**AMENDING SECTION 3 ARTICLE II, SECTION 4 ARTICLE III, PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 05-03 ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE LEVYING FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE USE OF FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT OWNED BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF LEYTE”.**

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to update the definition of terms and existing fees and charges for the use of facilities and equipment owned by the Province of Leyte;

**WHEREAS**, to recover the cost of maintenance and the depreciation for the use thereof;

**WHEREAS**, there is also a need to update the labels and numberings in the said ordinance to indicate specific facilities, equipment and additional provisions;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion duly seconded, be it.

**RESOLVE**, as it is hereby resolved, to amend Section 3 Article II, Section 4, Article III, and Section 5 of Provincial Ordinance No. 05-03 entitled “An Ordinance Levying Fees and Charges for the Use of Facilities and Equipment Owned by the Provincial Government of Leyte.

**I. Section 3 Article II, Provincial Ordinance No. 05-03** is hereby amended and definitions expanded as follows:

*“Kiosks” - refers to the stalls constructed under the amphitheater at the Leyte Sports Development Center for commercial purposes and other similar structures within the jurisdiction of the Province.*

*“Equipment” - refer to the WOW Leyte Bus and other similar equipment.*

**Section 4, Article III, Provincial Ordinance No. 05-03** is hereby amended and new subsections are inserted to read as follows:

**Section 4. FEES AND CHARGES.** The following schedule of fees and charges for the use of provincial government equipment and facilities shall be imposed as follows:

**A. RTR Plaza. xxx**

**B. Leyte Sports & Development Center (LSDC). xxx**

**C. Provincial Gymnasium. xxx**

**D. Leyte Convention Complex - Main Hall:**

- *Day Time/Nighttime (With Power) - Php 50,000.00 for 8 hours or less, use.*
- *In excess of 8 hours use— Php 4,000.00 per hour.*
- *Security Deposit – Php 5,000.00 per event.*

**E. LEYTE CONVENTION COMPLEX - Annex Building**

- *Day Time/Nighttime (Annex A&B) with Power - Php 47,000.00 for 8 hours or less, use.*
- *In excess of 8 hours use- Php 3,800.00 per hour.*
- *Day Time/Nighttime (Annex A or B with Power) - Php 26,000.00 for 8 hours or less, use.*
- *In excess of 8 hours use Php2,000. 00 per hour.*
- *Security Deposit (Fixed rate) – Php 5,000.00 per event.”*

**F. INTERNAL SUPPLIES FOR RENT**

- *HYDRAULIC LIFTER (before and after event) Php 2,500.00*

**G. WOW Leyte Bus**

**New provision will be made as Section 5, of the Provincial Ordinance No. 05-03 to read as follows:**

*“Section 5 – Establishment and Use of Trust Fund - A trust account is hereby created whereby all income or collection derived from the use of the Leyte Convention Complex, or grant or donation, if any, shall be deposited and shall accrue thereat. Said trust account shall be used or disbursed for the improvement of the Leyte Convention Complex and such other tourism related disbursements.*

With the formulation of the new provision, the succeeding provisions needs to be renumbered as follows:

*Section 5, (Official receipt & Permit) shall now be renumbered as Section 6  
Section 6 , (Contract of Lease,) shall now be renumbered as Section 7  
Section 7 (Exception) shall now be renumbered as Section 8  
Section 8, (Formulation of IRR) shall now be renumbered as Section 9  
Section 9, (Penal Provision) shall now be renumbered as Section 10  
Section 10, (Repealing Clause) shall now be renumbered as Section 11  
Section 11, (Effectivity) shall now be renumbered as Section 12.*

- II. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE** – If for any reason or reasons, any part of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- III. REPEALING CLAUSE** – All other Ordinances, orders, issuances, and rules. and regulations inconsistent with this Order are hereby modified and/or repealed accordingly.
- IV. EFFECTIVITY** – This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
