


Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 21 series of 2023 of the Sangguniang Bayan of Macarthur, Leyte with the following recommendations/comments:

- 1. That the Ordinance is laudable as it gives recognition to its constituents who excelled in sports and academic competitions;
- 2. That the Ordinance seeks to give Cash Incentives with varying amounts, depending on the position/place of the constituent on the said competitions;
- 3. That said "Cash Incentives" shall be appropriated annually from the General Fund of the LGU which means that Government Funds will be involved.
- 4. That worthy note, is the provision of Section 335, Chapter 4 of the Code, quoted for reference:

"Section 335- No public money or property shall be appropriated or applied for religious or private purposes"

5. That in view thereof, the Provincial Legal office is of the recommends that a review be made on the subject of where the funds are to be sourced to make sure that the same does not run contrary to the mandate of Section 335 chapter 4 of the Code.



WHEREAS, The Philippine Government has adopted a policy of giving incentives to athletes who are winners or medalists in legitimate international and local sports competitions pursuant to R.A. 9064 or the National Athletes, Coaches and Trainers Benefits and Incentives Act of 2001.

WHEREAS, In the Municipality of MacArthur, the Sangguniang Bayan deems it essential to enact a policy in consonance with the national government's policy of giving incentives to people, especially our youth who have brought honor and prestige to our locality in terms of sports and academic excellence.

WHEREAS, giving incentives to the winners of sports and academic competitions gives credence to their achievements worthy of emulation by the younger generation. These winners, through their sacrifices, enthusiasm and motivation serve as inspiration and good role models

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Mel Andrew P. Maldos duly seconded by all the members present, be it

Ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte in session duly assembled, that:

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the ORDINANCE GRANTING CASH INCENTIVES TO INDIVIDUALS, PAIRED OR GROUPS WHO EXCELLED IN SPORTS AND ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF.

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared a policy of the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte to extend financial incentives to deserving youth for having given honor to the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte in various legitimate competitions in the fields of sports and academics competitions.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. As used in this ordinance, the following terms or phrases shall be construed to mean:

- a. Sports Competitions refer to various sports competitions that are accredited or sanctioned by the following government agencies:
- Department of Education
- Philippine Olympic Committee
- Philippine Sports Commission
- Department of the Interior and Local Government Commission on Higher Education

Sports competitions may be categorized as:

- 1) National sports competitions include, but not limited to the following:
- Palarong Pambansa
- Philippine National Youth Games (Batang Pinoy)
- National Open
- National Games
- Special Olympics
  - 2) For international and worldwide levels of sports competition

include regular sports competitions sanctioned by the International Olympic Committee and/or the International Sports Federations such as:

- Summer Olympics
- World Championship of respective sports
- Asian Games
- Asian Championship of respective sports
- Southeast Asia Games (SEA Games)
- ASEAN Championships of respective sports
- Special Olympics

Sports competitions would not include exhibition games.

b. Academic Competitions – refer to the academic related competitions in the division/provincial, regional, national, international or worldwide levels and are duly organized by national government agencies for competitions conducted within the country while participation in the International and Worldwide competitions must have been permitted and/or authorized by the concerned national government agency.

Section 4. Number of Grantees. The number of grantees under this program depends on how many have qualified with the requirements set forth in this ordinance.

Section 5. Qualification of Grantees. To qualify as a grantee, he/she must:

- be a bona-fide resident of Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte for at least one (1) year and/or residing in the municipality as a boarder in case of in-school-youth (ISY) for at least two (2) years and must have duly represented the Municipality of MacArthur, Leyte in the competitions she/he had participated;
- have informed the Municipal Incentive Committee through writing of his/her participation and that she/he is an official representative of the municipality, province, region, and/or the country in a particular competition before the actual competition for records purposes;
- be able to submit original and/or certified true copy of certification and appropriate documentations that he/she participated and won first (1st), second (2nd) or third (3nd) places or gold, silver or bronze medal accordingly in a duly accredited sports and academic competitions in the Division/Provincial, Regional, National, International and Worldwide levels;
- have been duly certified by the Municipal Incentive Committee that the grantee(s) have satisfactorily submitted and have passed the basic requirements set forth in this ordinance through an appropriate

- For coaches/trainers
- for Provincial/Division, Regional and National Level competitions must be Filipino citizens, must submit authentic certification from appropriate authority/agency and the grantee that he/she had been the official coach/trainer of the grantee for not less than 6 months;
- 2. for International and Worldwide level of competitions must be Filipino citizens, members of the national coaches and trainers pool, recognized and accredited by the Philippine Sports Commission and have represented the country as official coaches and trainers to national athletes in international competitions

Section 6. The Municipal Incentive Committee. A Municipal Incentive Committee is hereby created, which is primarily tasked to judiciously screen applicants based on the qualifications set forth in this ordinance and its implementing rules and regulations. The Municipal Incentive Committee is composed of the following:

- Commission on Higher Education (in case of college students)

The Municipal Planning and Development Office shall serve as the Secretariat of the Municipal Incentive Committee.

\*Section 7. Amount of Incentives.

- a) For individual sports, and academic competitions, qualified grantees shall be entitled to receive the following cash incentives:
- Provincial/Division Level
- 1st Place or Gold Medalist ₱ 1500.00
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place or Silver Medalist ₱1,000.00
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place or Bronze Medalist ₱ 500.00
- Regional Level
- 1st Place or Gold Medalist ₱ 5,000.00

- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place or Silver Medalist ₱1,000.00 / grantee
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place or Bronze Medalist ₱ 500.00 / grantee
- National Level
- 1st Place or Gold Medalist ₱12,000.00 / grantee
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place or Silver Medalist ₱ 8,000.00 / grantee
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place or Bronze Medalist ₱ 5,000.00 / grantee
- International/Worldwide Level
- 1st Place or Gold Medalist ₱ 100,000.00 / grantee

- c) Only the qualified grantee/s shall be entitled to receive the financial incentive. The grant shall be non-transferrable.
- d) Coaches/Trainers of qualified grantees shall receive:
- 1. Financial incentive equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the financial incentive received by the grantee for provincial, regional, and national level competitions;
- 2. Financial incentive equivalent to twenty percent (20%) of the financial incentive received by the grantee for international and world competitions.

Section 8. Funds for the Program. To carry out the provisions of this ordinance, the amount of five hundred thousand pesos (P 500,000.00) shall be appropriated annually from the General Fund of the Municipality as the fund for this program. Supplemental budget should be done in supplemental appropriation.

Section 9. Issuance of Rules and Regulations. The Municipal Incentive Committee shall formulate and issue the Implementing Rules and Regulations as maybe necessary to carry out the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 10. Separability Clause. The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared separable and if one or more provisions are held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder, or any provision hereof not affected, shall remain valid and effective.

Section 11. Repealing Clause. All ordinances, resolutions, rules and regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

Section 12. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as "The Local Government Code of 1991."
