ⁱ LGUs shall ensure the roadworthiness of motorcycles, tricycles, pedicabs and motorized pedicabs for hire and must set minimum operating conditions necessary to the issuance of Operators permit;
Reiteration of the prohibition on the operation of motorcycles, tricycles and pedicabs for hire along national highways, subject to exceptions to be embodied in the ordinance;
With regard to the road clearing directive of the Department mandating the LGU's to identify the allowable and restricted areas for tricycles, motorcycles, pedicabs and motorized pedicabs for hire.
ⁱⁱ (vi) Subject to the guidelines prescribed by the Department of Transportation and Communications, regulate the operation of tricycles and grant franchises for the operation thereof within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality;

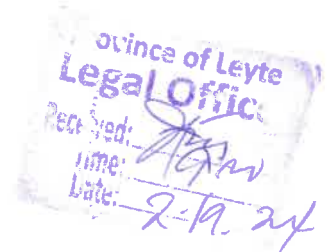

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 180
(Proposed Municipal Ordinance No. 185)

AN ORDINANCE INSTITUTING COMPULSORY REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF SINGLE MOTORCYCLES-FOR-HIRE IN MATAG-OB, LEYTE, REGULATING THEIR OPERATION, AND IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Matag-ob, Leyte in regular session assembled that:


Section 1. Title. This ordinance shall be known as the "Compulsory Registration and Licensing of Single Motorcycles-for-Hire in Matag-ob, Leyte, Regulating their Operation, and Imposing Penalties for Violations Thereof." Its purpose is to ensure the safe and efficient operations of single motorcycles-for-hire within the jurisdiction of Matag-ob, Leyte.

Section 2. Definition of Terms. For purposes of implementing this ordinance, the following terms shall be construed as follows:

a) Motorcycle – is a two-wheel motor vehicle steered by a handle bar from a saddle-style seat that is used for public transportation in the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte.






b) Operator – the owner or person in control of a single motorcycle-for hire

c) Professional Rider – a person authorized to operate a single motorcycle for-hire, possessing the necessary qualifications and licenses;

Section 3. Compulsory Registration and Licensing.

a) All operators of single motorcycles-for-hire within the municipality of Matag-ob, Leyte shall be required to register their vehicles with the Office of the Municipal Treasurer and obtain the necessary licenses and permits.

b) The registration process shall include the submission of relevant documents, such as proof of ownership, vehicle specifications, and proof of insurance.

c) Operators shall also be required to secure a valid professional driver's license.

Section 4. Operational Requirements.

a) All single motorcycles-for-hire must display prominently their respective registration numbers as prescribed by the Office of the Municipal Treasurer upon the direction of the Municipal Mayor.

b) Operators shall ensure that their motorcycles-for-hire are well maintained, roadworthy, and equipped with safety features such as headlights, tail lights, signal lights, horn (busina), step board/step knot, and rear view mirrors.

c) Drivers must wear their proper protective helmet, while operating the motorcycles-for-hire.

Section 5. Maximum Passenger Capacity. The maximum capacity of passenger shall depend on the make and model of the motorcycle as indicated hereunder;


a) for 3 capacity excluding driver;

b) for 2 capacity excluding driver;


Infants and children up to 5 years old shall not be included in the count of passenger (heads);



Section 6. Passenger Safety.

a) Operators shall not allow the overloading of passengers or the transportation of hazardous materials on their motorcycles-for-hire.

b) Drivers shall strictly adhere to traffic rules and regulations, including speed limits and safe driving practices.

c) No driver shall be allowed to drive or operate his unit under the influence of alcohol.

Section 7. Penalties. Any operator/driver found violating any provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized as follows:

a) First Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 1,000.00;

b) Second Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 1,500.00;

c) Third Offense – pay the administrative fine in the amount of 2,500.00 or imprisonment of 5 days and invalidation of his/her permit to operate, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 8. Implementation and Enforcement.

a) The Office of the Municipal Treasurer in coordination with the Chief of Police of the Matag-ob Police Station shall be responsible for the implementation and enforcement of this ordinance.


b) The Matag-ob PNP upon the leadership of its Chief of Police shall conduct regular inspections and impose penalties for violations.

c) The Office of the Municipal Treasurer in cooperation with the Matag-ob PNP shall conduct public information campaigns to educate operators, professional drivers, and passengers as well about the requirements and regulations stated in this ordinance.


Section 9. Effectivity. This ordinance shall take effect Fifteen days after its approval and subsequent posting in at least three conspicuous places within the municipal Poblacion.




