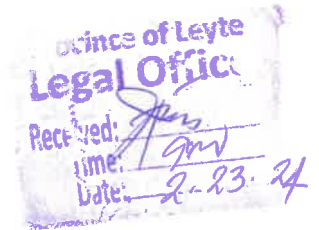
ⁱ (a) Barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of this Code, but in no case shall it be less than One thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per month for the punong barangay and Six hundred pesos (P600.00) per month for the sangguniang barangay members, barangay treasurer, and barangay secretary; Provided, however, That the annual appropriations for personal services shall be subject to the budgetary limitations prescribed under Title Five, Book II of this Code;

ⁱⁱ (d) All duly appointed members of the barangay tanod brigades, or their equivalent, which shall number not more than twenty (20) in each barangay, shall be granted insurance or other benefits during their incumbency, chargeable to the barangay or the city or municipal government to which the barangay belongs.

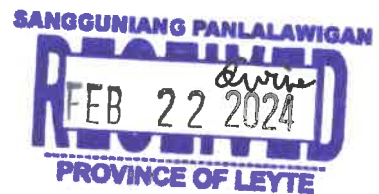

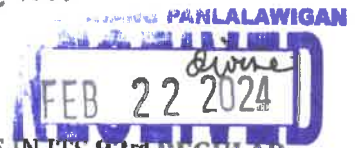

WHEREAS, Section 447 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that the Sangguniang Bayan, as the legislative body of the municipality, shall enact ordinances, approve resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants pursuant to Section 16 of the Code;

WHEREAS, Section 393 (a) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that barangay officials, including Barangay Tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipality or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of the Code;

WHEREAS, Section 393 (d) of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that all duly appointed members of the Barangay Tanod Brigades, or the equivalent, which shall number not more than twenty (20) in each barangay, shall be granted insurance or other benefits during their incumbency, chargeable to the barangay or the city or municipal government to which the barangay belongs;

NOW THEREFORE, in view of the foregoing premises, upon motion of **Honorable Federico P. Carolino, Jr.** and duly seconded by **Honorable Emmanuel D. Arboso** and **Honorable Allan B. Egano**;

BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Capoocan, Leyte in session assembled that:

Page 1 of 3

SECTION 1. TITLE - This Ordinance shall be known as the “**Financial Assistance to Barangay Tanods**”.

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY - It is the policy of this municipality to enact measures that will enhance the public health, safety and convenience, maintain peace and order, and promote the general prosperity of its inhabitants. It shall then be its declared policy to promote and improve the social well-being and welfare of the Barangay Tanods, who are the forefronts in keeping peace and order and public safety in the locality.

SECTION 3. PURPOSE - This Ordinance aims to ensure the grant of Financial Assistance to Barangay Tanods to motivate them to sustain and improve further their performances and services.

SECTION 4. COVERAGE - This ordinance shall cover all duly appointed Barangay Tanods in the Municipality of Capoocan, Leyte who unequivocally render their services to maintain peace and order in their locale.

SECTION 5. NUMBER OF BARANGAY TANODS - Pursuant to **Section 393 (d)** of the **Local Government Code of 1991**, all duly appointed members of the barangay tanod brigades, or the equivalent, shall number not more than twenty (20) in each barangay.

SECTION 6. REGISTRATION - In order for a duly registered Barangay Tanod to be entitled to the assistance provided under this ordinance, the Barangay GAD Focal Persons shall register them with the GAD Coordinator of the Municipality of Capoocan, Leyte.

SECTION 7. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND BENEFITS - In recognition of their services, all duly registered Barangay Tanods who are actively and regularly performing their duties as certified by their Punong barangay shall be entitled to the assistance, as follows:

1. **Financial Assistance** - Duly registered Barangay Tanods shall receive financial assistance amounting to a **minimum of PhP1,000.00 to a maximum of PhP1,500.00** from the Municipal Government, **once a year**.
2. **Schedule of Release** - The identified volunteers shall receive the financial assistance in the 1st Quarter of the succeeding year.
3. **Prerequisites** - to be eligible in claiming the assistance, the following shall be submitted:
 - a) **Certified True Copy of the Certificate of Registration from the concerned offices.**
 - b) **Accomplishment Report duly signed by the concerned offices.**
 - c) **The identified Barangay Tanods must have rendered at least seven (7) months and shall still be in service at the end of the current year.**

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - The amount necessary to carry out provisions of this Ordinance in its enactment, shall be included in the ensuing Appropriation Ordinance embodying annual or supplemental budget and every year thereafter, the same shall be included in the annual budget of the **Gender and Development (GAD) Fund for Barangay Tanods**.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinance executive orders, issuances including rules and regulations inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY -This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.





 - a) **Certified True Copy of the Certificate of Registration from the concerned offices.**
 - b) **Accomplishment Report duly signed by the concerned offices.**

SECTION 8. APPROPRIATION - The amount necessary to carry out provisions of this Ordinance in its enactment, shall be included in the ensuing Appropriation Ordinance embodying annual or supplemental budget and every year thereafter, the same shall be included in the annual budget of the **Gender and Development (GAD) Fund for Barangay Tanods**.

SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared invalid, the remainder or any provision hereof not affected thereby shall remain in force and effect.

SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinance executive orders, issuances including rules and regulations inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.


