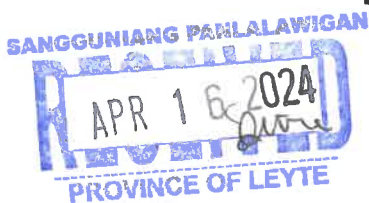

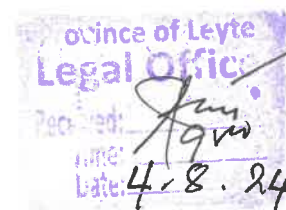

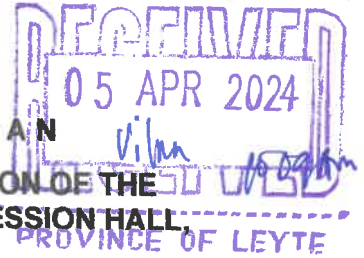

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Under the law, it is illegal to operate a two-wheeled motorcycle on public roads if a child is on board, especially if there's a heavy volume of vehicles, there's a high density of fast-moving vehicles, or where a speed limit of more than 60kph is imposed. The exception here is if the child's feet can comfortably reach the motorcycle foot peg for the pillion rider, the child's arms can reach around and grasp the waist of the motorcycle rider, and the child is wearing a standard protective helmet. Another exception is if the child being transported requires immediate medical attention.

Motorcycles have evolved into more than just a mode of transportation in the Philippines, the motorbike serves as a mode of transportation for errands, school bus transportation, a business workhouse, and in extreme situation (which we do not condone), the family van. On a little motorcycle, it is still feasible to see a father, mother and children riding together.


As the number of motorbikes on the road has increased, so has the number of motorcycle accidents, congress enacted Republic Act 10666 and signed into law in 2015, to safeguard the welfare of children, while many continue to defy the law, Republic Act 10666 finally granted law enforcement the teeth they needed to prosecute erring motorcycle riders who continue to transport little children on their motorcycles, saving the lives of numerous youngsters from potentially fatal incidents.

To improve child survival, the Local Government of Jaro, Leyte should play a stronger role in preventing deaths from motorcycle injuries, efforts should be made to prevent the promotion of unhealthy behavior or life-style among children and adolescents by understanding the need for RA 10666 to be implemented locally.

Hence, this ordinance is being proposed for enactment.

SERIES OF 2024**

AN ORDINANCE LOCALIZING THE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10666, AN
ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN ABOARD
MOTORCYCLE IN JARO, LEYTE.

Be it ordained, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte, that:

ARTICLE I

TITLE AND SCOPE OR ORDINANCE


SECTION 1. TITLE – For brevity, this ordinance shall be known as the “Safety of Children Aboard Motorcycle Ordinance of Jaro, Leyte”.

SECTION 2. SCOPE OF ORDINANCE – The provisions of this ordinance shall control, enforce, direct and regulate the operations of single motor vehicles in Jaro, Leyte, to provide safety to children as stated in Section 4 of this ordinance, in accordance with Republic Act No. 10666 or “Children’s Safety on Motorcycles Act of 2015”.

**ARTICLE II
DEFINITIONS**

SECTION 3. WORDS AND PHRASES DEFINED – As used in this ordinance:

- A. Motorcycle** – refers to any two-wheeled motor vehicle (but not limited to: Habal-habal- E-Tricycle), having one (1) or two (2) riding saddles;
- B. Public roads** – refer to roads designed by the national government or local government units as roads for public use such as, but not limited to, national highways, provincial roads, municipal and barangay streets;


- C. **Foot peg** – refers to a flat form attached to the motorcycles on which to stand or brace the feet; and
- D. **Rider** – shall mean any person/s riding on the motorcycle, scooter or moped but not necessarily driving the same.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITION - It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a two-wheeled motorcycle within the jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte, with a child on board on public roads or where a speed limit of not more than *30 kilometers per hour is being imposed*. (Reference: **Section 25, Speed Limit, Section 30-No Children as Passenger or Backrider in a Motorcycle**), *Revised Traffic Code of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte*.

- A. *As a general rule, "no child passenger is allowed in front of the motorcycle rider", unless:*
- B. *The child passenger must be 6 years old and above, physically and physiologically capable, and can comfortably reach his/her feet on the standard foot peg of the motorcycle;*
- C. The child's arms can reach around and grasp the waist of the motorcycle rider;
- D. The child is wearing a standard protective helmet referred to under Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as the "Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009";
- E. The child being transported requires immediate medical attention.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES – Riders found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized, and pay the fine at the Municipal Treasure's Office. (Reference: Section 82, *Revised Traffic Code of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte*), as follows:

- A. **1st Offense** – a fine of P 1,500.00 or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).
- B. **2nd Offense** – a fine of P 2,000.00, or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).



C. **3rd Offense** – a fine of P 2,500.00, or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).

Citation Tickets to be issued to violators of this Ordinance, shall be provided to the Municipal Traffic Enforcers, as their accountabilities. The Municipal Traffic Enforcers shall be a duly authorized representative of the Municipal Treasurer.

Violations of Section 4, and Section 5 of this Ordinance, beyond the third time shall result in the recommendation for the revocation of the offender's Driver's License at Land Transportation Office (LTO).

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any provision, portion or part of this ordinance is found to be inconsistent with any law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules and regulations or part/s thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and/or modified accordingly.


SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING BODY – The Municipal Traffic Management Enforcement Board (MTEB) shall be in-charge of the overall implementation and monitoring of this ordinance with the assistance of the JARO-Philippine National Police (JARO-PNP), Municipal Traffic Enforcers, and the Barangay Tanods and other deputized volunteer traffic group/organizations.


SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after the completion of its posting in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the Municipality of Jaro as mandated for under RA No. 7160, or otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.

AMMENDMENTS INCLUSIONS/EXCLUSIONS TO ORDINANCE NO. 23, SERIES OF 2024 INTRODUCE BY THE SB MEMBERS:


1. Par. A, Section 3, Article II – Definitions

A. Motorcycle – refers to any two-wheeled motor vehicle (but not limited to Habal-Habal, E-tricycle), having one (1) or two (2) riding saddles.


2. Section 4, Article II, to change the word "Prohibition" to "Prohibition".


3. Section 5, Article II, par. b and c, to change the "plus" to "or".
4. **Par. 1, Section 4, Article II, to read:**

SECTION 4. PROHIBITION - It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a two-wheeled motorcycle within the jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte, with a child on board on public roads or *where a speed limit of not more than 30 kilometers per hour is imposed, xxx:* (Reference: Section 25, Ordinance NO. 19, series of 2023-Enacted: November 20, 2023).

Hon. Que opines and suggest to Hon. Salgado that the JARO-BFP should have a permanent driver of their ambulance on duty that can be mobilize in time of emergency situations, just like at the RHU, and the MDRRMO, that they have a permanent driver of their rescue vehicles.

Hon. Altres opines and request more from Hon. Salgado elaborate more on the word "golden hour".

Hon. Salgado opines and inform the Body that the word "golden hour" should mean the time the patient would need an immediate medical attention in order to survive.

Hon. Tañala speaks-out that as far as he knows the JARO-BFP owned one (1) unit of ambulance, and it is already an old one, and looking at the physical appearance of the BFP ambulance, it might no longer road-worthy to be use on their rescue operation, and he believes that there is a need for the LGU to provide brand-new ambulance to the JARO-BFP.

Hon. Salgado the BFP is requesting from the LGU to use the ambulance which already on their position, and the concerns of the SB members for the drivers and for maintenance is already provided for in the MOA.



**ORDINANCE NO. 23
SERIES OF 2024**

AN ORDINANCE LOCALIZING THE REPUBLIC ACT NO. 10666,
AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE SAFETY OF CHILDREN ABOARD
MOTORCYCLE IN JARO, LEYTE.

Be it ordained, by the Sangguniang Bayan of Jaro, Leyte, that:

ARTICLE I

TITLE AND SCOPE OR ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. TITLE – For brevity, this ordinance shall be known as the
“Safety of Children Aboard Motorcycle Ordinance of Jaro, Leyte”.

SECTION 2. SCOPE OF ORDINANCE – The provisions of this ordinance
shall control, enforce, direct and regulate the operations of single motor vehicles in
Jaro, Leyte to provide safety to children as stated in Section 4 of this ordinance, in
accordance with Republic Act No. 10666 or “Children’s Safety on Motorcycles Act of
2015”.

**ARTICLE II
DEFINITIONS**

SECTION 3. WORDS AND PHRASES DEFINED – As used in this
ordinance:

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- A. **Motorcycle** – refers to any two-wheeled motor vehicle (but not limited to: Habal-habal- E-Tricycle), having one (1) or two (2) riding saddles;
- B. **Public roads** – refer to roads designed by the national government or local government units as roads for public use such as, but not limited to, national highways, provincial roads, municipal and barangay streets;
- C. **Foot peg** – refers to a flat form attached to the motorcycles on which to stand or brace the feet; and
- D. **Rider** – shall mean any person/s riding on the motorcycle, scooter or moped but not necessarily driving the same.

SECTION 4. PROHIBITION - It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a two-wheeled motorcycle within the jurisdiction of Jaro, Leyte, with a child on board on public roads or where a speed limit of not more than *30 kilometers per hour is being imposed*. (Reference: **Section 25, Speed Limit, Section 30-No Children as Passenger or Backrider in a Motorcycle**), *Revised Traffic Code of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte*).

- A. ***As a general rule, no child passenger is allowed in front of the motorcycle rider, unless:***
- B. The child passenger must be 6 years old and above, physically and physiologically capable, and can comfortably reach his/her feet on the standard foot peg of the motorcycle;
- C. The child's arms can reach around and grasp the waist of the motorcycle rider;
- D. The child is wearing a standard protective helmet referred to under Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as the "Motorcycle Helmet Act of 2009";

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- E. The child being transported requires immediate medical attention.

SECTION 5. PENALTIES – Riders found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be penalized, and pay the fine at the Municipal Treasure’s Office. (Reference: Section 82, *Revised Traffic Code of the Municipality of Jaro, Leyte*), as follows:

- A. **1st Offense** – a fine of P 1,500.00 or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).
- B. **2nd Offense** – a fine of P 2,000.00, or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).
- C. **3rd Offense** – a fine of P 2,500.00, or Blood Donation to the Jaro Rural Health Unit (RHU).



Citation Tickets to be issued to violators of this Ordinance, shall be provided to the Municipal Traffic Enforcers, as their accountabilities. The Municipal Traffic Enforcers shall be a duly authorized representative of the Municipal Treasurer.

Violations of Section 4, and Section 5 of this Ordinance, beyond the third time shall result in the recommendation for the revocation of the offender’s Driver’s License at Land Transportation Office (LTO).

SECTION 6. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If for any reason, any provision, portion or part of this ordinance is found to be inconsistent with any law, other provisions or part/s thereof not so affected shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 7. REPEALING CLAUSE - All ordinances, rules and regulations or part/s thereof, which are inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed, amended and/or modified accordingly.

SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING BODY – The Municipal Traffic Management Enforcement Board (MTEB) shall be in-charge of the overall implementation and



monitoring of this ordinance with the assistance of the JARO-Philippine National Police (JARO-PNP), Municipal Traffic Enforcers, and the Barangay Tanods and other deputized volunteer traffic group/organizations.

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY - This Ordinance shall take effect 15 days after the completion of its posting in at least four (4) conspicuous places in the Municipality of Jaro as mandated for under RA No. 7160, or otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991.





Minutes of the Public Hearing

1. Invocation and Acknowledgement

- The session commenced with an invocation and prayer led by the SK Federation Officers. Participants were acknowledged by the SK Federation President Vianca Mae N. Familiar, who is the Vice Chairman of the Committee on Social Welfare and Development and Human Rights.

2. Rationale of the Public Hearing

- Hon. Vianca Mae N. Familiar provided the rationale emphasizing the significance of the public hearing concerning the children's safety on motorcycles.

3. Presentation of the Ordinance Localizing the Republic Act 10666, An Act Providing for the Safety of Children Aboard Motorcycles in Jaro, Leyte.

- Hon. Familiar gave the overview and asked the SK Chairpersons to relay the information of the ordinance to the Brgy. Captains.
- Hon. Familiar firstly discussed the Republic Act No. 10666 or Children's Safety on Motorcycles Act of 2015, in which a two-wheeled motorcycle rider may not be allowed to drive a motorcycle with a small child on board.
- Furthermore, Hon. Familiar discussed each section of the ordinance to adopt it to Jaro, Leyte.
- Hon. Familiar highlighted the prohibitions of the said ordinance therefore emphasizing what circumstances shall be considered as exempted from the penalties.
- To extend the discussion, Hon. Familiar discussed the penalties to those riders who will be found guilty of violating any of the provisions of the ordinance.

4. Question and Answer Session


- Hon. Lester Cuña of Brgy. Hiagsam inquired as to whether it is exempted if the child rides a motorcycle with a guardian rather than just the driver. Hon. Familiar responded that it is better if a child is accompanied by its guardian, but the provisions stays the same, which means it is still not exempted from the penalties.
- Hon. Jefle Jabonero of Brgy. Sagkahan asked what would happen if the offender declined to face consequences. Hon. Familiar responded that the PNP will make the decision on how to deal with this particular scenario.
- Hon. Wilmar Justiza of Brgy. Pange asked who would administer the penalty. and Hon. Familiar responded that in the event that your barangay encounters this, the Brgy. Council will make the final determination and will forward it to the PNP. But if this occurs within the Jaro Proper, the PNP will be in full control.
- Hon. Jerico Dador of Brgy. II - Poblacion also inquired as to what kind of helmet that each child ought to wear when on a motorcycle, Hon. Familiar replied that a half-face helmet is appropriate.
- Hon. Lester Cuña of Brgy. Hiagsam inquired again about whether every person riding the motorcycle, not just the child, needed to wear a helmet when heading to Jaro proper. Hon. Familiar answered that other passengers might not wear the helmet.

5. Closing Remarks


- Hon. Vianca Mae Familiar concluded the public hearing by discussing the next steps in approving the ordinance to the Sangguniang Bayan and thanking all for attending the said meeting.
