Furthermore, the opinions rendered herein are without prejudice to opinions rendered by higher authorities.

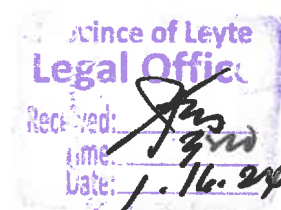

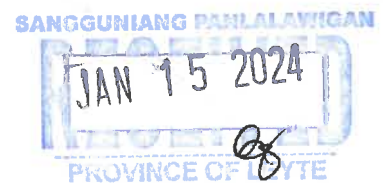

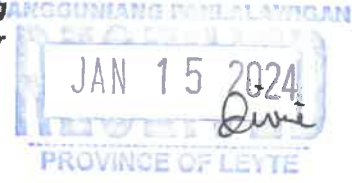

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESSES OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTING OF PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE ( PNP) UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS, AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY (COC), AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

*WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 or R. A. No. 7160, also known as the General Welfare Clause provides in part, that every local government unit shall ensure and support the maintenance of Peace and Order within their respective territorial jurisdiction;*

*WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 297, s. 2000 signed into law by Former Pres. Joseph E. Estrada on Oct. 4, 2000 is entitled " REGULATING THE MANUFACTURE, SALE, DISTRIBUTION AND USE OF PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS ";*

*WHEREAS, Section 1 of Executive Order No. 297, s. 2000 provides that xxx The unauthorized manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements is hereby prohibited. Any violation of this rule shall, after due notice and hearing, result in the immediate closure of the establishment, plant and/or office where the uniforms and other items are manufactured, stored, sold and/or distributed, the cancellation of its business license or permit, the condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of all paraphernalia used or intended to be used in the manufacture, sale and/or distribution and the imposition of reasonable administrative fines, without prejudice to the filing of administrative, civil and/or criminal actions. ;*

*WHEREAS, in Sept. 3, 2020, the Philippine National Police Directorate for Research and Development ( PNP- RDD) has issued DRD Standard Operating Procedure No. 2020- 001 prescribing the procedures and guidelines in handling of samples of PNP Uniforms and accoutrement to ensure the identity of the submitted samples as basis for issuance of Certificate of Conformity ( COC ). ;*

*WHEREAS, the unauthorized manufacture, sale, use and distribution of PNP Uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements impose serious concerns since such symbolic PNP identifiers, instead of providing a comforting sense of security, could be used by lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality;*

**NOW THEREFORE**

**BE IT ORDAINED, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Calubian, Leyte, in a session assembled , that :**

**SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.** This ordinance shall be entitled as "AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESSES OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF CALUBIAN, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING OR DISTRIBUTING OF PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE ( PNP) UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS, AND OTHER ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY (COC), AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF."

**SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION.** All businesses operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte, whether in physical, on line or in digital platforms, engaged in the manufacture, sale and distribution of the Philippine National Police (PNP) uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements. It includes enterprises dealing with raw materials for the production of aforementioned items.

**SECTION 3. RATIONALE . A.** It is the policy of the municipality of Calubian, Leyte to ensure that PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements are manufactured, sold, distributed or supplied only by authorized manufacturer, distributor, supplier and/or seller and used exclusively by uniformed personnel of the PNP; thus, there is a need for its regulation.

**B.** The PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements are symbolic of a discipline and an image which portray the character and being of every policeman, most representative of a professional Philippine National Police.

**SECTION 4. DEFINITION OF TERMS -** For purposes of implementation of this Ordinance, the following mean as follows:

a. **PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements-** are the authorized clothing, garments, distinguishing mark, emblem , merchandise, or decorations worn by bona fide members and officially acknowledged by the Philippine National Police;

b. **PNP Certificate of Conformity ( COC ) -** a certification issued by the PNP through the Directorate for Research & Development ( DRD) which signifies authority to manufactures, ell or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements;

c. **Distributor-** a person or company that buys products from a manufacturer and sells them for a profit to other businesses, stores, or customers, often by transporting the same;

d. **Manufacture -** act of producing or trading of fit to use, ready to wear, or ready to use PNP Uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements;

e. **Accoutrement -** means a piece of clothing or equipment that is used in a particular place or for a particular activity .

**SECTION 5. REQUIREMENT FOR PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY.** All businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias, and accoutrements must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity ( COC) from the Calubian PNP which shall be post permit compliance to all businesses before issuance of a Business Permit.

**SECTION 6. COORDINATION WITH THE CALUBIAN PNP.** For effective implementation of this ordinance, the Calubian PNP shall be integrated in the Online Unified Business Permit Application System ( OUBPAS) , through the Business Permit & Licensing Office ( BPLO) to ensure that all covered establishments engaged in the manufacturing, selling, or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements that are applying for a business permit , shall be evaluated by a dedicated PNP Personnel.

**SECTION 7. AUTHORITY TO INSPECT BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS.** The Business Permit & Licensing Office and Office of the Municipal Treasurer, Calubian, Leyte in coordination with the Calubian PNP, shall periodically conduct joint inspection of covered business establishments requiring the presentation of its respective Certificate of Conformity ( COC) from PNP.

**SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES.** The Business Permit & Licensing Office and Office of the Municipal Treasurer, Calubian, Leyte are the primary offices/ departments mandated to make the Implementing Rules and Regulations ( IRR) and to execute the provisions of this ordinance, in coordination with the personnel from the Calubian Municipal Police Station.

**SECTION 9. SUPPLEMENTAL CLAUSE.** The use of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements by any person or entity , who is not a member of the uniformed Philippine National Police (PNP) personnel is also prohibited.

**SECTION 10. PENALTY CLAUSE.** Any person or persons caught in violation of this ordinance, in whole or in part, shall be penalized as follows:

**First Violation** : Fine of Five hundred pesos ( P 500.00);

**Second Violation** : Fine of One thousand pesos ( P 1,000.00 );

**Third or More Subsequent Violations : Fine of Two thousand pesos ( P 2,000.00) and imprisonment of one (1) month or upon discretion of the court.**

**SECTION 11. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All ordinances or resolutions , local issuances or rules inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**SECTION 12. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE -** If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the remaining provision not affected thereby, shall continue to be in full force & effect.

**SECTION 13. EFFECTIVITY-** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval from the Honorable Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte.




