Gentlemen and Ladies:

Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code of 1991 (Republic Act No. 7160), our preliminary review of the **General Fund Supplemental Budget No. 3 CY 2023** of the **Municipality of Palompon**, **Leyte** duly enacted by the Sangguniang Bayan through **Appropriation Ordinance No. 483-231023** with a total appropriation in the amount of **P12,791,036.51**, reveals substantial compliance with the same law and its implementing Rules and Regulations.

It is therefore recommended for approval subject to the following conditions:

- That the reversion of appropriations identified as the source of funds for this Supplemental Budget is backed up by cash collections and are made available to support the expenditures under Supplemental Budget No. 3. Further, that such reversion shall not render an adverse effect on the fiscal standing of the LGU at the closing of the books of accounts;
- 2. That the appropriation and grant for overtime pay under the Municipal Treasurer's Office in the amount of P50,000.00 shall be subject to the Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services and Overtime Pay for Government Employees specifically Section 6.1 of CSC-DBM JC No. 2 dated November 25, 2015 which states that "Only appointive and salaried civilian government employees holding regular, contractual, and casual positions of division chief or equivalent level and below, may be authorized to render overtime services with pay or compensation" & Section 7.0 of same circular provides that Government officials and employees who are not authorized to render overtime services with pay or compensation (Sec. 7.1) are those civilian personnel holding positions higher than division chief or equivalent levels;
- 3. That the procurement of Goods, Supplies, Equipment, Civil Works and related services shall be made in accordance with the provisions of RA 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and
- 4. That disbursement of funds shall be for the specific purpose(s) for which they have been appropriated pursuant to Sections 335 & 336 of RA 7160.

Compliance with DBM issuances, accounting and auditing rules and regulations and all other existing laws shall be the responsibility of the implementing Local Government Unit.

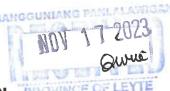

The Programs, Projects, and Activities (P/P/As) under this sector are: (1) Mayor's Office, (2) SB Office (3) Admin Office (4) MPDC Office (5) Budget Office (6) Treasurer's Office (7) Accountant's Office (8) LCR Office (9) Assessor's Office and (10) GS Office. This sector requires ₱ 5,791,500.00 or 18.41% of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Social Services

This sector is composed of the department of: (1) Health Office, (2) MSWD Office (3) Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office. The proposed Programs, Projects and Activities in this sector have a funding requirement of **P 515,000.00** or **1.64%** of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Economic Services

This sector is composed of the following departments: (1) Municipal Agriculture's Office (2) MEETO Office (3) Engineer's Office (4) WASH Office (5) Public Market (6) Slaughterhouse and (7) Tourism Destination Area (TDA).

The Program, Projects, and Activities identified under this sector amount to ₱ 25,143,536.51 or 79.95% of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Funding Requirement

The Supplemental Annual Investment Program (AIP) No. 3 for CY 2023 has a total funding requirement of **P 31,450,036.51**.

In terms of fund allocation of the Programs, Projects and Activities (PPA's) identified in the AIP under the regular operational budget items, these are broken down into following scheme Personal Services (PS) \$\mathbb{P}\$ 50,000.00 or 0.16%, Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) \$\mathbb{P}\$ 10,525,501.74 or 33.47%, and Capital Outlay (CO) \$\mathbb{P}\$ 20,874,534.77 or 66.37%.

Thereafter Mayor Ramon C. Oñate asked the Council for comments and suggestion about the presentation of the funding of the PPA's. Hearing none, the MDC Chairman requested the August body for a motion to approve the said agenda. Mr. Rolando S. Presentation of Agenda of the MDC Meeting

Engr. Isagani A. Jaena then discussed the Programs, Projects and Activities under the *Supplemental Annual Investment Program No. 3 for CY 2023 in behalf of the Chairman.* The supplemental AIP was necessary because there were savings on the Personal Services and from the Continuing Appropriation and it is necessary to revert the amount to supplement other priority projects that were not included in the approved annual investment program for CY 2023. Other projects/activities were change into other priority projects.

In terms of fund allocation of the Programs, Projects and Activities (PPA's) identified in the AIP under the regular operational budget items, these are broken down into following scheme Personal Services (PS) ₱ 50,000.00 or 0.16%, Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) ₱ 10,525,501.74 or 33.47%, and Capital Outlay (CO) ₱ 20,874,534.77 or 66.37%.

Contents of the Supplemental AIP No. 3 for CY 2023:

General Services

The Programs, Projects, and Activities (P/P/As) under this sector are: (1) Mayor's Office, (2) SB Office (3) Admin Office (4) MPDC Office (5) Budget Office (6) Treasurer's Office (7) Accountant's Office (8) LCR Office (9) Assessor's Office and (10) GS Office. This sector requires ₱ 5,791,500.00 or 18.41% of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Social Services

This sector is composed of the department of: (1) Health Office, (2) MSWD Office (3) Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office. The proposed Programs, Projects and Activities in this sector have a funding requirement of **P 515,000.00** or **1.64%** of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Economic Services

This sector is composed of the following departments: (1) Municipal Agriculture's Office (2) MEETO Office (3) Engineer's Office (4) WASH Office (5) Public Market (6) Slaughterhouse and (7) Tourism Destination Area (TDA). The Program, Projects, and Activities identified under this sector amount to \$\mathbb{P}\$ **25,143,536.51** or **79.95%** of the total funding requirement of the Supplemental AIP No. 3, CY 2023.

Funding Requirement

The Supplemental Annual Investment Program (AIP) No. 3 for CY 2023 has a total funding requirement of **P 31,450,036.51**
