

Section 16. General Welfare. - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAYS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MACARTHUR, PROVINCE OF LEYTE

In Section 16 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of the Philippines, states that "Within their respective territorial jurisdiction, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things the preservation and enrichment of culture.

On motion of Honorable Gwendolyn M. Beriso duly seconded by en masse, be it

Ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte that:

Section 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as "An Ordinance Declaring the Special Non-Working Holidays in the Municipality of Macarthur, Province of Leyte."

Through an Executive Order No. 324, dated June 17, 1950, issued by the late President Elpidio Quirino, the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte was created and founded.

In consideration that the commemoration is being participated in by all sector from the government and non-government organizations, it is but proper and just that the people of MacArthur, Leyte be given the opportunity to celebrate and participate in this momentous occasion.

Section 3. Every 15th day of May of the year in Celebration of the Town Fiesta in Honor of Patron Saint Isidore Labrador.

The local government has traditionally undertaken various activities every 15th day of May of every year to celebrate the town's annual fiesta, in honor of the Patron Saint Isidore Labrador, and a way of thanking the Lord for his bountiful blessings. This celebration also serves as a vehicle for the enrichment of faith and strengthening family ties/ solidarity.

Section 4. Every 8th day of November of the year as Yolanda Anniversary.

Typhoon Haiyan, a category five typhoon, struck the Philippines on 8th November, 2013 at 4.40 am. The tropical storm originated in the northwest Pacific Ocean. It is one of the most powerful typhoons to affect the Philippines. Wind speeds of 314 kilometers per hour (195 miles per hour) were recorded and to which the total of dead individuals increased to 6,300, 1,061 missing individual and 28,689 were injured. The recorded damage to property according to National Disaster Risk Reduction Management Council caused by Yolanda stands at P89,598,068,634.88.

This special non-working holiday was meant to:

- Pay homage to the resilience of the people who suffered and survived the catastrophic Super Typhoon Yolanda
- To mourn and honor the memories of those who perished during the wrath.
- To salute and recognize the efforts and selflessness of all responders, volunteers and Organizations who extend assistance during the recovery and rehabilitation efforts of all the affected communities.

Section 5. Automatic Work and suspension of classes in all levels for private and public schools within the jurisdiction of MacArthur, Leyte on every 17th day of June, 15th day of May and 8th day of November of every year. This is to give ample time and opportunity to all employees and workers in the government service and in private sector to fully

Section 6. EXCEMPTION. Those agencies whose functions involve the delivery of basic and health services, preparedness/ response to disasters and calamities, and/or the performance of other vital services shall continue their operations and render the necessary services.

Section 7. REPEALING CLAUSE. All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 8. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If for any reason, any provision, section or any part of this ordinance is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction or suspended or revoked by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining provisions, sections or parts hereof which shall remain and continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY- This ordinance shall take effect after the approval from the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and the requirements of posting prescribed in RA7160 is complied with.

ENACTED by the Sangguniang Bayan in session assembled on December 11, 2023 at MacArthur, Leyte, Philippines.
