WHEREAS, under the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC) to which it is determined to give priority to the right to protect public health and to promote measures of tobacco control based on current and relevant scientific, technical, and economic considerations, and agreed to implement the measures provided in the treaty.


WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9211, also known as the "Tobacco Regulation Act of 2003", is an omnibus law regulating smoking in public places, in public utility conveyances, in government building, premises and grounds, in tobacco advertising, promotion and sponsorship, and in sales restrictions, among other requirements.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11900, also known as the Vaporized Nicotine & non-Nicotine Products and novel Tobacco Products such as E-cigarette and heated tobacco products, regulating both nicotine containing & nicotine-free cigarettes similarly.

WHEREAS, the Philippine Clean Air Act of 1999, or Republic Act No. 8749 declares the right of every citizen to



breathe clean air, prohibition of smoking inside enclosed public places, including public conveyances and other means of transport, and it directs local government units to implement this provision.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Code of 1991, or Republic Act No. 7160 accords every local government unit's power and authority to promote the general welfare within its territorial jurisdiction, including the promotion of health and safety of its constituents.

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Matag-ob recognizes that it must act with urgency to de-normalize the culture of smoking and tobacco consumption through comprehensive and proven effective tobacco control measures as increasing number of Filipinos die each year of tobacco smoke-related diseases such as its effect on hypertension, stroke, heart disease, lung cancer and various cancers among others.

WHEREAS, scientific evidences have unmistakable established that tobacco consumption and likewise exposure to tobacco smoke causes diseases, disabilities and even death. It leads to socio-economic & environmental consequences, places burdens on families, especially the poor sectors, and causes devastation on the national and local health systems. Scientific evidences have shown that there is no safe level of exposure to tobacco smoke. Effective measures to protect from exposure requires the total elimination of smoking and tobacco smoke. Approaches other than 100% smoke-free environment have repeatedly been shown to be ineffective, including ventilation, air filtration and the use of designated smoking areas, whether with separate ventilation systems or not.

WHEREAS, there is a need to have a new implementing rules and regulations necessary to ensure the effective implementation of this Ordinance No. 200, series of 2024.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE SANGGUNIANG BAYAN OF MATAG-OB, LEYTE THAT:


SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known as the "Anti-Smoking Ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte."





SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVE. This ordinance is enacted in order to promote and safeguard the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Matag-ob, Leyte by regulating smoking in public places, workplaces, and enclosed areas. It aims to reduce exposure to secondhand smoke, decrease the initiation of smoking among the youth, and support individuals who wish to quit smoking. By enacting this ordinance, the local government seeks to create a healthier and more pleasant environment for all residents and visitors, contributing to the overall well-being of the community.

SECTION 3. SCOPE OF THE ORDINANCE. This Ordinance shall apply to:

1. All drivers, conductors, inspectors and passengers of all public conveyances, government-owned vehicles, and other means of public transport within the territorial jurisdiction of Municipality of Matag-ob;
2. All drivers and passengers of private-owned vehicles, of an open-type vehicle or a vehicle with opened-windows and are parked or in stationary in any areas or spaces owned by the government, within the territorial jurisdiction of Matag-ob
3. All accommodation and entertainment establishments or businesses in Matag-ob, enclosed and open spaces.
4. All workplaces in Matag-ob, private & government sectors. All company vehicles used for transporting employees, guests or any vehicle used in the course of work are considered part of the workplace.
5. All public buildings and facilities, whether open or enclosed (totally/ partially) such as but not limited to: government offices, healthcare & educational institutions, etc.
6. All spaces & facilities, public or private that are frequented by minors.
7. All public recreational facilities & places, outdoor and indoor, such as but not limited to: sports complex, athletic fields, parks, plazas, etc.

SECTION 4. INTERPRETATION. These rules and regulations shall be construed in a manner that can achieve the primary objective of the New Comprehensive Anti-Smoking Ordinance of Municipality of Matag-ob which is to safeguard public health and ensure the well-being of all its constituents by protecting them from the

harmful & toxic effects of smoking and tobacco consumption.

SECTION 5. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- A. **ACCOMMODATION AND ENTERTAINMENT ESTABLISHMENT** - refer to establishments that provide food, accommodation, drinks, merchandise, entertainment or other professional services including, but not limited to, restaurants, fast foods, eateries, hotels, motels, lodges, inns, boarding houses, disco houses, karaoke/ videoke bars, resto bars, and movie houses, or any other place with pleasant environment and atmosphere conducive to comfort, healthful relaxation and rest, offering food and/or drinks, sleeping accommodation and recreation facilities to the public for a fee;
- B. **BUSINESS** – organization or enterprising entity engaged in commerce, industrial, or professional activities.
- C. **CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE** - a certification in writing issued by the Municipal Mayor or his duly authorized representative that the establishment has complied with after the required inspection, evaluation and recommendation conducted by the concerned regulatory offices.
- D. **CONVEYANCES** – means of transportation, vehicles.
- E. **DSAs or DESIGNATED SMOKING AREA** - refers to spaces or areas wherein a person is allowed to smoke without violating the said Ordinance.
- F. **RESIDENCE**, a private property or private building; can be the smoking area, for as long as the area is not freely used or rented for public used and it is not frequented by minors.
- G. **ELECTRONIC DEVICE SYSTEMS** - refer to any device such as electronic nicotine device systems, electronic cigarette or E-cigarette and similar devices, whether it is used to deliver nicotine to the user or not, that however resembles the outward appearance of real smoking products.



H. **RECREATIONAL FACILITIES/ PLACES** - refers to all places which could be enclosed by one or more walls or sides whether covered by a roof or not, or even if open on all sides but is covered by a roof, regardless of whether the structure is permanent or temporary in nature or all places for collective use, regardless of ownership or right to access including, but not limited to gasoline stations, banks, malls, shopping/business arcades, town squares, terminals, airport, seaport, schools, places of worship/churches, hospitals, cinema houses, gymnasiums/covered courts, funeral parlors, barber shops, cockpits, gaming areas, recreational facilities, pedestrian overpass, indoor car parks, waiting sheds, sidewalks and other places where people usually congregate;

I. **ORDINANCE** - law, set forth by government authority. It shall refer to Ordinance No. 200, otherwise known as "The Anti-Smoking Ordinance of Matag-ob, Leyte".

J. **PUBLIC CONVEYANCES** - refer to any vehicle, whether mobile or stationary, used in the transport of passengers or available to the public as a mode of transport, such as but not limited to jeepneys, buses, trains, vans, taxis, airplanes, ships and other modes of water transportation, tricycles, single motorcycles, and others, as public utility vehicles whether covered by a Certificate of Public Convenience or not.


K. **PUBLIC BUILDING or FACILITY**- refers to any of the following:

i.1) Any building or structure owned by the government or owned by a private person but used or rented or occupied by the government or any of its instrumentalities.

i.2) Any building or structure used or controlled exclusively for public purposes by any department or branch of government, local government unit or barangay without reference to the ownership of the building.






- L. **PUBLIC OUTDOOR SPACES** - refers to outdoor spaces that are open to the public, or places where facilities are available for the general public or where a crowd of people gather or congregate regardless of ownership or right to access such as but not limited to parks, playgrounds, sports grounds or centers, gaming areas, cockfighting areas, church grounds, healthcare/hospital compounds, cemeteries, gardens, resorts, beaches, pools, markets, streets, sidewalks, parking areas, walkways, entrance ways, waiting areas, stairwells and the like.
- M. **SHISHA** – a waterpipe also known Sheesha, Hookah, Nargeela, Argeel, Nargile, or any other name that refers to a device or instrument which may have a single or multi-stemmed pipe for smoking, whether, it delivers nicotine to the user, in which the smoke is passed through a water basin before inhalation.
- N. **SMOKING** - refers to the lighting and/or puffing of cigarette; cigar; herbal or plants such as "lomboy" and any tobacco product of any kind/ form /or type; electronic device systems; Shisha and the like.
- O. **TOBACCO PRODUCT** - any product that consists of loose tobacco that contains nicotine and is intended for use as a CIGARETTE, ORAL or CHEWING and NASAL SNUFF.
- P. **WORKPLACES** - an area, permanent and temporary, government and private; in which a person performs duties of employment or work, regardless of whether the work is done for compensation or on a voluntary basis.
- Q. **BPLO** - Business Permit and Licensing Office in Matag-ob, is responsible in processing of business applications both new and renewal.
- R. **MHO** - Municipal Health Office in Matag-ob, primarily responsible for the provision and delivery of public health services and regulation of providers of health goods and services.
- S. **PNP** - Philippine National Police is the national police forces assigned in Municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte, responsible in implementing existing laws,





T. **SMOKING CESSATION COUNSELOR / ADVISOR** – a trained health professional, an advocate of the “Smoking Cessation Program” of the Department of Health; provide support to smokers thru interview, counselling & even treatment to improve their ability to become or stay nicotine-free, thus promoting early prevention of respiratory and other related diseases.

SECTION 6. PROHIBITED ACTS. The following acts shall be prohibited:

- A. Smoking, Sniffing or Chewing of any Tobacco products and using Electronic Device System (EDS), Shisha and the like, in any of the places enumerated in Section 3 of the Ordinance, except in the approved DSAs (Designated Smoking Areas). Therefore, all prohibited places mentioned in SECTION 3 shall hereof be understood as a **totally non-smoking area.**
- B. Possession of any lighted cigarette, or cigar, or any tobacco product, or an actually operated electronic device system (EDS), ex. Vape, Shisha and the like within the enumerated areas under SECTION 3, shall constitute prima facie evidence as an act of smoking prohibited under this Ordinance.
- C. Prohibition of selling of cigarette & other tobacco products or electronic device system (EDS), Shisha and the like, whether in face to face selling or online selling, to individuals under the age 18 years old or to minors, even though with a verbal or written consent from parents or guardians or any adults.
- D. Prohibition of selling of cigarette, any herbal/plant cigars (ex: lomboy), other tobacco products and or electronic device system (EDS), Shisha and the like, by the stores, groceries, or any business establishments within the Municipality of Matag-ob during the days other than **Wednesdays & Saturdays.**
- E. Prohibition of delivery by tobacco manufacturing companies' trucks, panels or vans of cigarettes, or any tobacco products, and or Electronic Device

System (EDS), Shisha and the like to the stores, groceries, or any business establishments within the Municipality of Matag-ob during the days other than **Wednesdays & Saturdays**.

- F. The law, RA 9211, prohibits the selling of cigarettes, or any tobacco products, Electronic Device System (EDS), Shisha and the like, to stores, groceries, or any business establishments that are located within 100meters from any point of the perimeter of schools, public playgrounds, or other facility frequented by minors.
- G. Prohibition of selling cigarettes, or any tobacco products, Electronic Device System (EDS), Shisha and the like, within any government facilities or institutions.
- H. Prohibition of ambulant vendors or peddlers to sell cigarettes, any herbal/plant cigars (ex: lomboy), other tobacco products, and or Electronic Device System (EDS), Shisha and the like, in any places within the jurisdiction of Municipality of Matag-ob.
- I. Prohibition of installing vending machines of cigarettes & other tobacco products in any places within the jurisdiction of Matag-ob, Leyte.
- J. Prohibition of installing a DSA or Designated Smoking Area in any places enumerated in SECTION 3 of the Ordinance.
- K. Prohibition of selling and or display of cigarettes, any herbal/plant cigars (ex: lomboy) or other tobacco product, Electronic Device Systems (EDS), Shisha and the like, inside the accommodation establishments nor inside the entertainment establishments.
- L. Knowingly, allowing, abetting, or tolerating smoking of any cigarette, or tobacco, or any EDS (Electronic Device Systems), Shisha and the like in any of the places enumerated in SECTION 3 of the Ordinance.
- M. Refusal to allow the entry of the members of the Anti-Smoking Task Force or its duly deputized enforcers into places mentioned in SECTION 3 of the Ordinance for the purpose of implementing, monitoring, inspecting, and enforcing the






N. Failure to comply with the mandatory duties and obligations as enumerated in SECTION 7 of these rules and regulations as well as any other provisions of the Ordinance.

Any person who wish to smoke tobacco products and the likes may be allowed only within the comfort of his own residence compound. He may be allowed to smoke inside his vehicle while he is riding it provided that he does not smoke outside of his vehicle when it is within public places.

SECTION 7. MANDATORY DUTIES AND OBLIGATIONS.

The person-in-charge, which refers to the President or Manager in cases of a company, Corporation, or Association, or Partnership or the Owner/Proprietor or Operator in case of Single Proprietorship, of accommodation and entertainment establishments, whether tourism-accredited or not, workplaces, Public Buildings, Enclosed or Partially Enclosed Public Places, Public Outdoor Spaces shall:

a) Post and Display of Signages:

a.1) Posting and displaying an 8x16 inches **"This is a Non-Smoking Establishment (or Facility)"** sign at all entrances using red color.


a.2) Prominently display **"NO SMOKING"** signs in red color, at the most visible locations in the area or building or establishment where smoking is prohibited (main accommodation area, waiting area, conference room, function room, VIP room, bar, cashier, comfort rooms), in order to ensure that the public can easily view such signs and be notified.

a.3) At the very least a **"NO SMOKING"** sign for new establishment shall occupy no less than 50% of said signage. The remaining lower 50% of the signage shall show the following warning prominently:

* (consisting of a pictorial representation of a burning cigarette enclosed in a red circle with a red bar across it)



- e.) The person-in-charge or his/her duly authorized representative including the employees concerned shall immediately inform its duly deputized enforcers and or the Anti-Smoking Task Force or the Law enforcers, thru the Hotline numbers, or at the nearest police station, for the violation and the violator(s) thereof;
- f.) Owners, Operators and Drivers of public utility vehicles in Matag-ob that conveys or transport passenger(s) to & from municipality; all government-owned vehicles of the local government unit and all establishments or company-owned vehicles in Matag-ob that are used to transport employees and guests to & from Matag-ob are mandated to prominently display **"NO SMOKING"** sign in their units, as follows:

4. For other types of vehicles, the **"NO SMOKING"** sign of at least 3.5 sq. inch shall be placed at the back of the windshield and another sign of at least 14 sq. inch shall be placed at the back of the driver's seat.
5. All cases involving a minor violating any of the provisions of the Ordinance shall be referred by the apprehending officer, after the issuance of the citation ticket, to the Municipal Social Welfare Development Office (MSWDO) and the latter shall ensure that the minor and his/her parents or guardians be referred to the Municipal Health Officer or Smoking Cessation Counselor for proper counseling.

Thereafter, the minor shall be referred to the concerned Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC), for the appropriate diversion and rehabilitation program. And for this purpose, the MSWDO, in coordination with the BCPC and MHO, is enjoined to formulate its appropriate diversion and rehabilitation programs & activities.

SECTION 8. ANTI-SMOKING TASK FORCE. There shall be created an Inter-Agency Task Force which will be known as the **"Matag-ob Anti-Smoke Task Force"**, and shall be constituted and created with the following duties and responsibilities for the purpose of smoking regulations, which is to protect the smokers & non-smokers from the pernicious effects of exposure to tobacco smoke.

b.) With the approval of the Municipal Mayor, the Anti-Smoking Task Force shall also have the power to recommend amendments or revisions of any provision of the Ordinance.

c.) Sixty (60) days after effectivity of the Ordinance, the Anti-Smoking Task Force in coordination with BPLO shall conduct an ocular inspection of all establishments in the municipality to determine compliance with the requirements of these rules/ regulations, and Ordinance.

d.) Conduct Ocular inspection for all non-tourism accredited and tourism-accredited accommodation and entertainment establishments, in coordination with the Municipal Tourism Office and the BPLO;

e.) The Anti-Smoking Task Force, in coordination with the Municipal Health Office staff, shall undertake educational awareness campaigns on the ill-effects of smoking and exposure to second-hand smoke; information dissemination programs; and capacity building programs and smoking cessation clinics.


f.) The Anti-Smoking Task Force in coordination with the Municipal Health Office shall also inform the public of the provisions of these rules and regulations, and Ordinance, thru an intensified tri-media campaign.

SECTION 11. TRAINING AND DEPUTATION







proper court shall be allowed to pay the foregoing administrative penalty:

First Offense: 500.00

Second Offense: 1,000.00

Third Offense: 2,500

The violator shall be given a period of three (3) days after apprehension to pay the above corresponding fine, otherwise, the case shall be prosecuted in proper court against the violator. All proceeds from payment of the herein penalty imposed shall accrue to the Municipal General Funds.

Any violator who have been issued a Citation Ticket for Third and succeeding offenses shall be required to undergo a Smoking Cessation Counseling in accredited clinics and health centers after the penalty has been paid. The smoking cessation counselor shall attest that the violator had undergone counseling by signing his/her name in the citation ticket and attaching the required counseling form. After complying with the said requirements, the violator shall return the citation ticket to the police station of the apprehending officer or to the Anti-Smoking Task Force Office if the deputized enforcer is not a member of the Philippine National Police of Matag-ob.

Notwithstanding the payment of the administrative penalty provided herein, the failure of any person violating any of the provisions of the Ordinance to undergo the smoking cessation counselling upon third and succeeding offenses shall still warrant the filing of case in court.

SECTION 13. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other ordinances, executive orders and rules and regulations that are inconsistent with these rules and regulations are hereby repealed and/or modified accordingly.


SECTION 14. AMENDMENTS CLAUSE. This ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. Should any provision of these rules and regulations be subsequently declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not so declared and not affected by such declaration shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.

95 chance to enjoy their vice, because while it is true that we
96 are mandated to protect the lives of our constituents by
97 promoting healthy practices, we are also mandated to
98 encourage trade.
99


100 Mayor Tacoy: Agree. We are slowly moving towards a
101 smoke free municipality. In the future, smoking and selling
102 of tobacco products will be totally banned in the municipality
103 of Matag-ob, Leyte.
104

105 Jerry Ortecio: This legislation will affect the income of the
106 business sector. Also, the usual delivery schedule is
107 Tuesday.
108

109 Hon. Denoy: The local government will be responsible in
110 disseminating the information regarding the schedule of
111 delivery. The salesman who shall delivering the tobacco
112 products to our municipality will be duly notified, hence, they
113 have to abide by our ordinance.
114

115 Engr. Roberto Boldero: Proceeded to express his strongly
116 support to the ordinance being introduced. He agreed that
117 while there are people who smokes, a lot others are in
118 danger of the grave effects of second-hand smoke, which is
119 much more detrimental to the health of the non-smoker as
120 per medical studies.


