

¹ (ii) Maintain peace and order by enacting measures to prevent and suppress lawlessness, disorder, riot, violence, rebellion or sedition and impose penalties for the violation of said ordinances;

is SECTION 1. The unauthorized manufacture, sale and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accourtements is hereby prohibited. Any violation of this rule shall, after due notice and hearing, result in the immediate closure of the establishment, plant and/or office where the uniforms and other items are manufactured, stored, sold and/or distributed, the cancellation of its business license or permit, the condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of all paraphernalia used or intended to be used in the manufacture, sale and/or distribution and the imposition of reasonable administrative fines, without prejudice to the filing of administrative, civil and/or criminal actions.

AN ORDINANCE MANDATING ALL BUSINESSES OPERATING WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE ENGAGED IN THE MANUFACTURING, SELLING, OR DISTRIBUTING PNP UNIFORMS, INSIGNIAS. AND ACCOUTREMENTS TO SECURE PNP CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code or Republic Act No. 7160, also known as the General Welfare Clause provides in part that every local government unit shall ensure and support the maintenance of peace and order within their respective territorial jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 297 entitled Regulating the Manufacture, Sale, Distribution and Use of PNP Uniforms, Insignias and Other Accoutrements was signed on October 4, 2000 to control and manage the unauthorized manufacture, sale, and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements;

WHEREAS, E.O. No. 297 imposes as penalties the immediate closure of establishment; cancellation of business license or permit; condemnation, seizure and forfeiture of unauthorized items; and, imposition of reasonable fines for violators of the said order, all of which could be undertaken by the local government units concerned;

WHEREAS, in 03 September 2020, the Philippine National Police Directorate for Research and

|Development (PNP-DRD) has issued DRD |Standard Operating Procedure No. 2020-001 prescribing the procedures and guidelines in handling of samples of PNP uniforms and accoutrements to ensure the integrity of the submitted samples as basis for issuance of Certificate of Conformity (COC):

WHEREAS, the unauthorized manufacture, sale, use, and distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrement impose serious concerns since such symbolic PNP identifiers, instead of providing a comforting sense of security, could be used by lawless elements in the commission of crimes within the municipality;

WHEREAS, to protect the integrity and sanctity of the symbolism of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accourrements, this August Body believes that there is a dire need to enact a corresponding municipal ordinance to mitigate, or even eradicate, the proliferation of the unauthorized PNP uniforms and commission of illegal activities within Matag-ob, Leyte;

Now, Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte In Regular Session Assembled, THAT:

SECTION 1. TITLE OF ORDINANCE-Ordinance shall be known as: The PNP Certificate of Conformity Ordinance.

SECTION 2. SCOPE AND APPLICATION- All businesses operating within the territorial jurisdiction of Matag-ob, Leyte, whether in physical, online or in digital platforms, engaged in the manufacture, sale, and distribution of Philippine National Police uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements. It includes enterprises dealing with raw materials for the production of aforementioned items.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of implementation of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall be binding and controlling:

a) PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements these are authorized clothing, garment, distinguishing mark, emblem, merchandise, of decorations worn by bona fide members and officially acknowledged by the Philippine National Police.

b) PNP Certificate of Conformity (COC) - a certification issued by the PNP through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) which signifies authority to manufacture, sell, or distribute PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements.

- c) Distributor-an authorized agent of a supplier or manufacturer to supply or deliver PNP uniforms, insignias and accoutrements wherein the latter has a valid PNP Certificate of Conformity.
- d) Manufacture- act of producing or trading of fit-touse, ready-to-wear, or ready-to-use PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements.

SECTION REQUIREMENT FOR CERTIFICATE OF CONFORMITY - All businesses engaged and dealing with PNP uniforms, insignias, and accoutrements must secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity which shall be post-permit compliance to all businesses after issuance of a business permit.

SECTION 5. COORDINATION WITH THE PNP -For effective implementation of this Ordinance, the PNP shall be integrated into the Online Unified Business Permit Application System (OUBPAS), in coordination with the BPLO, to ensure that all covered establishments engaged in the manufacturing, selling, or distribution of PNP uniforms, insignias, and other accoutrements that are applying for a business permit shall be evaluated by a dedicated PNP personnel.

The PNP shall also submit to the BPLO a Negative List of registered covered establishments who failed to secure the PNP Certificate of Conformity.

SECTION 6. **AUTHORITY** TO INSPECT ESTABLISHMENTS - The BPLO, in coordination with the PNP, shall periodically conduct joint inspection of covered business establishments requiring the presentation of its respective PNP Certificates of Conformity.

SECTION 7. IMPLEMENTING OFFICES - The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) is the primary office mandated to make the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and to execute the provisions of this Ordinance, and in coordination with the Philippine National Police, Matag-ob, Police Station.

SECTION 8. PENALTIES - Failure to secure a PNP Certificate of Conformity or present the same during inspection shall warrant the issuance of appropriate Notice of Violation. Upon findings that the establishment continuously violates pertinent provision of this Ordinance, the BPLO may either order the suspension of the business operation, revocation of the business permit, or closure of the business establishment, depending of the nature of the violation committed.

case of violations found during the aforementioned inspections for failure to present competent proof of authority to deal with PNP uniforms, insignias and other accoutrements, the items found therein shall be seized or confiscated subject to proper disposal, without prejudice to the revocation of business

Any violator of the aforementioned provisions shall be imposed of a penalty of according to the following schedule:

> First Offense: A fine of Ph500.00 Second Offense: A fine of Ph1,000.00

Third Offense: A fine of Ph2,000.00 and or imprisonment of Five (5) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any section of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, other sections which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that the rights that are vested upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.

SECTION 11. AMENDMENTS CLAUSE - This ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This shall take effect ten (10) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.





This practice should be discouraged so that (1) the barangays will earn, and (2) avoid any barangay from getting tangled in case the livestock that were transported are not healthy or carrying any disease specially ASF. So the barangays should design a strategy where there is an available form to be filled up and issued even the Punong Barangay is not around to sign the said document.




