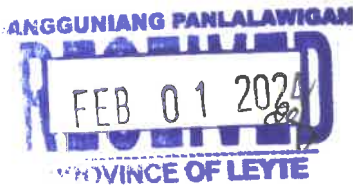


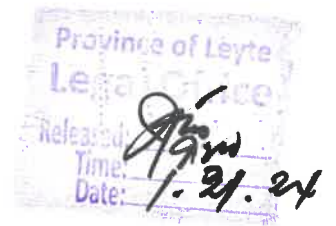

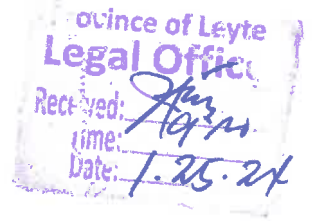
ⁱ (a) The sangguniang bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of this Code and in the proper exercise of the corporate powers of the municipality as provided for under Section 22 of this Code

ⁱⁱ Philippine Pharmacy Act. SEC. 30. *Dispensing/ Sale of Pharmaceutical Products.* – No pharmaceutical product, of whatever nature and kind, shall be compounded, dispensed, sold or resold, or otherwise be made available to the consuming public, except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the FDA.

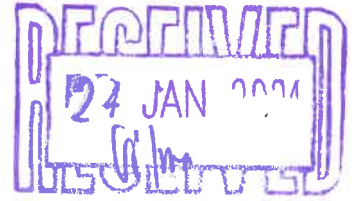

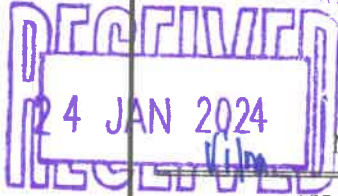

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND RESALE OF
OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICINES AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL
PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER MINI CONVENIENCE
STORES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABONTABON, LEYTE.**

WHEREAS, Article II, Section 15 of the 1987 Constitution mandates the state to protect and promote the right to health of the people and instil health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, Section 30 of RA No. 10918, otherwise known as Philippine Pharmacy Act prohibits the compounding, dispensing, selling, or reselling of pharmaceutical products through retail drug outlets not licensed by the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA);

WHEREAS, RA No. 8203, otherwise known as the *Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs*, prohibits any person from manufacturing, selling, offering for sale, donating, distributing, trafficking, brokering, exporting, importing or possessing counterfeit drugs;

WHEREAS, the proliferation of counterfeit pharmaceutical products and the sale of medicines by sari-sari stores, without authorization from the FDA, are a potential cause of serious harm to the health of the general public;

WHEREAS, after a Public Hearing and thorough study and discussion on the subject ordinance by the August Body, the herein ordinance is hereby enacted;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion by Hon. Danilo E. Balais and unanimously seconded;

BE IT RESOLVE, as it is hereby resolved to enact/approve Municipal Ordinance No. 16 Series of 2023 entitled "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND RESALE OF OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICINES AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER MINI CONVENIENCE STORES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABONTABON, LEYTE";

BE IT ORDAINED by the Honorable Sangguniang Bayan, in its Regular Session assembled, that:

**MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 16
Series of 2023**

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND RESALE OF OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICINES AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER MINI CONVENIENCE STORES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABONTABON, LEYTE.

SECTION 1. TITLE OF THE CODE. This ordinance shall be known as "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE SALE AND RESALE OF OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICINES AND OTHER PHARMACEUTICAL PRODUCTS IN SARI-SARI STORES AND OTHER MINI CONVENIENCE STORES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF TABONTABON, LEYTE";

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. When used in this Ordinance, the following terms shall have respective meanings herein set forth:

- a. **Counterfeit pharmaceutical products** – refer to pharmaceutical products which do not contain the amount as claimed; with wrong ingredients; or with insufficient quantity of active ingredients, which result in the reduction of the product’s safety, efficacy, quality, strength, or purity. These also refers to products that are deliberately and fraudulently mislabelled with respect to identity and/or source or with fake packaging and can apply to both branded and generic products.
- b. **Household remedies** – refer to any preparation containing pharmaceutical substances of common or ordinary use to relieve common physical ailments, and which may be dispensed without prescription in original packages, bottles or containers, of which the nomenclature has been duly approved by the FDA.
- c. **Over-the counter (OTC) medicines** - refer to medicines used for symptomatic relief of minor ailments, and which may be dispensed without prescription.
- d. **Pharmacist** – refers to a health professional who has been registered and issued a valid Certificate of Registration (COR) and Professional Identification Card (PIC) by the PRC and the Professional Regulatory Board of Pharmacy.
- e. **Pharmacist-only OTC medicines** – refer to over-the-counter medicines classified by appropriate government agencies to be obtained only from a licensed pharmacist, with mandatory pharmacist’s advice on their selection and proper use.
- f. **Prescription medicines** – refer to medicines which can only be dispensed by a pharmacist to a patient, upon the presentation of a valid prescription from a physician, dentist, or veterinarian and for which a pharmacist’s advice is necessary.
- g. **Sari-sari stores** – refer to retailing stores selling a general line of merchandise classified as micro-enterprise.
- h. **Convenience stores, cooperative-run stores, and other small and medium enterprises** – refers to a small retail business including those establishments or parts of a gas/petrol stations that stocks a range of everyday items.

SECTION 3. REGULATORY CLAUSE. Compounding and dispensing of pharmaceutical products shall only be done by duly registered and licensed pharmacist. No pharmaceutical products of whatever nature and kind, shall be compounded, dispensed, sold or resold, otherwise be made available to the consuming public, except through a retail drug outlet duly licensed by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).


Exceptions may be made in emergency cases, which refer to life-threatening situations where a patient needs immediate medical attention and treatment and the services of pharmacist are not available.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITED ACTS.

- a. Sari-sari Stores and other similar retail outlets and micro-enterprises are absolutely prohibited from selling or reselling over the counter medicines and other pharmaceutical products as defined and classified by the Food and Drug Administration.

- b. Convenience stores, cooperative-run stores, and other small and medium enterprises which intend to sell household remedies and over the counter drugs (which are not pharmacist-only medicines) are prohibited from dispensing, selling, or reselling prescription and pharmacist-only over the counter medicines, as defined and classified by the Food and Drug Administration.
- c. The distribution of COVID-19 drugs shall be governed by policies set forth by the FDA and the Department of Health only unless otherwise provided.
- d. The possession, dispensing, selling, or reselling of counterfeit pharmaceutical products are prohibited and shall governed by the provisions of RA 8203 otherwise known as the *Special Law on Counterfeit Drugs*.

SECTION 5. FDA RETAIL OUTLET AND AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENT.

- a. Owners of establishments mentioned in Section 4 (b) are first required to apply as a retail outlet for non-prescription drugs (RONPD) pursuant to Food and Drugs Administration Circular No. 2014-028, and secure the following:
 - 1. A license to operate from FDA.
 - 2. The employment of the supervision and oversight of a duly registered and licensed pharmacist, pursuant to Section 31 (b) of RA 10918; and
 - 3. Other requirements imposed by the FDA on its license to operate to applicants.

SECTION 6. RESPONSIBILITY OF THE LGU. The LGU shall have the following responsibilities pertinent to this ordinance:


- a. The LGU shall ensure the integration of guidelines in the existing business permits and licensing systems and requirement;
- b. The Municipal Health Office and Barangay Health Stations in coordination with the LGU & BLGU shall ensure the operation of their respective pharmacies wherein non-prescription generic drugs and selected prescription drugs are made available.
- c. The LGU shall also establish an enabling mechanism designed to assist owners of sari-sari stores and other retail stores in securing proper authorization from FDA to dispense, sell, and resell pharmaceutical products.

SECTION 7. PENAL CLAUSE. Violations of any of the above sections as well as any provision/s hereof shall be punished as follows;

First Offense	Fine of ₱1,000.00 and confiscation of all pharmaceutical products being sold.
Second Offense	Fine of ₱1,500.00 and confiscation of all pharmaceutical products being sold.
Third Offense and Succeeding Offenses	Fine of ₱ 2,500.00 and confiscation of all pharmaceutical products being sold, revocation of business permit and license to operate or imprisonment for a period not exceeding six (6) months, or both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

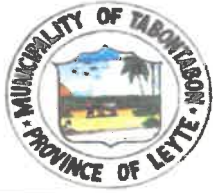

SECTION 8. FORMULATION OF IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. Within one (1) month after the approval of this Ordinance, the Municipal Mayor through the Local Health Board shall convene a meeting to formulate and issue the appropriate implementing rules and regulations necessary for the efficient and effective implementation of all provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. If any provision of this Ordinance is determined to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable, its remaining provisions shall remain in full force as though this ordinance did not originally include such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE. All previous ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance shall be deemed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE. This Ordinance shall take effect in accordance with the law.
