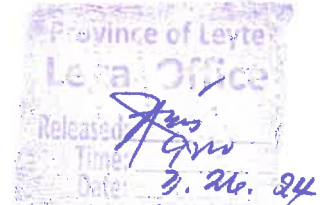


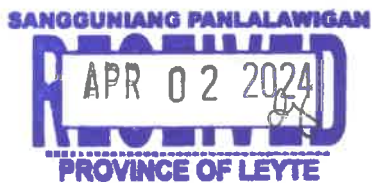

Respectfully returned to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of Leyte, through the SP Secretary, the attached Ordinance No. 03, S. 2024 of the Sangguniang of Panlungsod of Baybay City, Leyte, recommending for the declaration of its validity, pursuant to its power under Section 56 (C) of R.A. 7160, to the opinion of the Provincial Legal Office (PLO), an exercise of the power under Section 393(a)ⁱ of the Local Government Code, Provided, that the annual appropriations for personal services shall be subject to the budgetary limitations prescribed under Title Five, Book II of the Code; Provided further that the source of funding and budget be specified in the ordinance for transparency and clarity.

Furthermore, the opinions rendered herein are without prejudice to opinions rendered by higher authorities.

ⁱ (a) Barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of this Code, but in no case shall it be less than One thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per month for the punong barangay and Six hundred pesos (P600.00) per month for the sangguniang barangay members, barangay treasurer, and barangay secretary: Provided, however, That the annual appropriations for personal services shall be subject to the budgetary limitations prescribed under Title Five, Book II of this Code;

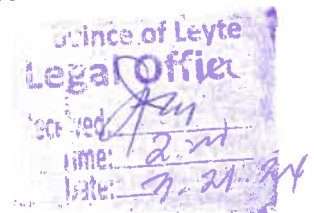

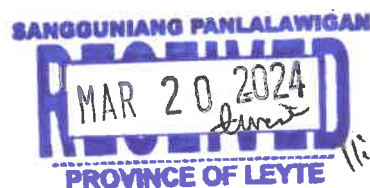

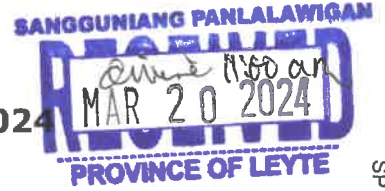

"AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING SPECIAL MEDICAL, FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE, AND BENEFITS TO ELECTED BARANGAY OFFICIALS, SANGGUNIANG KABATAAN OFFICIALS, AND APPOINTED BARANGAY WORKERS"

Sponsored by: HON. JULES LUCAS C. CARI, ATTY. JOSE ROMMEL A. PEÑARANDA AND HON. KYLA SHANNEN T. VIDAL

PREFATORY STATEMENT

WHEREAS, Section 387 of the Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, states that the Sangguniang barangay has the power to "create such other positions or offices as may be deemed necessary to carry out the purposes of the barangay government" in accordance with the need of public service;

WHEREAS, Section 393 of the said law provides that barangay officials, including barangay tanods and members of the lupong tagapamayapa, shall receive honoraria, allowances, and such other emoluments as may be authorized by law or barangay, municipal or city ordinance in accordance with the provisions of this code, but in no case shall it be less than One thousand pesos (P1,000.00) per month for the punong barangay and Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) per month for the sangguniang barangay members, barangay treasurer, and barangay secretary, subject to the budgetary limitations prescribed by law;

WHEREAS, Further Section 394 and Section 395 thereof gives the power of the Punong barangay to appoint barangay secretary and treasurer;

WHEREAS, SECTION 423 of the said RA 7160 likewise stressed that there shall be in every barangay a Sangguniang Kabataan to be composed of a chairman, seven (7) members, a secretary, and a treasurer.

The SK Chairman, in accordance with Section 434 thereof, shall have the same privileges enjoyed by other Sangguniang barangay officials under this Code subject to such requirements and limitations provided herein.

WHEREAS, expressly provided in Section 458(a)(1)(xiii) of the same law that the Sangguniang Panlungsod may provide for group insurance or

additional insurance coverage for all barangay officials, including members of barangay tanod brigades and other service units, with public or private insurance companies, when the finances of the city government allow said coverage.

WHEREAS, the City understands the role, the risk and the responsibility of all elected and appointed Barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and workers in carrying out their mandate, ensuring the delivery of basic services and the promotion of peace and order in the barangay;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Honorable. Jules C. Cari and duly seconded by the majority of the council members present;

BE IT ORDAINED, as it is hereby ordained by the 6th Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Baybay, Province of Leyte, in its 9th Regular Session duly assembled that:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "Barangay Health and Risk Assistance Ordinance of 2024".

SECTION 2. Definition of Terms - For purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall refer to and/or mean as hereunder defined;

- a. Appointed barangay Workers- refers to the Barangay secretary, Barangay treasurer, Barangay health workers, barangay tanods, Lupong Tagapamayapa, Pangkat ng Tagapagkasundo members; Barangay Nutrition Scholar, Barangay Service Point Officers, Daycare Workers and Bantay Dagat and such other workers appointed by the punong barangay.
- b. Barangay Elected Officials- refers to the Barangay Chairman and Barangay Kagawads elected through the Barangay Elections and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections, including those Barangay officials appointed by the city mayor in case of vacancy brought about by resignation, illness, incapacity or death of the incumbent
- c. Sangguniang Kabataan Officials- refers to the Barangay Sangguniang Kabataan Chairman and Kagawads elected through the Barangay and Sangguniang Kabataan Elections; the appointed Sangguniang Officers Sangguniang Kabataan Secretary and Sangguniang Kabataan Treasurer.
- d. Special Medical Assistance- refers to monetary assistance for hospital expenses, maternity expenses, medicines, laboratory and other injury related expenses.
- e. Special Financial Assistance- refers to monetary assistance for loss of life.
- f. Special Burial Assistance- refers to monetary assistance for burial expenses and other related expenses.



g. Risk Assistance- refers to monetary assistance for accidents that result in either Injury or Death during the term of his/her office.

SECTION 3. Insurance benefits- All barangay elected officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or appointed barangay workers shall be covered or insured against accident or any contingency. The City shall establish an insurance policy for all elected and appointed barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or workers and pay the premiums thereof, in full or a portion thereof, subject to availability of funds.

SECTION 4. A Special Medical Assistance, in addition to any financial assistance provided by any private or public entities, the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (P 500.00) per day for Hospital Expenses this includes maternity expenses and Five-Hundred Pesos (P 500.00) per day for Medicine Expenses for 15 days shall be given to any elected barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or appointed barangay workers who sustain injuries in the line of duty.

SECTION 5. A Special Financial Assistance(a), in addition to any financial assistance provided by any private or public entities, the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) shall also be provided to any elected barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or appointed barangay workers who die while in the line of duty.

A Special Burial Assistance(b), in addition to any financial assistance provided by any private or public entities, the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00) shall be provided to any elected barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or appointed barangay workers who die while in the line of duty or in his/her incumbency.

SECTION 6. A "Special Barangay Workers Fund" shall be established in the City Mayor's Office (CMO) to be funded, wholly or partially, by the savings from the CMO, the contributions of elected barangay officials and appointed barangay workers, and by the donations of charitable institutions to the local government. Provided that within (1) year from the approval of this ordinance, this fund shall constitute the initial reserve fund for its purpose.

SECTION 7. Elected barangay Officials and Appointed Barangay Workers shall contribute in the amount of Five Hundred Pesos (P 500.00) per year to be used for the Special Barangay Workers Fund.

SECTION 8. In the event that the elected barangay official, Sangguniang Kabataan Official, and /or appointed barangay worker is wounded or injured in the performance of his duties, the City, through the Special Barangay Worker's Fund, shall provide Special Medical Assistance in such amount as defined under this ordinance.

SECTION 9. In case of death to the elected barangay official, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials, and/or appointed barangay worker in the line of duty, his compulsory heirs, as provided under Article 887 of the New Civil Code, shall receive Special Financial Assistance and Special Burial Assistance in such amount as defined under this ordinance.



SECTION 10. The Office of the City Mayor is responsible for the delivery of the assistance in case of death to the heirs of the deceased elected barangay officials, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials, and/or appointed barangay workers; in case of injury to the elected barangay official, Sangguniang Kabataan Officials and/or appointed barangay workers or to their immediate family.

SECTION 11. The Office of the City Mayor shall promulgate the necessary implementing Rules of this Ordinance within Sixty (60) days from its effectivity.

SECTION 12. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Ordinance is held invalid or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity and effectivity of the other provisions hereof.

SECTION 13. Repealing Clause. - Pertinent provisions of City Ordinance No. 5, 2020. other laws, decrees, executive orders and rules and regulations contrary to or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

SECTION 14. Effectivity Clause. - this Ordinance shall take effect upon compliance with the publication requirement as provided for by law.



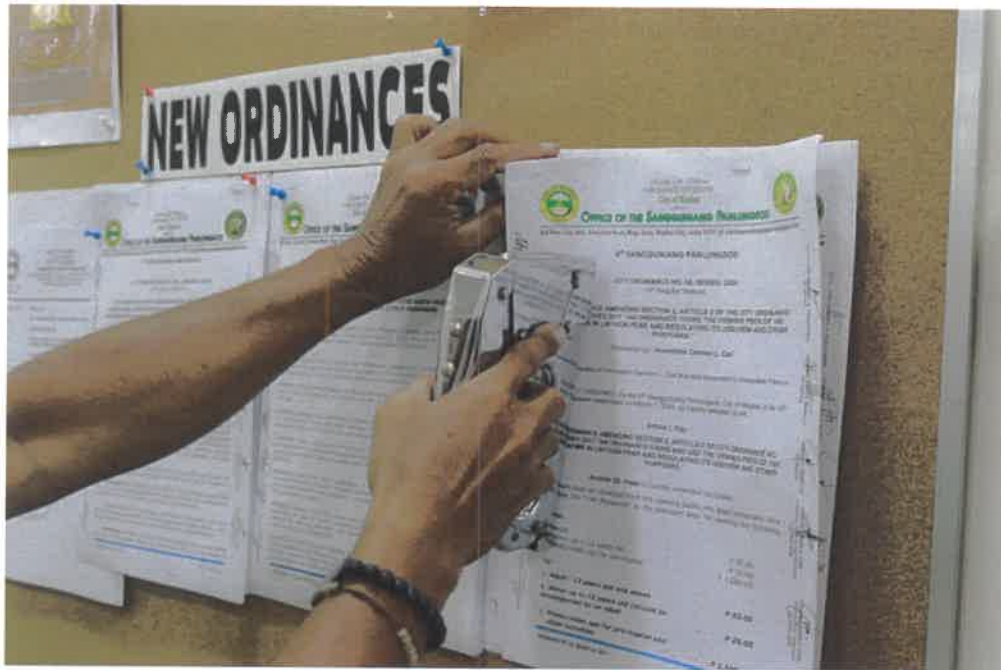

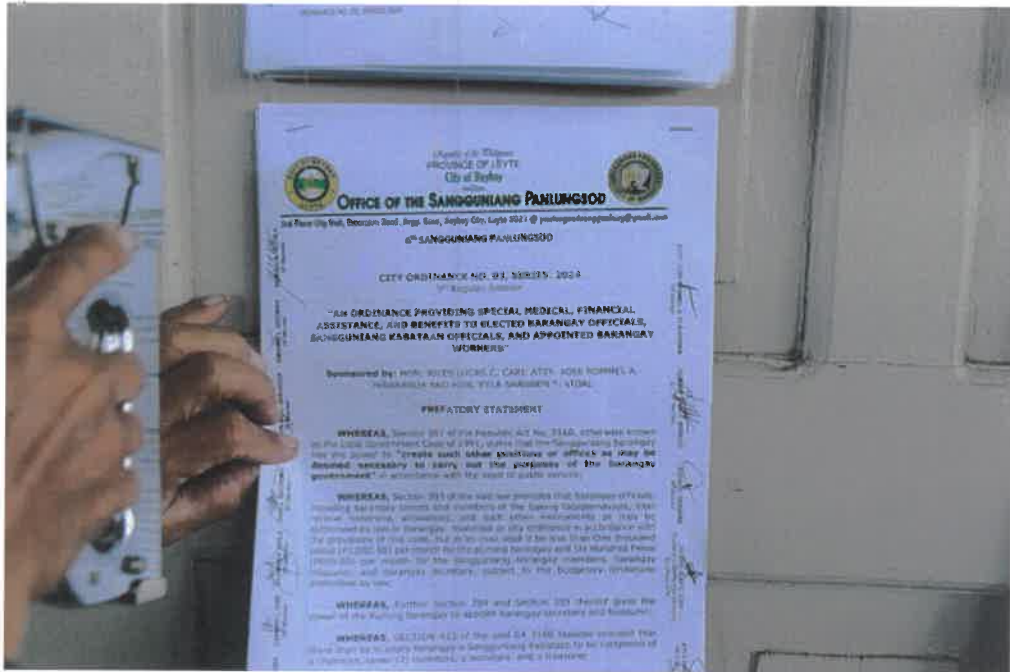
