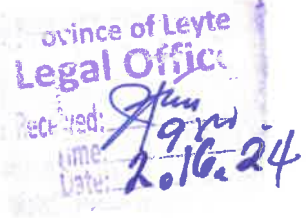

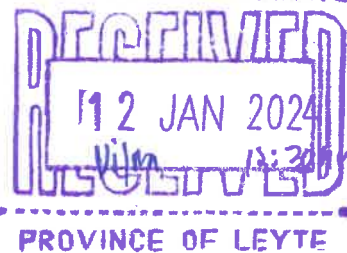

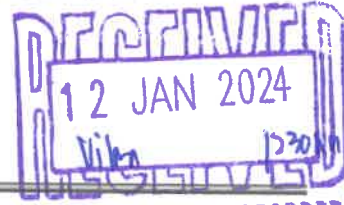

PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, Ylang- ylang tree is scientifically known as *Cananga odorata* is a small and beautiful flower. It is a fast- growing tree that exceeds Five (5) meters per year and attains an average height of 12 meters. It grows in full or partial sun, and prefers the acidic soil of its native rainforest habitats. The leaves are long, smooth and glossy. The flower is greenish yellow and curly like a starfish and yields a highly fragrant essential oil. The tree is native to Philippines and Indonesia and is commonly grown in Polynesia, Melonesia and Micronesia;

WHEREAS, having an Ylang- ylang Tree Planting Ordinance will allow and require the municipality of Kananga, Leyte to conduct annually the tree planting activity especially the plantation of the Ylang-ylang Trees as it is representing the town symbol and its significant origin;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of SB Member Jeffsbor G. Cuizon, seconded by All SB Members be it,
RESOLVED, to enact:

"AN ORDINANCE MANDATING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT OF KANANGA, LEYTE, TO CONDUCT YLANG- YLANG (*Cananga odorata*) TREE PLANTING ACTIVITY, AS PART OF THE ANNUAL FOUNDATION CELEBRATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY, AND

APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREOF

Be it ordained by the 23RD Sangguniang Bayan session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. TITLE - This ordinance shall be known as "Ylang- ylang Tree Planting Ordinance of the Municipality of Kananga, Leyte".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY- It is hereby declared the policy of the municipality to adopt and impose necessary policies for the planting, growing, cultivation and propagation of the Ylang- ylang tree as it is representing the town symbol and its significant origin.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS - For purposes of this ordinance, the following terms are hereby defined:

- a. Ylang- ylang Tree Planting – it refers to the tree planting activity and other relevant form of activity that is part of the Municipal Annual Foundation Day Celebration.
- b. Ylang- ylang Tree Planting Committee- refers to the committee task to implement this ordinance.
- c. Ylang- ylang Tree- scientifically known as *Cananga odorata*, a tropical tree that is native to and originated in the Philippines and Indonesia.

SECTION 4. CREATION OF YLANG- YLANG TREE PLANTING COMMITTEE – there is hereby created a Committee which shall be in- charge of the activity that composed of the following:

Chairman: Municipal Mayor

Vice Chairman: Municipal Vice Mayor

Members:

SB Chairperson on Committee on Environmental Protection

- Municipal Agriculturist Officer (MAO)
- Department of Agrarian Reform
- Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer (MENRO)
- Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Officer (MDRRMO)
- Municipal Local Government Operation Officer (MLGOO)
- Liga ng mga Barangay President (LNB)
- SK Federation President;
- Municipal Budget Officer (MBO)
- Municipal Tourism Officer (MTO)
- Municipal Assessor (MA)
- Municipal Engineer (ME)
- Local Youth Development Officer (LYDO)
- District Supervisors, Department of Education
- School Principals (public and private)
- Philippine National Police (PNP)
- Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)
- Armed Forces of the Philippines
- Barangay Councilor's League President Committee on Environment
- Two (2) Representatives from the NGO (environment related);
- Such other members as the Local Chief Executive may deem it necessary.

SECTION 5. FUNCTIONS OF THE YLANG- YLANG TREE PLANTING COMMITTEE. The following are the functions of the Committee:

- Formulate plans and programs necessary to achieve the intent of this ordinance;
- Assist and support to the cultivation and propagation of Ylang- ylang trees.
- Specify and or identify the areas to be planted of the trees.
- Monitor and record the activities and projects undertaken under this ordinance;

- Establish a strong monitoring and maintenance team who will look the planted trees.
- Establish linkages to National, Regional or Provincial environmental agency for support and coordination purposes.
 - Such other functions as the Local Chief Executive may deem necessary.

SECTION 6. ANNUAL SCHEDULE OF YLANG- YLANG TREE PLANTING - The Ylang- ylang tree planting schedule will fall under the week of the municipal foundation day celebration.

SECTION 7. INFORMATION AND MONITORING- For information and monitoring purposes, the Public Information Office (PIO) is tasked to disseminate the related information to all concerned agencies, department, barangay councils and institutions as to the place, time and date for the conduct of Ylang- ylang tree planting day. Likewise, the Office of the Municipal Agriculturist in partnership of the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Officer shall submit to the Ylang- ylang Tree Planting Committee the accomplishment report of the said activity.

SECTION 8. SUPPLY AND DISTRIBUTION OF SEEDLINGS- The Municipal Agriculture Office (MAO) and in partnership with the Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office shall be responsible in the supply and distribution of the seedlings for the Ylang- ylang tree planting activity of the Municipality.

SECTION 9. PLANTING OF TREES- All local government officials and employees, barangay officials and personnel of other government agencies and or non-government organizations shall be required to plant at least one (1) Ylang- ylang tree every year.

SECTION 10. AREAS COVERED BY TREE PLANTING- The Ylang- ylang Tree Planting Committee shall specify and identify the area within the Municipality to be planted.

The Ylang- ylang planting activities shall be done in any of the following areas:

- Public school grounds, gardens or other available areas within the school premises;
- Idle or vacant public lands;
- Public parks in rural areas;
- Private schools, parks and lands with the consent of the owner thereof.

SECTION 11. MAINTENANCE OF TREES- The assigned LGU employees, barangay officials/workers and deputized non-governmental organizations shall be responsible for the maintenance of such planted trees for the weeding, installation of tree guard as seedling protection and the application of appropriate fertilizer that would enhance the growth and survival of the trees.

SECTION 12. DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF BARANGAY OFFICIALS – All Twenty- Three (23) barangay councils in the entire municipality shall lead in the execution of Ylang- ylang tree planting activity in their respective barangay and shall provide the area as planting site, likewise appropriate a budget to be used in the said activity. The barangay councils also are tasked to create a Barangay Committee chair by the Committee on Environment/Agriculture.

SECTION 13. APPROPRIATIONS - The LGU- Kananga shall appropriate regularly in the annual budget an initial amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php.50,000.00) and likewise the barangay shall appropriate an amount amounting to Five Thousand Pesos (Php. 5,000) for the successful implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE - Pertinent provisions of all other laws, ordinances, executive orders and rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon its approval and after due compliance with all the requirements provided under R.A. 7160. Otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.




