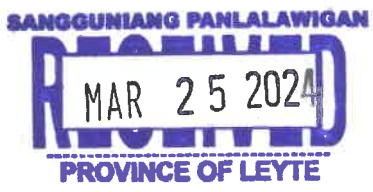

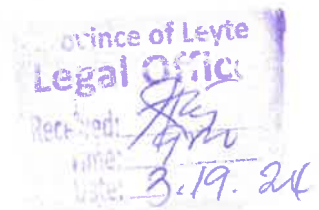

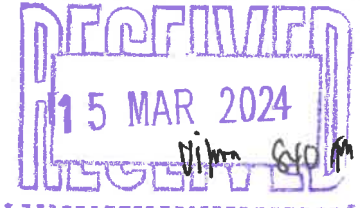

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte in regular session assembled that:

Article 1. General Provisions

Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the "Bajaj Tricycle-for-hire Regulation Ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte."

Section 2. Purpose and Objective. The purpose of this ordinance is to:

- a) Promote the use of Bajaj units as tricycles-for-hire in providing reliable and affordable transportation services to the community;
- b) Regulate the operation of Bajaj units to ensure passenger safety and comfort;
- c) Establish guidelines for Bajaj unit operators and drivers; and
- d) Impose penalties for violations of this ordinance.

Article II. Definitions





Section 1. Bajaj Unit

A Bajaj unit refers to a specific type of three-wheeled motor vehicle that is now being used as a tricycle-for-hire in the Philippines, characterized by a small enclosed cabin for the drivers and passengers.

Article III. Operation of Bajaj Units

Section 1. Permit and Licensing.

1.1 Bajaj unit operators shall obtain a permit from the Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte, prior to operating as a tricycle-for-hire service.

1.2 All Bajaj unit drivers shall possess a valid professional driver's license and must undergo necessary training and orientation as mandated by the municipality.

Section 2. Route. The operation of the Bajaj units shall be divided into two namely the East Bound and the West Bound.


2.1 East Bound Route shall cover the Barangays of:

3.1 East Bound route shall have the foregoing color and design:



3.2 West bound route shall have the foregoing color and design:



3.3 Body Number and MATRIDA Logo. Each Unit shall bear its assigned Body Number on the left side and the MATRIDA logo on the right side for easy identification.

Section 4. Fare System.

4.1 Fare rates for Bajaj units shall be approved, reviewed, and adjusted periodically by the Sangguniang Bayan in coordination with Matag-ob Tricycle Drivers Association (MATRIDA).

4.2 Fare rates shall be prominently displayed within the Bajaj unit for reference and transparency.


Section 5. Safety Regulations.

5.1 All Bajaj units must undergo a regular safety inspection conducted by the Office of the PNP Matag-ob Police Station through its duly designated personnel for





the purpose in coordination with the Office of the Municipal Treasurer to ensure road worthiness.

5.2 Bajaj units shall only be allowed to carry a maximum capacity of 6 passengers excluding the driver, and the maximum capacity shall be indicated inside the unit visible to the riding public.

5.3 Body number shall be printed at the front portion of the unit and shall be properly illuminated or lighted for easy identification.

5.4 Bajaj drivers must strictly adhere to traffic rules and regulations, including speed limits, to minimize the risk of accidents.

5.5 Operators shall not allow the overloading of passengers or the transportation of hazardous materials on their tricycles-for-hire.

Article IV. Violations and Penalties

Section 1. Violations

1.1 Failure to obtain the necessary permit and license to operate a Bajaj unit as a tricycle-for-hire.

1.2. Failure to comply with safety regulations outlined in this ordinance.

1.3 Overcharging of fares exceeding the approved rates.

1.4 Reckless driving and violation of traffic rules and regulations.

Section 2. Penalties

a) First Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 1,000.00;

b) Second Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 1,500.00;


c) Third Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 2,500.00 or imprisonment of 5 days and invalidation of his/her permit to operate, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.





1.1 The Office of the Municipal Treasurer in coordination with the Matag-ob PNP shall oversee the implementation of this ordinance and coordinate with relevant authorities to ensure its proper execution.

1.2 The Office of the Municipal Treasurer in coordination with the Matag-ob PNP shall conduct regular inspections, audits, and monitoring of Bajaj units once every six (6) months to ensure compliance with regulations.

1.3 Bajaj Units shall be given a grace period of 6 months to change the color and design of their unit according to their respective route, provided that all new franchisee shall not be issued a franchise unless their unit is compliant.

1.4. Old tricycle units shall be allowed to operate for a period of six (6) months after approval of this ordinance to give the operator time to change into bajaj unit.

Section 2. Amendments Clause.

This ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

Section 3. Effectivity Clause.

This ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its approval.

Section 4. Repealing Clause

Any existing ordinances or provisions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance shall be repealed or modified accordingly.



After a short discussion on the matter, the Body agreed to take note of several observations by the attendees who were present during the public hearing.

Questions:

1. Maximum Capacity.

The Bajaj Unit as tricycle-for-hire shall be allowed a maximum capacity of 6 passengers excluding the driver, hence, hence, Article III, Section 3, p. 3.2 shall be amended accordingly.



2. Change of color of the bajaj unit.

There will be a color coding for bajaj units to correspond to their route. The route will be divided into East Bound and West Bound. The specifications including colors and design shall be incorporated in the Ordinance.

A question was also raised as to what is the process in the Land Transportation Office (LTO) regarding the change of color and design of the body of the unit. The Mayor, Honorable Bernardino G. Tacoy manifested that he

to ensure that there is no more illegal parking of any motor vehicle within the Poblacion to effect free flow of traffic and most specially to ensure the safety of everyone. The Mayor added that he will consult with the LNB President, Honorable Joel Tacoy regarding the wage of the dispatcher because the terminal is within the territorial jurisdiction of Barangay Talisay.

The Honorable Joel G. Tacoy made a manifestation that he will help to facilitate that the cost of change of color units will be minimal and may be paid in instalment basis sot that the operators will not be over-burdened. The Mayor then interposed that he will assign somebody to coordinate

7. Grace period to comply with the requirements of the ordinance.

The operator of bajaj units that are already running/operating will be given 6 months from approval of ordinance to comply with the requirements of the ordinance, like the change of color of their units. For new applicants, their unit must already conform to the requirements upon submission of their application for franchise.

8. A question was raised by an operator if the east bound units can conduct west bound passengers. The Mayor answered that yes they can so long as their origin is not from the municipal terminal. They can also pick up passenger along the way and vice-versa.

9. Tricycle units. Old Tricycle units model may be allowed to operate as long as their road worthiness is ascertained, otherwise they shall be given a certain period of time to change their unit to bajaj.

The question was raised to clarify issues where the passenger would choose to ride bajaj units even if it is not their turn yet. The Mayor answered that it is ok because the passenger has every right to choose which vehicle to board so long as the passenger is willing to wait for the turn of his/her chosen vehicle to run.

10. Casilion operators. Another question raised was whether the operators from Barangay Casilion, Villaba, Leyte will be allowed to hold franchise to operate in Matagob. The Mayor answered that they will not be allowed to renew franchise anymore considering that they are not actual residents within the territorial jurisdiction of Matagob, Leyte.

11. Colorum Units. It was learned that during this public hearing, there are at least 4 operators that have no franchise, hence, they are considered colorum. The Mayor then gave a stern warning that it will not be tolerated. To solve this problem the LGU is planning to issue 10 new franchises starting this year 2024.

The Mayor also interjected that it is the responsibility of the President of MATRIDA to look after the welfare of his members so that colorum units will not be allowed to operate.



12. Traffic Enforcer. The Mayor also gave commitment that he will install traffic enforcer soon.

13. Private Units . It was learned that MATRIDA has allowed certain private individuals to use their tricycle units to ferry family members to and from school only in the morning and afternoon.

The Mayor answered that there is no problem with this kind of arrangement because it is only family use.
