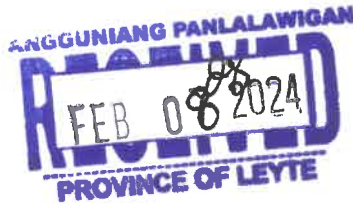

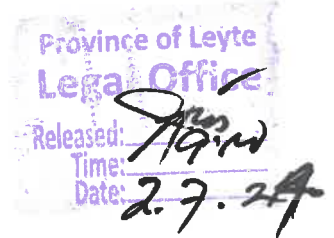

ⁱⁱ **Section 16. General Welfare.** - Every local government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants.

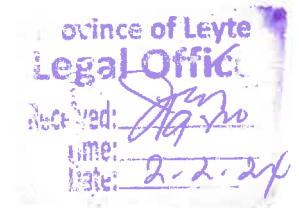

ORDINANCE NO. 174
Series 2023
(Proposed Mun. Ord. No. 193)

AN ORDINANCE STRICTLY REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE TO MAINTAIN CLEANLINESS AND ORDERLINESS OF THEIR IMMEDIATE SURROUNDING AND FRONTAGE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF OR OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "TAPAT KO, LINIS KO PROGRAM".

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Matag-ob advocacy in "Clean and Green Campaign" must be fully implemented and enforced;

WHEREAS, the efforts of the LGU alone is not sufficient enough in providing and maintaining cleanliness and orderliness in the municipality;

WHEREAS, in support in Municipal Ordinance No. 153 of 2023 entitled "The Comprehensive Ecological Solid Waste Management Program of the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte declaring certain acts prohibited and providing penalties, thereof and for other purposes";

WHEREAS, the collaboration of the dwellers and residents of the municipality is needed to discourage and prevent the proliferation of continued practice of indiscriminate display of visual clutters in the frontage of their residence and commercial establishments, as well as





in any open or public places that affect the cleanliness of the surroundings;

WHEREAS, the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte shall not only encourage and attract local and foreign businesses and investors but will also provide health, social, moral welfare and environmental benefits of its inhabitants;

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte in regular session assembled:

ARTICLE I General Provision

Section 1. Title- This ordinance shall be known as the "AN ORDINANCE STRICTLY REQUIRING ALL RESIDENTS AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE TO MAINTAIN CLEANLINESS AND ORDERLINESS OF THEIR IMMEDIATE SURROUNDING AND FRONTAGE AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF OR OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "TAPAT KO, LINIS KO PROGRAM".

Section 2. Declaration of Policies - It is the policy of the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them, and protect and promote their right to a better sanitary condition, public safety and against the harmful effects of pollution caused by illegal and unsanitary disposal of garbage.

Section 3. Purpose and Scope - It is the main purpose of this Ordinance to maintain cleanliness and orderliness and to have safe environment. This shall apply to all persons, institutions and all the barangays within the jurisdiction of the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte.

Section 4. Definition of Terms - As used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall be understood, construed, and shall mean as follows:

Business Signage- any publicly displayed information that's presented in the form of words, symbols and/or pictures and is designed to advertise the business.

(a) **Garbage** - trash, rubbish, or refuse is waste material that is discarded by humans, usually due to a perceived lack of utility.








Immediate Surroundings- refers to the frontage or vicinity including up to the mid-span of the road, street alley or avenue (excluding highways) from the edge of the street, sidewalks of residential houses, hotel, resorts business/ commercial establishments or offices whether public or private.

(b) Sari- Sari Store - is a convenience store occupying an important economic and social location in a community and are common in neighbourhoods and along the streets, tend to be family-run and privately owned operating within the shopkeeper's residence.

(c) Tapat Ko Linis Ko - a Filipino term which means clean-up of their own premises which refers to the regular maintenance and cleaning of sidewalks fronting and surrounding premises of their homes, establishment or institution by removal of accumulated wastes and debris.

(d) Trash Bin - is a container for temporarily storing waste, and is usually made out of metal or plastic.

(e) Waste- garbage, refuse and other rubbish which is not disposed of properly, tends to create a danger to public safety, diminished cleanliness and sanitation.

Section 5. Prohibited Acts- The following acts shall be prohibited in the immediate surroundings of residential and commercial establishments:

(1) Leaving/ Littering trash and other refuse in the gutter, sidewalks, streets, alleyway and roads and allowing or leaving pet animals to defecate or urinate outside their property line;

(2) Storing, dumping or placing wastes, debris, junked or under repair vehicles, dilapidated appliances and other objects (business signage- movable) in any part of the road, street or avenue or in any sidewalk which may impede or obstruct the vehicular and pedestrian traffic;

(3) Construction of house or business of pens or cages of animal or animal on leash;

(4) Construction of house or business extension, including installation of roofs and canopies, awnings and the like;

(5) Installation of permanent fences or gates;

(6) Use of sidewalks for plants, trees and planters ;

(7) Construction of business signage (permanent) without the approval of the municipality; and

(8) Commercial establishments allowing sari-sari store in their immediate surroundings.

Section 6. Temporary use when allowed- The use of any roads, streets, avenues, alleys, sidewalks, bridges, parks or other places on a temporary basis and for public purposes or use for a definite period only shall require a special permit from the municipality.

Section 7. Persons Liable- The following persons (natural and juridical) are deemed liable under this Ordinance:

(a) For Residential Houses – The owner/lessee/administrator of the residential house.

(b) For Commercial Establishments (Sole Proprietorship) - The Owner/Tenant/Proprietor.

(c) For Commercial Establishments (Partnership or Corporation) – The partners, general manager, the president, or the most senior officer.

(d) For the vacant lots - The owner/tenant/administrator of the lots.

Section 8. Penalties- Any person, corporation, trust, firm or entity found violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished in the following manner.

(a) Individuals (owners/tenant of residence, vacant lot and business with sole proprietorship):

1st Offense - An administrative Fine of Five Hundred (P500.00) Pesos.

2nd Offense – An administrative Fine of One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos.

3rd Offense - An Administrative Fine of One Thousand Five Hundred (P1,500.00) Pesos, or imprisonment of 5 days or both such fine and imprisonment upon the discretion of the court.

(b) Establishments (Partnership and Corporations)

1st Offense- An administrative Fine of One Thousand (P1,000.00) Pesos.

2nd Offense – An administrative Fine of Two Thousand (P2,000.00) Pesos.

3rd Offense- An Administrative Fine of Two Thousand, Five Hundred (P2,500.00) Pesos and revocation of business permit in the part of business establishments or imprisonment of 5 days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 9. Separability Clause- If for any reason, any provision, section or part of this ordinance is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction or suspended or revoked, such judgment shall not affect or impair the remaining, sections or parts thereof, which shall remain or continue to be in full force and effect.

Section 10. Repealing Clause - All ordinances, rules and regulations or parts thereof in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, provided that the rights that are vested upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall not be impaired.

Section 11. Amendments Clause - This ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

Section 12. Effectivity Clause - This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its approval.



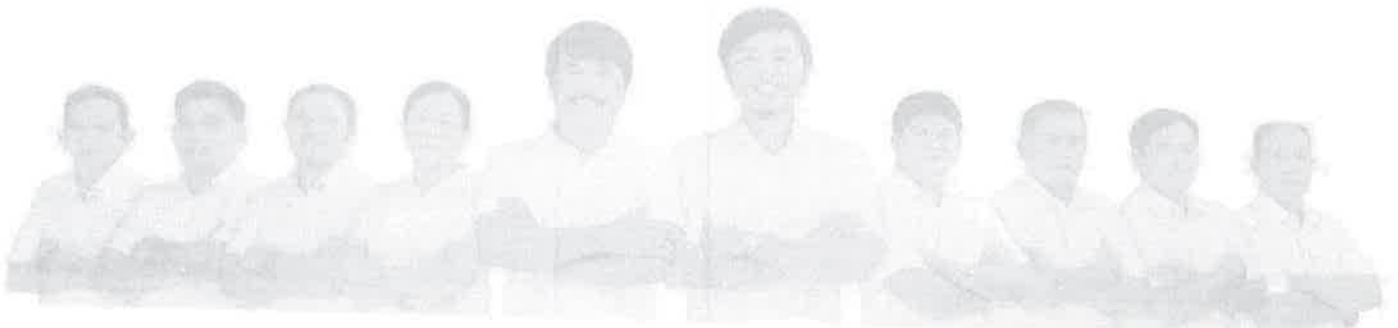



He pointed out that the barangays should not tolerate that the client would secure permit from other barangays and not from the origin barangay where the livestock has come from. This practice should be discouraged so that (1) the barangays will earn, and (2) avoid any barangay from getting tangled in case the livestock that were transported are not healthy or carrying any disease specially ASF. So the barangays should design a strategy where there is an available form to be filled up and issued even the Punong Barangay is not around to sign the said document.



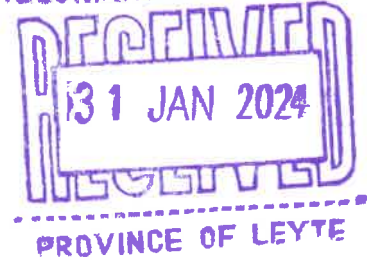
