"AN ORDINANCE WAIVING GOVERNMENT FEES AND CHARGES IN THE ISSUANCE OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED IN THE APPLICATION FOR **EMPLOYMENT OF FIRST TIME JOBSEEKERS"**

#### PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, under Republic Act 11261, otherwise known as "First Time Jobseekers Act" the state grants certain privileges as to fees and other charges to individuals who are seeking job for the first time; WHEREAS, in local setting, numbers of fresh graduates especially, despite potentials, are inept and denied of the opportunity, by reason of financial constraints in securing certificates or such other documents necessary for employment:

WHEREAS, to localize the noble intent of the law (R.A 11261), it is but JUST and proper.

WHEREFORE, on motion of Honorable Simoune M. Astorga, SP Chair on Trade Labor Commerce and Industry, and duly seconded by Honorable Ramon Ronald J. Veloso.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod, this city, in its 43rd Regular Session assembled on November 30, 2023 an ordinance as hereby is adopted, to wit:

Section 1. TITLE – This legislation shall be known as "Baybay City First Time Jobseekers Assistance Ordinance"

Section 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY It is the policy this Local Government to promote full employment and gainful work and opportunities to its constituents. As such, accessibility to government services is hereto expanded by providing incentives to first time job seekers.

## Section 3. DEFINATION OF TERMS;

- 1. Job an activity, trade or profession that somebody does regularly for pay
- 2. Seeker one time trying to achieve or obtain something
- 3. First time jobseeker- is a person who is any of the following:
  - a. Recently graduated from college or tertiary level seeking employment for the first time.
  - b. Previously graduated but recently decided to apply for an employment

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- c. Any other person who is applying for employment and who have not previously secured application documents mentioned in Section 4 for purposes of work.
- 4. Employment the condition of working for a pay
- 5. Government Office / Agency any instrumentality of the duly constituted authority rendering service
- 6. Fee(s) a charge made by institution for a service rendered

**Section 4. WAIVER OF FEES AND CHARGES** – Subject to exceptions under existing laws, all government agencies and instrumentalities, within the coverage of this Local Government, shall not collect fees or charges from First time jobseekers on the following:

1. Police Clearance

- 2. Barangay Clearance / Certifications locally generated
- 3. Birth Certificate
- 4. Marriage Certificate
- 5. Transcript of academic records issued by state colleges and universities.
- Medical Certificate from the City Health Office. However, the fees and charges
  collected for laboratory tests and other medical procedures required for the grant
  of a medical certificate shall not be free of charge;
- 7. Other documentary requirements issued by the government that may be required by employers from job applicants.

Provided that such fees and charges shall be waived only ONCE and for only One (1) Copy of each document. Subsequent requests and / or additional copy/ies shall incur charges of fees.

**Section 5. PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY** – To avail, barangay certification must be presented stating the fact of a first time jobseeker. The barangay where the first time jobseeker is a resident or originates has the primary responsibility of ascertaining the eligibility of the individual.

A Barangay Certification, signed by the Punong Barangay or his/her authorized officer, shall only be issued to an individual if he or she is a:

- a. Filipino
- b. First time jobseeker
- c. Actively looking for employment and, Resident of the barangay issuing the certification for at least six (6) months

This Certification shall be provided free of charge. The validity of benefits under this law is one (1) year from the issuance date of the Barangay Certification.

**Section 6. VIOLATIVE ACT** – Any availment other than expressly allowed, shall be punishable under this ordinance and the revised Penal code for illegal fabrication, falsification or unauthorized use of documents.

**Section 7.** RECORDS - The concerned offices are hereby tasked to maintain a yearly record for the individuals who has availed the privilege, Further, shall submit and furnish records of all beneficiaries to the Public Employment Service Office (PESO) every month.

**Section 8. EXCEPTIONS** - The waiver fees and charges under this ordinance, shall not include those collected by National Offices or Agencies in performance of their functions.

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Section 9. INTERPRETATION - In all cases, any ambiguity in the interpretation of this ordinance, shall be resolved liberally, in favor of the applicant.

Section 10. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If by any reason(s), any provision in this ordinance is declared unconstitutional and or illegal, the remaining portion of this ordinance shall not be affected, and therefore, remain in full force and effect;

Section 11. REPEALING CLAUSE - local ordinances, orders, rules and regulations, that are inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly;

Section 12. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon its approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan and after due compliance with all the requirements as provided for under R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.












BAYBAY CITY TRICYCLE TERMINAL AND SUPERMARKET
