This refers to the proposed provincial ordinance entitled "A REVISED ORDINANCE LEVYING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES & EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF LEYTE SERIES OF 2024.

During the joint committee meeting, clarifications and suggestions were made which are now provided for in the attached draft ordinance¹. Aside from such and upon careful review and perusal, the joint committee finds that the measure is timely and urgently needed to be passed to raise funds for the maintenance and improvement of the properties of the provincial government as mentioned in the proposed ordinance.

The joint committee also find no provision in the said proposed measure which contravenes the Constitution and other existing laws and that the same is compliant to the general limitations of legislation, that:

- a. It does not contravene the Constitution;
- b. It is not unfair or oppressive;
- C. It is not partial or discriminatory;
- d. It does not prohibit trade;
- e. It is general and consistent with public policy; and,
 - f. It is not unreasonable.

In view thereof, the joint committee hereby recommends for the passage of the said ordinance and resolve that the same be scheduled for second reading, subject to the provisions of Section 186² in relation to sections 187³ and 188⁴ of the Local Government Code.

²SECTION 186. Power To Levy Other Taxes, Fees or Charges. - Local government units may exercise the power to levy taxes, fees or charges on any base or subject not otherwise specifically enumerated herein or taxed under the provisions of the National Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or other applicable laws: Provided, That the taxes, fees, or charges shall not be unjust, excessive, oppressive, confiscatory or contrary to declared national policy: Provided, further, That the ordinance levying such taxes, fees or charges shall not be enacted without any prior public hearing conducted for the purpose.

³SECTION 187. Procedure for Approval and Effectivity of Tax ordinances and Revenue Measures; Mandatory Public Hearings. - The procedure for approval of local tax ordinances and revenue measures shall be in accordance with the provisions of this Code: Provided, That public hearings shall be conducted for the purpose prior to the enactment thereof: Provided, further, That any question on the constitutionality or legality of tax ordinances or revenue measures may be raised on appeal within thirty (30) days from the effectivity thereof to the Secretary of Justice who shall render a decision within sixty (60) days from the date of receipt of the appeal: Provided, however, That such appeal shall not have the effect of suspending the effectivity of the ordinance and the accrual and payment of the tax, fee, or charge levied therein: Provided, finally, That within thirty (30) days after receipt of the decision or the lapse of the sixty-

REPOSAR: 1ST DISTRICT BOARD MEMBER 530 Thank you very much, Honorable Presiding Chair and Honorable Floor Leader. 531 This is an appeal coming from Mayor Lovely Castro from the Municipality of 532 533 Alangalang, referring to our resolution which says that before they can implement the supplemental budget and the corresponding ordinances in relation thereto, they should 534 comply with the conditions set forth by the local council of the province. I think the 535 536 appeal is valid particularly pursuant to the provisions of the Local Government Code pursuant under Section 5 (a) (c) of the said Code which provides that, all powers or any 537 provision and a power of the local government unit shall be liberally interpreted in its 538 539 favor and in case of doubt any question thereon shall be resolved in favor of the devolution of powers. The issue here is, the Municipality of Alangalang is prevented to 540 implement the position of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office 541 because under the Local Government Code it is an optional position. However, I see 542 that Section 5 of the Civil Service Memorandum Circular No. 12 which stated, or which 543 544 is the basis of the Local Finance Committee that says," before an optional position shall 545 be created, all mandatory provisions which are provided under such circular shall have

been created first." I am saying that it is consistent, because there are 2 minimum requirements under the said circular which says, that there should be priority need, that the creation of the position is based on the priority needs of the Local Government Unit and also based on the financial capability of the said LGU. There are listings of mandatory positions under the same CSC Memorandum No. 12, which are not actually priority positions, given the current condition of the municipality of Alangalang. Hence, the Local Chief Executive of Alangalang is requesting that since they have at least complied the 2 minimum requirements which is the finding that this position priority to deliver basic services under which the Local Government Code provides. And it is certified that they have the financial capability to make that position or the Office of the MENRO be operationalized, the same Local Chief Executive Mayor Yu-Castro is requesting the Sangguniang Panlalawigan to reconsider our resolution striking off the provisions which states that, before we are approving their supplemental budget with the condition that they comply with the conditions set forth by the Local Finance Committee. I would like to state that I agree with the appeal of the Local Chief Executive particularly that the Office of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office and the other positions which are actually health positions are actually needed by the Local Government Unit of Alangalang. It is actually sad that the Local Government Unit cannot implement or at least create these positions which they see or priority needs of the Local Government Unit to deliver basic services which are in this case environmental, disaster and health. So, with that note, Mr. Chair, I would like to move that we grant the appeal of the Local Chief Executive of Alangalang by lifting the conditions and comments set by the Provincial Local Finance Committee based on first, the provisions of the constitution which is the local autonomy of the Local Government Units. And the provisions of the Local Government Code, "Section 5 under the rules of interpretation and I state under Section C, the general welfare provision of this Code shall liberally interpreted to give more powers to the Local Government Units in accelerating economic development and upgrading the quality of life for the people of the community." I do believe that the creation of the positions as stated in the
