Furthermore, the opinions rendered herein are without prejudice to opinions rendered by higher authorities.

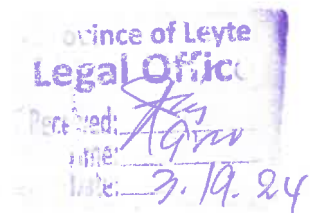

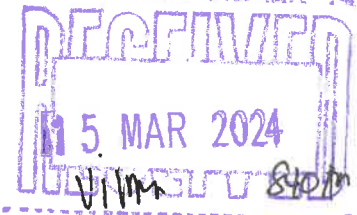

**Section 1. SHORT TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "Anti-Illegal Parking Ordinance Amendments".

**Section 2. Section 3 shall be amended so that it shall read as follows:**

**Amended Provision:**

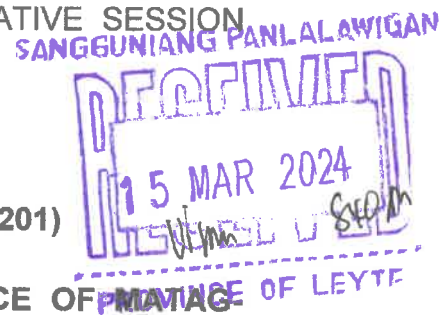
**Section 3. VEHICLES NOT TO BE IN CERTAIN AREAS.** No driver of any vehicle shall:

- Park a vehicle in a "No parking Area", except when loading or unloading goods;*
- Vehicles are only permitted to park for a limited time during fiestas, burials, weddings, Katig-oban Festival, Himorasak Festival, and other LGU activities.*

**Section 3. Section 4 shall be amended so that it shall read as follows:**

**Section 4. Shall be amended so that letter "g" shall be deleted.**

- within any pedestrian zone;
- between the pedestrian zone and the nearest curb;






- c. in front of a right-of-way, passage or private driveway;
- d. alongside or opposite any excavation if the vehicles would obstruct traffic;
- e. on any footway, marked crosswalk or pedestrian crossing;
- f. upon a bridge or other related structure or within a tunnel or underpass;

**Section 4. Section 5. LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONES.**

A driver of a public utility vehicle shall stop, pick up or unload passengers only at the Municipal Terminal.

**Section 5. Delete the whole of "Section 6. METHODS OF PARKING VEHICLES.** Any driver who parks or leaves a vehicle waiting on a thoroughfare shall park or leave the vehicle waiting:

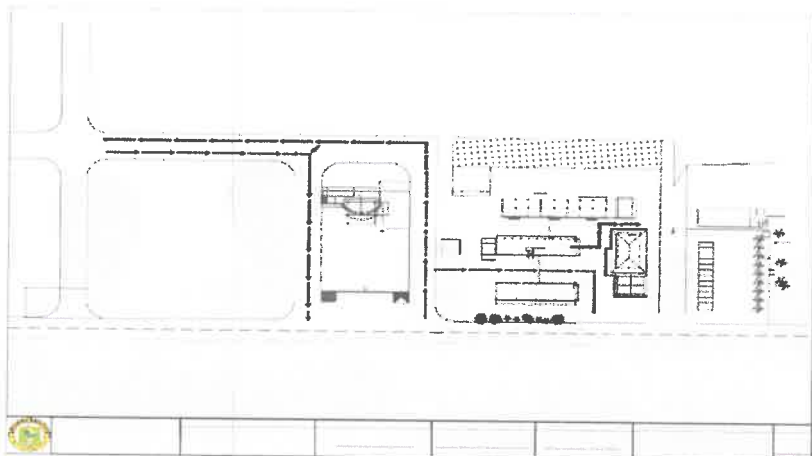
*a. in the case of a road on which vehicles are permitted to travel in both direction, as near as practicable to the right boundary of the thoroughfare;*

*b. in the case of a one-way road on which vehicles are permitted to travel in one direction only, vehicles are only allowed to park in the left side as near as practicable to left boundary of the road and parallel to the boundary of the thoroughfare;*

*c. so that not less than 3meters of the width of the thoroughfare between the vehicle and the far boundary of the thoroughfare is available for the movement of other vehicles;*

*d. in a manner that it does not cause undue obstruction on the thoroughfare."*

**Section 6. Section 7. DESIGNATED PARKING AREAS shall be amended as follows:**

“Third Offense - P2,000.00 or imprisonment of Five (5) days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.”

**Section 8. Amendments Clause.** This ordinance may be amended or modified as necessary through the appropriate legislative process.

**Session 9. Repealing Clause.** Any ordinance, Rule or Regulation or part thereof which are inconsistent with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

**Session 10. Effectivity.** This ordinance shall take effect 15 days upon approval.

44 After a short discussion on the matter, the Body

49 Hon. Denoy: The public is then informed that the local  
50 government will strictly implement the provisions of this  
51 ordinance. And the ordinance specifically provides that no  
52 person shall be allowed to smoke in any public places within  
53 the municipality.

55 Mayor Bernardino G. Tacoy: The Honorable Mayor also  
56 gave his commitment that although the local government  
57 encourage trade, he commits to protect the welfare of the  
58 majority specially the welfare of the non-smoking populace  
59 of the municipality.  
60


61 Kagawad Gilbert Bontes: Just inquired regarding the  
62 provision in the ordinance that provides that the business  
63 establishments may sell tobacco products at least 2 days in  
64 a week every Wednesday and Saturday. Does it mean that  
65 any person may also be allowed to smoke in public on these  
66 days mentioned?  
67

68 Hon. Denoy: The answer is no. Although stores may be  
69 allowed to sell, and deliveries are also allowed on  
70 Wednesday and Saturday but still no person shall be  
71 allowed to smoke in public places. They may smoke  
72 anytime at their residence only.  
73

74 Cita Gonzaga: So it won't be considered illegal if a person  
75 would smoke inside his/her residence?  
76


77 Hon. Denoy: No person shall be apprehended if he/she is

83 Mayor Tacoy: It is the mandate of the local government to  
84 protect the lives of its constituents. Hence, the anti-smoking  
85 ordinance aims to protect the health of the majority. It is now  
86 the responsibility of the smoker to put in danger the lives of  
87 his family should he/she continues to smoke in the presence  
88 of his/her family at their residence.  
89  
90 A question arose why the local government still allows the  
91 selling and delivery of tobacco products?  
92  
93 Hon. Denoy: We are transitioning to a smoke free  
94 municipality. In the meantime, we are giving the smokers a  
95 chance to enjoy their vice, because while it is true that we  
96 are mandated to protect the lives of our constituents by  
97 promoting healthy practices, we are also mandated to  
98 encourage trade.  
99  
100 Mayor Tacoy: Agree. We are slowly moving towards a  
101 smoke free municipality. In the future, smoking and selling  
102 of tobacco products will be totally banned in the municipality  
103 of Matag-ob, Leyte.  
104  
105 Jerry Ortecio: This legislation will affect the income of the  
106 business sector. Also, the usual delivery schedule is  
107 Tuesday.  
108  
109 Hon. Denoy: The local government will be responsible in  
110 disseminating the information regarding the schedule of  
111 delivery. The salesman who shall delivering the tobacco  
112 products to our municipality will be duly notified, hence, they  
113 have to abide by our ordinance.  
114  
115 Engr. Roberto Boldero: Proceeded to express his strongly  
116 support to the ordinance being introduced. He agreed that  
117 while there are people who smokes, a lot others are in  
118 danger of the grave effects of second-hand smoke, which is  
119 much more detrimental to the health of the non-smoker as  
120 per medical studies.



164 Hon. Denoy: Presented the full text of the proposed  
165 ordinance.

166  
167 Mr. Rodulfo E. Sanoria: Raised the matter of the parking of  
168 motor vehicles of TAPRIMCO clients transacting business  
169 with the coop. He then proceeded to request that a parking  
170 space be designated for transacting clients and that a traffic  
171 officer shall be assigned to direct the traffic flow in the area.  
172

173 Hon. Joel G. Tacoy: The Punong Barangay of Barangay  
174 Talisay where TAPRIMCO Office is situated, explained that  
175 the barangay has no jurisdiction in that area because it is a  
176 national highway, but in consideration of the comfort and  
177 safety of our constituents then the barangay will find ways  
178 to regulate parking in front of the TAPRIMCO building.  
179

180 Mr. Sanoria: Explained that there is a space in the lot owned  
181 by Mayor Bernie, and if the Mayor would allow the said  
182 space to be used for parking, then it may be used for  
183 TAPRIMCO clients.  
184

185 Hon. Joel Tacoy: Expressed his commitment to look into the  
186 matter as soon as possible.  
187


188 Michael Cripps: Who is the Chief Tanod of Barangay  
189 Talisay, explained that their common problem in  
190 implementing the parking ordinance is that most people  
191 would only say that they would park only for a moment.  
192

193 Hon. Joel Tacoy: Then the advise would be to issue citation  
194 ticket.  
195

196 Jerry Ortecio: Another problem on motorcycles-for-hire is  
197 that some are parking at the municipal park, while others  
198 are parking at the senior citizens building.  
199

200 Hon. Denoy: The Habal-habal drivers and operators have  
201 been designated a parking space at the Municipal Terminal.

204 not follow the regulations.

206 Hon. Denoy: Those who are colorum will be identified easily  
207 once the MAHADA will put on stickers in their units for easy  
208 identification.  
209

210 Engr. Medina Cleote Aldaya: Expressed that her office will  
211 strictly implement the no encroachment law. Hence, no  
212 parking shall be allowed within 5 meter from the center line  
213 of any municipal streets.  
214

215 Mayor Tacoy: The Sangguniang Bayan together with the  
216 Municipal Engineer will sit down to discuss further the  
217 provisions of the anti-encroachment law.  
218

219 Dayday Arevalo: Just wanted to ask regarding delivery  
220 trucks who shall be conducting delivery in business  
221 establishments.  
222


223 Hon. Joel Tacoy: They will be allowed to unload their  
224 products at the business establishment but so long as the  
225 vehicle shall not park but only unload. The driver of the  
226 delivery truck should not leave the vehicle unattended in the  
227 duration of the delivery. Most importantly, no vehicle shall  
228 be allowed to unload in counterflow.  
229

230 Gregoria Pintoy: How about customers who wants to pick-  
231 up their goods?  
232

233 Hon. Joel Tacoy: Those persons who have bought  
234 merchandise from any store may be allowed to commission  
235 a public transport vehicle and pick-up their goods right at  
236 the store only for loading.  
237


238 Mayor Tacoy: Just to make some clarifications. Vehicles  
239 may be allowed to loan and unload in front of any business  
240 establishments only. So a motor vehicle that has been  
241 commissioned to pick-up merchandise may be allowed to






