY - Any farmer, dealer or handler or any other individual engaged in livestock trading who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be levied a fine of not more than P 500.00 for the first offense and P 1,000.00 for the second offense and P 2,000.00 for the third offense and cancellation of license in case of farmer or other individual for committing the same offense or as deemed appropriate by the management.

ARTICLE V11 - FINAL PROVISIONS

For the proper and effective implementation of this Ordinance. Executive Order shall be prepared and issued to all concerned personalities for appropriate action.

SECTION 25 - REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules order and regulations or parts thereof contrary or inconsistent with any of the provisions of this ordinance are hereby amended, modified and/ or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 26 - SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - Any provision of this ordinance or the application thereof to any person, barangay or circumstances is held invalid, The remainder of this ordinance and the application of such provisions to other person or circumstances shall not be affected thereby.

SECTION 27 - IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES - The Municipal Mayor shall make the necessary guidelines

SECTION 28 - EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately after its approval.
